

And you deserve to be treated as such. That’s why special seating is reserved for those with difficulty, walking, hearing, or using a device such as a cane or walker.





A Guide To Anointing of the Sick Preparation & Pre-Planning The Mass of Resurrection & Burial



Anointing of the Sick

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick brings the grace and strength to bear illness and pain. It is not necessary to wait until a person's condition is life-threatening to request anointing.

A person who is ill, facing serious surgery, is aged and has not recently been anointed, or a person who has a chronic condition may receive the Anointing of the Sick. In addition, when a person's condition is deteriorating, they may be anointed again. Call the parish office **921-6631** when anointing is indicated.

When Death Occurs

If you are using the services of a funeral home, they are your first contact. The funeral director will coordinate with the church.

If you are using the services of a crematory, you will need to contact them. Depending on your arrangements with them, they may coordinate with the church or you may be the one to call the church office at **921-6631** to schedule a Mass and to arrange for burial.

Making Arrangements

Arrangements for you or a family member may be made in advance by calling **921-6631** to set up an appointment. No money can be accepted until services are about to be rendered. You may request any of the following at the pre-planning meeting:

- A Garden Burial
- Scripture Readings
- Liturgical Music Selections
- Designated persons to bring up the bread and wine for Communion

In addition, we need to determine a contact person to work with at the time of death, and also to learn what funeral home or crematory you are using.

Mass of Resurrection

A Mass of Resurrection is celebrated in our chapel in one of three ways:

Funeral Mass—with the body present

Funeral Mass— with ashes present

Memorial Mass—without the body or ashes present

Although the Church prefers to have the body present, any of the above are acceptable.

Wake Service

A member of the clergy can be requested to lead a prayer service when a wake is held at a local funeral home.

Body or Ashes Interred at a Local Facility

When the body or ashes are to be buried at a local facility, a priest or deacon, along with the family, can accompany them to the site for prayers, blessing, and interment.

Burial of Ashes in the Memorial Garden

When the ashes are present at the Mass, and a garden burial is desired, the ashes are usually interred immediately following the Mass. If you plan to have the ashes buried in the garden, only a temporary urn is needed. The ashes are put directly into the ground in a space prepared for the specific person. The ashes are covered with dirt. No marker appears in the garden but the person's name is engraved on a tile on the Memorial Board.

Other Instances of Garden Burials

Ashes from a previous death or from a death that occurred outside the local area may also be buried in the Memorial Garden. The Memorial Garden is limited to registered members of Incarnation Church. Call the Parish Office to make arrangements, **921-6631**.



Cremation and the Catholic Church

Is Cremation Permitted?

Although a funeral where the body is present is preferred, cremation is permitted by the Catholic Church. The Church recognizes that there are times when it is not possible for either for financial reasons or other in other circumstances when cremation is the chosen option. People are encouraged to celebrate the vigil and the Funeral Mass before cremation takes place. A Funeral Mass can be celebrated in the presence of the cremated remains or a Memorial Mass may be celebrated in the absence of the body or cremated remains.

What should I do with the cremated remains?

The cremated remains of the deceased must be given the same respect as a body is given in burial. The cremated remains should be placed in a worthy vessel and be buried in a grave or entombed in a mausoleum or columbarium. Some parishes in the Diocese of Venice have memorial gardens in which a loved one's cremated remains may be laid to rest directly into the earth. A minister of the Church should be present at the interment to celebrate the Rite of Committal.

Cremated remains should not be scattered or separated and distributed among family members, or put into jewelry or other objects.

While they were looking intently at the sky as he was going, suddenly two men dressed in white garments stood beside them. They said, “Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven.”
