



# THE ASSUMPTION OF THE *Blessed Virgin Mary*

Today we celebrate one of the great feasts of the Church year, the Assumption of Mary. From the earliest days of Christianity, it has been believed that Mary was assumed body and soul into heaven. The Eastern Church believes that when Mary died, the apostles buried her in a tomb in Jerusalem. St. Thomas was away at the time and when he returned two days later, they opened the tomb so that he could see the body. To their amazement, they found the tomb empty, and realized that Mary, the first of the disciples, was also the first to be resurrected and brought into the glory of God in heaven. Our Orthodox brothers and sisters call this the "Dormition of the Theotokos" (the going to sleep of the Mother of God).

The first written accounts of the Assumption date to the third century and the feast was widely celebrated on August 15th by both the Eastern and Western Churches by the 7th century. The truth of the Assumption was accepted by all Christians until the Reformation in the 16th century. Surprisingly, although the Church has always taught the truth of the Assumption, it was not defined as



dogma (revealed truth that must be believed) until 1950, when Pope Pius XII issued *Munificentissimus Deus* (The most bountiful God) which stated that "The Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory." Although the Eastern Church believes that Mary died and was then assumed into heaven, Western Christian tradition is less certain. Many saints and theologians believe that Mary, being without sin, was spared physical death (the wages of sin) and assumed into heaven while still alive. The Church has not spoken dogmatically on that point and Catholics are free to believe as they wish about it.

## UNDERSTANDING THE SACRAMENTS

### BAPTISM

Baptisms are celebrated on the second and fourth Sundays of the month. Parents should contact our Office of Faith Formation at (941) 585-0668 or [faithformation@stcbc.org](mailto:faithformation@stcbc.org) at least six weeks before the anticipated Baptism to register for the preparation class.

### THE RITE OF ANOINTING

A person does not need to wait until the point of death to receive this sacrament. For those who are about to depart from this life, the Church offers the person Penance, Anointing of the Sick, and the Eucharist as Viaticum (food for the journey) given at the end of life. Contact the Parish Office at 625-4754 to schedule an anointing.

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

If you are a registered parishioner of St. Charles Borromeo and plan to marry in our parish, please contact the Faith Formation office at (941) 585-0668 at least six months prior to the tentative wedding date.

### CONVALIDATION OF MARRIAGES

Were you married outside of the Catholic Church? Don't hesitate to contact the Faith Formation Office at (941) 585-0668 or [faithformation@stcbc.org](mailto:faithformation@stcbc.org) to make arrangements to have your marriage blessed by one of our priests.

### DIVORCED OR SEPARATED

Don't let a separation or a legal divorce keep you from the life of the Church. Please contact the Parish Office at (941) 625-4754 to speak to a priest about your own marital situation.

### ANNULMENT

An annulment is more accurately described as a declaration of matrimonial invalidity. If you wish to reestablish your freedom to marry in the Church, please contact a parish priest to be your advocate in presenting your case to the Tribunal.






# *He is waiting!*

*"The time you spend with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is the best time you will spend on Earth. Each moment that you spend with Jesus will deepen your union with Him and make your soul everlastingly more glorious and beautiful in Heaven and will bring about everlasting peace on Earth." - Saint Teresa of Calcutta, MC*

Jesus wants me to tell you again...how much love He has for each one of you - beyond all you can imagine. I worry some of you still have not really met Jesus - one to one - you and Jesus alone. We may spend time in chapel but have you seen with the eyes of your soul how He looks at you with love? Do you really know the living Jesus, not from books but from being with Him in your heart? Have you heard the loving words He speaks to you? Ask for the grace; He is longing to give it.

Until you can hear Jesus in the silence of your own heart, you will not be able to hear Him saying, "I thirst" in the hearts of the poor. Never give up this daily intimate

contact with Jesus as the real living person, not just the idea. How can we last even one day without hearing Jesus say, "I love you"- impossible. Our soul needs that as much as the body needs to breathe the air. If not, prayer is dead and meditation only thinking.

Jesus wants you each to hear Him speaking in the silence of your heart. Be careful of all that can block that personal contact with the living Jesus. The devil may try to use the hurts of life, and sometimes our own mistakes to make you feel it is impossible that Jesus really loves you, is really cleaving to you. This is a danger for all of us. And so sad, because it is completely opposite of what Jesus is really

wanting, waiting to tell you. Not only that He loves you, but even more, He longs for you. He misses you when you don't come close. He thirsts for you.



My children, you don't have to be different for Jesus to love you. Only believe that you are precious to Him. 

### GUIDELINES FOR RECEIVING COMMUNION

#### For Catholics

Catholics fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist when they receive Holy Communion in fulfillment of Christ's

commandment to eat His Body and drink His Blood. In order to be properly disposed to receive Communion, communicants should not be conscious of grave sin, have fasted for an hour, and seek to live in charity and love with their neighbors. Persons conscious of grave sin must first be reconciled with God and the Church through the sacrament of Penance. A frequent reception of the sacrament of Penance is encouraged for all.

#### For Other Christians

We welcome to this celebration of the Eucharist those Christians who are not fully united with us. It is a

consequence of the sad divisions in Christianity that we cannot extend to them a general invitation to receive Communion. Catholics believe that the Eucharist is an action of the celebrating community signifying a oneness in faith, life, and worship of the community. Reception of the Eucharist by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we must all pray.

#### For Those Not Receiving Communion

Those not receiving sacramental Communion are encouraged to express in their hearts a prayerful desire for unity with Lord Jesus and with one another.

#### For Non-Christians

We also welcome to this celebration those who do not share our faith in Jesus. While we cannot extend to them an invitation to receive Communion, we do invite them to be united with us in prayer.






## ALTAR SERVER TRAINING

## CHURCH ETIQUETTE

### ATTIRE

The idea of Sunday best should be honored; churchgoers of all ages should dress conservatively. Coat and tie is appropriate for men, but not required. Women should wear modest dresses, skirts and slacks; no tank tops, short skirts or tight-fitting clothing.

### ARRIVAL

Offering envelopes should be prepared ahead of time. Arrive at least 10 minutes before Mass begins. This helps reduce distractions and provides time to get settled. Latecomers should wait to be seated by ushers so as not to disrupt the Mass and the congregation. Please avoid chewing gum or eating candy when coming to Mass.

### ENTERING THE CHURCH

Once you enter the Church, please

refrain from over socializing with others. Remember that others are already engaged in prayer in their seats. As a sign of respect for the Blessed Sacrament, genuflect (bow if you are unable to genuflect) before taking your seat. Move to the center of the pew to accommodate others who arrive after you.

### QUIET TIME

Turn off cell phones and pagers. It is understandable that children may have difficulty sitting quietly, but when they become distracting, take them out briefly until they settle down. They may simply need a change of environment. The Narthex is an appropriate place to take them.

### CONSECRATION

Elevation of the Host and Chalice after the words of consecration are spoken

is a sacred time, and there should be silent reverence with no movement around the church, except in an emergency.

### COMMUNION

Again, please refrain from socializing when leaving the pew to receive Communion. Receive the holy Eucharist with reverence, bow slightly and respond "Amen."

### LEAVING THE CHURCH

The final part of Mass is singing a closing hymn. Leaving before the hymn ends is inappropriate. Genuflect (or bow) toward the altar before leaving. Refrain from greeting and visiting each other until leaving the church. Have respect for those who wish to remain in prayer.


