

#### **PASTORAL PONDERINGS**

Today is Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion. We begin the holiest week of the Church Year. Eucharist begins on a high note with the blessing of palms, shouts of Hosannas, and songs of triumph as the roval entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem takes place. Then, the emotional tide turns as we move into the Liturgy of the Word with scripture readings from Isaiah and Philippians, culminating with the Passion According to Luke. Today we are reminded that as Jesus enters Jerusalem, it is an entry into the mystery of his suffering, death, and resurrection. There is so much in the assigned scripture passages this Sunday for us to reflect upon and meditate upon for a whole week. I simply want to take a couple of lines from Luke's passion account which are not found in the other three Gospels. It is a conversation which takes place when Jesus is hanging on the cross between two criminals who have been crucified with him. One rebukes Jesus saying: "Are you not the Christ? Save yourself and us." The other replies, "Have you no fear of God, for you are subject to the same condemnation? And indeed, we have been condemned justly, for the sentence we received corresponds to our crimes, but this man has done nothing criminal." He continues speaking and says to Jesus, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." Jesus replies, "Amen, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise." One criminal recognizes Jesus as God and begins to believe in him. He knows the deeper meaning of being saved by Jesus - not from the cross, but by being with him in Paradise. There are times in our lives when we want Jesus to save us from the cross, but what he does is help us endure the suffering we are undergoing and gives us hope, hope that there is new life that will result from our suffering whatever it may be. Our sung acclamation during the Passion today is: "Jesus, remember me, when you come into your kingdom." God has called each of us by name and as members of the Body of Christ, Jesus remembers us every time we act upon his words, "Do this in memory of me." As we celebrate Eucharist, a foretaste of the banquet of heaven and the pledge of future glory, we remember Jesus and he remembers us, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

I encourage all to take part in as many of the Holy Week liturgies as you are able. Please note the insert in today's bulletin outlining the times for the Sacred Paschal Triduum. There will be no sign-up/ reserved places for the Triduum and Easter liturgies. Do arrive early to ensure that you and your family have seats. Extra seats will be set up in chapel and in the gathering space. Please feel free to wear a mask to church if you are concerned about social distancing or health issues. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion will wear masks at the time of the distribution of Holy Communion.
