

## **PASTORAL PONDERINGS**

This weekend we celebrate the Second Sunday of Advent. The key figure in today's Gospel is John the Baptist. We are told that the word of God came to John, son of Zechariah, in the desert. He proclaimed a baptism for the repentance of sin. Luke quotes the following words of the prophet, Isaiah, in referring to John: "A voice of one crying out in the desert: 'Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths." This Advent Season, let us take to heart the message of John to "prepare the way of the Lord" by looking into our hearts and reflecting upon our need for conversion. Perhaps we may choose to celebrate the sacrament of Reconciliation. Especially note the opportunities for the sacrament of Penance listed in today's bulletin. Please pray for the children of our parish who will be making First Reconciliation next weekend.

The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary occurs on December 8. It is a holy day of obligation. Mary, under the title of the Immaculate Conception, is the patroness of our country. There are two opportunities for attending Mass at our parish: Tuesday, December 7, 6:30 PM Viail Mass—Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, and Wednesday, December 8, 12:00 Noon Mass—Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. Please join us for Eucharist as we honor the Blessed Virgin Mary who was sinless from the moment of her conception: Mary, the humble servant of God, and most worthy vessel to bear his Son, Jesus, our Savior, who was born into our world so that we might know God's great love for us.

As of this writing, (November 23 – early deadline), our new sound system is fully installed. When initially installed, the amplifier came "DOA" from the factory, and so, a temporary amplifier had to be installed and a new one ordered. The sound is much improved with the new 8-channel amplifier. If you watch Mass via livestream, it can now be accessed both through You Tube (search Saint Catherine of Siena Parish of Bay City, MI) or through Saint Catherine of Siena Facebook page. For closed caption, press the small "cc box" to activate it on your computer or phone. Once again, I would like to thank all who use the pink envelopes for our development fund. Thus, we were able to provide the parish with a much-needed new sound system.

Last week I gave the answer to some titles given to Jesus and asked if you were able to think of any additional ones. Here are some other titles for Jesus: *Rabbi, Master, Word of God, the Christ, Redeemer, Lamb of God, Light of the World, Lord of Life, and King of Kings.* This week's question is: If you had to name a patron saint or saints for Advent, who would they be? 
## DIOCESAN NEWS RETIREMENT FUND FOR RELIGIOUS
