




#### **OUR MISSION STATEMENT**

#### **PASTORAL PONDERINGS**

This Sunday, as we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, the Christmas Season officially ends. On Monday, we return to the first week in Ordinary Time. The manifestations of Christ that we have celebrated during the Christmas Season (to the shepherds, to the magi, to his parents when they found him in the temple among the teachers, and to the whole world represented by the magi who traveled a great distance from the East) culminate in the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. In today's Gospel account, Jesus is baptized, and as the Holy Spirit descends upon him, the Father reveals to us the identity of Jesus as he says, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." From his baptism, Jesus launches into his public ministry. From the age of twelve until his baptism, Scripture tells us nothing about his life other than that "Jesus" advanced in wisdom and age and favor before God and man." Today's feast challenges us to open ourselves to Christ so that he may be manifested in our lives. Remember what Father Jim told us in his homilies on Christmas, quoting Mother Teresa (Saint Teresa of Calcutta): "It is Christmas every time you let God love others through you." She goes on to say: "...it is Christmas every time you smile at your brother and offer him your hand." That refers to the whole human family. We were baptized in Christ through water and the Holy Spirit, and the Father found favor in each one of us. As members of the Body of Christ, we have the potential to present Christ to whomever we encounter each day as well as to encounter Christ in another each day. Sometimes, we cover up the face of Christ by our words and actions which prevent us from bearing Christ to others. Christ's basic message is that love is what matters: God so loved the world that he sent his only begotten Son so that all believe in him might have eternal life. We are vessels of God's love, and we are capable of evangelizing through our words and actions. Let us reflect upon ways in which, this New Year, we can make a difference as Catholic Christians in our world through small, everyday acts of kindness and love. As we renew our Baptismal Promises this weekend, let us resolve to consciously choose to follow Christ more closely and to take seriously our baptismal call to live as true and authentic disciples.
