PASTORAL PONDERINGS

This weekend we celebrate the Third Sunday of **Lent.** In the second part of today's Gospel account, we journey into the orchard with Jesus as he tells the parable of the fig tree. It has been three years and a certain tree has not yet produced any fruit. The owner of the orchard tells the gardener to cut it down. However, the gardener says, "Sir, leave it for this year also, and I shall cultivate the ground around it and fertilize it; it may bear fruit in the future. If not, vou can cut it down." I read somewhere that sometimes it takes fruit trees two to four years **before they begin producing fruit.** Also, a fruit tree may produce exceptionally good fruit one year and nothing the next year because of exhausting itself the previous year. Of course, caring for trees demands having certain soil conditions and proper pruning. I learned that fig trees are sturdy trees and that it takes a long drought and a great deal of neglect before they come to a point of being barren. The orchard owner in the Gospel may not have been aware of all these variables, but the gardener certainly was. The orchard owner was willing to cut the tree down before it was mature enough to bear fruit. That would have been a mistake. The gardener, on the other hand was patient, was willing to give the tree another chance along with his own "tender, loving care." This is the way our compassionate and loving God looks **upon us.** He knows our potential in being faithful disciples. He knows that we don't always use our natural gifts or those bestowed upon us by the Holy Spirit in the best way. If we are open to receiving it, God gives us grace in an abundance: in our prayer, in the sacraments we celebrate, in the Scriptures, and through the people he sends into our lives. God **never gives up on us.** At those times that we do not bear fruit, when we are experiencing pain or grief, when we are distracted by other things that cause us to lose focus on what it means to be authentic disciples, when we sin, or when we stray **from** God, he doesn't cut us off. God continues to provide the conditions in which we can grow, the environment in which we can blossom, and continued opportunities to glorify him and his name.

Please join us for Lenten Evening Prayer this Wednesday at 6:00 PM. We will especially keep the people of Ukraine in our prayers.

I encourage you to sign up for one of the parish synod sessions if you have not already done so. Please bring a friend with you. There is one session scheduled next Sunday between the 8:30 and 11:00 AM Masses and another at 10:00 AM on Wednesday, March 30. Both will take place in the parish center.
