Strengthening Faith: Key Practices for Raising Lifelong Catholics

"Thus says the LORD: Say to those whose hearts are frightened: Be strong, fear not! Here is your God...he comes to save you."

The Peyton Institute for Domestic Church Life recently published the "Future Faithful Families Project" study, exploring how families successfully raise children to remain active Catholics as adults. As we start the new school year, it's helpful to review some highlights from this study. The full report is available at stfrancisa2.com (Future Faithful Families CARA Report). Parents who succeed in keeping their children Catholic into adulthood share several key practices and characteristics:



**Parish Registration and Active Involvement:** 100% of parents who raised children to remain active Catholics are registered with their parish. Additionally, 60% are involved in parish life beyond weekly Mass, showing the importance of embedding the family in a strong faith community.

**Religious Education and Catholic Schooling:** These parents often ensure their children receive comprehensive religious education. This includes parish-based religious education (52%), attendance at Catholic primary school (58%), Catholic secondary school (29%), and even Catholic college (14%).

Completion of the Sacraments and Frequent Confession: 100% have been Confirmed Catholics. Regular participation in the Sacrament of Confession is common, with 69% of these parents going at least once a year. This practice reinforces the importance of repentance and renewal in the Catholic faith.

Weekly Mass Attendance: All participants emphasized the critical importance of attending Mass weekly, instilling this as a non-negotiable habit that their children continue even after leaving home.

**Family Prayer and Rituals:** Many families place a strong emphasis on shared meals, family prayer, and religious rituals in the home. These practices are integrated into their daily lives, helping to weave faith into the fabric of their family culture.

**Service and Charity:** Almost all these families engage in charitable service or ministry together, either through their parish or independently. This active participation in helping others reflects the lived example of Catholic social teaching.

The commitment of these parents to faith formation at home and in the community, coupled with regular religious practices, has proven effective in keeping their children committed to the Catholic faith.


## **Thank You Father Kumanda!**



Euthanasia and Assisted Suicide: Health Care, **Aging, End-of-Life Decisions** 

Thursday, September 19th at 7:00pm - 9:30pm at St. Francis' Assisi Center. Ann Arbor



Voters will become more aware of the issues prior to the election in November. Our speaker from Right to Life -Genevieve Marnon - who works in Lansing, is concerned about the pending legislation that could legalize euthanasia and assisted suicide in Michigan. And, Bishop Boyea believes that this issue needs to be brought to people's attention before they vote for particular candidates in November.

All politicians from our Deanery area have been invited. They will be allotted time (5 minutes) to express their position on the pending legislation concerning euthanasia and assisted suicide.


