

PASTORAL PONDERINGS

This past week, we began the holy season of Lent with the celebration of Ash Wednesday. As we do each year, we answered the call to continued conversion. In solidarity with all who are preparing for Baptism and the sacraments of Initiation, we began a 40-day retreat: one in which we strive to deepen our relationship with Christ. As we recall our own Baptism, we ask ourselves where we have fallen short in being faithful disciples of Christ. We embrace the disciplines of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, and we reflect upon our need for forgiveness and reconciliation. We journey together with Jesus who gave his life totally for all that we might have life. This Sunday, we journey with Jesus, filled with the Holy Spirit following his baptism in the Jordan River, and led by the Spirit into the desert. He remains there forty days and is tempted by the devil. Jesus, who was fully God (Son of God) and fully human (Son of Man), experienced all things that we do, which includes temptation. God, however, Jesus triumphs temptation; he was "like us in all things but sin." Note that the temptations of Jesus parallel the temptations of Adam and Eve in the garden and those of the Jewish people during the Exodus when for forty years they wandered in the desert. Israel failed but Jesus triumphed. Jesus knew who he was and what his mission was. In the first temptation, Jesus did not let his physical hunger for food surpass his understanding that "One does not live on bread alone." He knows his mission includes feeding the hungry and ultimately providing them with the bread of eternal life. In the second temptation, when Jesus is promised all the kingdoms of the world, he knows that his kingdom is not of this world and that God's plan of salvation does not rest on worldly power and glory. Jesus must suffer death on the cross and his glory resides in God the Father who raises him from the dead. It is to God the Father that all power and glory belong. Thus, Jesus tells the devil: "You shall worship the Lord your God, and him alone shall you serve." In the final temptation, the devil takes Jesus to the parapet of the temple and says to him, "If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down" for it is written that "God will command his angels to guard you..." Jesus realizes that the tempter is misinterpreting psalm 91 and dismisses it by replying: "You shall not put the Lord your God to the test." The Gospel passage ends noting that devil departs from Jesus for a time. That means he will return. The temptations of Jesus and his response teach us how we ourselves are tempted and how we can overcome temptation. It is simply in realizing who we are and who we are called to be, sons and daughters of God, who depend upon God's grace each day of our lives to triumph over the temptations we face and knowing we will be tested again and again as Jesus himself was.
