The cost of your first visit is \$40. At this visit you receive a basin for soaking your feet, a toenail clipper, an emery board and a manicure stick. These items are yours to keep and you will bring them with you each time you come for a nail clipping. Each subsequent visit is \$30.



Grilled Pork Chops with Cherry Salsa

Ingredients

- 2-3 pounds pork steaks thin cut
- 1 Tbsp. garlic powder
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 2 cups sweet cherries, pitted & chopped
- 1/4 cup red onion, finely diced
- 1/2 jalapeno, finely diced & seeded, ribs removed. (use more if you like it spicy and leave the seeds in)
- 1/4 cup cilantro, chopped
- Juice of 1 lime

Instructions

- 1. Season the pork with garlic, salt and pepper; set aside
- 2. Make the cherry salsa by combining cherries, onion, jalapeno, cilantro and lime juice, stirring well.
- 3. Grill the pork steaks about 3-5 minutes per side (longer if you get thick cut) until cooked through.
- 4. Serve topped with cherry salsa
