

The LUMINARY

The Holy Eucharist

All of the seven Sacraments were given to us by Our Lord as channels of supernatural grace. Through the Sacraments we receive divine assistance which strengthens us so that we can faithfully follow God in this world and attain Heaven. The greatest of all the Sacraments is the Most Blessed Sacrament: the Holy Eucharist. The other Sacraments give us grace, restore us to grace, or increase grace within us. When we receive the Holy Eucharist we receive the very Author and Source of all grace.



Our Lord taught that His flesh is True Food. The crowds murmured at this difficult teaching but Our Lord insisted upon it and on account of this teaching many of the crowd who had been following Him followed Him no longer. Our Lord let them leave since they refused to believe this teaching and even asked the Apostles if they also would leave Him on account of it. Saint Peter, on behalf of the Twelve, proclaimed faith in Our Lord's divinity. The Apostles knew Jesus is God incarnate, and therefore His words are true.

On the night before He was betrayed Our Lord, at the Last Supper, took bread and broke it and gave it to the Apostles and declared it to be His Body. Our Lord often performed miracles by His mere word. This word, spoken over the bread, miraculously changed the bread into His Body. Our Lord gave the Apostles the sacred power to do what He had done. The same miracle performed by Our Lord at the Last Supper takes place at each and every Holy Mass. When a validly ordained Priest pronounces Our Lord's words over the bread at Mass, the bread is miraculously transformed into the very Body of Christ.

The Eucharist is not a reminder of Our Lord; it is not a symbol of Our Lord; it is Our Lord: really, truly, wholly present in our midst. This is why we kneel during the consecration: God is made present upon our Altar and we adore Him. We should always receive Holy Communion with as much reverence, devotion, and love as we are able to stir up in our hearts—aware of Whom we receive when we receive Holy Communion. Let us always receive Holy Communion worthily, with attention, and in a spirit of profound adoration.

Let us be mindful than whenever we enter a Catholic church we come before God Who is Truly Present in the Holy Eucharist within the Tabernacle. As we enter a Catholic church we should acknowledge Our Lord's presence by genuflecting before entering the pew and saying a short prayer of praise and adoration. O Sacrament most Holy, O Sacrament Divine, all praise and all thanksgiving be every moment Thine!


