



## Good News



Since Hasidic and Jewish Orthodox communities were some of the first to suffer the worst COVID-19 outbreaks, they are now turning their experiences into a nationwide movement that has already saved

thousands of lives. Out of all the COVID-19 treatments that are currently being researched in the US, convalescent plasma therapy has been shown to be particularly promising—especially for severe cases of the virus. The treatment involves drawing blood plasma from someone who has recovered from and built up an immunity to COVID-19, testing the blood for the related antibody, and then injecting it into a sick patient so that the antibody can attack the virus for its new host.

When Dr. Michael Joyner began spearheading the treatment's research at the Mayo Clinic back in mid-April, one of the biggest hurdles for its progress was obtaining blood plasma from people who had already recovered from the novel coronavirus.

Since that initial donation, Jewish communities across the country have hosted plasma drives to help save at-risk COVID patients. "There's no way we'd be able to treat so many people without them," Dr. Joyner told NBC News



It is exciting to enter my second year of Theology at Pope Saint John XXIII National Seminary as a new seminarian in the Diocese of Venice.

Raised in an Irish Catholic family in East Dundee, a quiet northwest suburb of Chicago, I first felt called to the priesthood at the age of ten while serving Mass. The noise of the world, however, muffled that calling for many years. While worldly distractions led me away from pursuing the priesthood, God never stopped pursuing me! After a profound conversion experience in December of 2007, I gave myself to the service of the Lord and His Church.



Ten years later I found myself in an 18ft rowing skiff rowing up the intracoastal from Miami to N.Y. celebrating the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Fatima. During my rowing experience, I met many Salvatorians which opened the door to my entering the Society of the Divine Savior as a candidate in Milwaukee. In 2019 Bishop Bevard invited me to serve the Diocese of St. Thomas, VI, and, with his blessing,

I entered first year Theology at Pope Saint John XXIII. Bishop Bevard's abrupt retirement after emergency heart surgery led to my looking at other dioceses. After meeting with Bishop Dewane, Msgr. Patrick Dubois, Fr. Eric Scanlan, and Fr. Shawn Roser, I felt led to the Diocese of Venice. I am most grateful to Bishop Dewane for giving me this opportunity and am overwhelmed by the kindness I have received upon my arrival at Incarnation. I look forward to spending the rest of the summer here and serving under Fr. Eric's and His Excellency's direction.

You're in!







### Early Childhood Religious Education Program



We are excited to offer the Early Childhood Religious Education program for 4/5 year old children and Kindergartners. The program helps children get to know and love the God who made them and the world that He created. This program is completely home-based with the addition of gathering children together 3-4 times a year for interaction.

At the beginning of the year, parents receive a home packet that contains all the materials needed for the monthly lessons. Parents and children will typically complete 3 lessons a month. Cost for the Early Childhood program is \$25 per child.

**Volunteer to Help The Children Grow in Faith** - Catechists, small group leaders, and other adult assistance is needed for the upcoming school year. The only prerequisite is a desire to serve the Lord by passing on the faith to the children, the future of our Church.

**Catechist:** Leading a group of children in a specific grade on Wednesday evenings. No prior teaching experience needed, lessons are pre-planned for you. classes meet from 6:00-7:15 pm

**Hall Monitor:** Help to maintain safety in the hallways during Religious Education. Welcome children and families, and assist the catechist by helping to escort children.

**Middle School Small Group Leader:** Working with middle school teens to lead small group discussions. Middle school meets on Sunday from 6:00-7:15 pm

**Hospitality:** Providing a baked good or snack for middle school and high school programs that meet on Sunday evenings.

## Inquiring Minds Want To Know

I don't know much about the Holy Spirit. How do we know we have truly received the Holy Spirit?

We first receive the indwelling of the Holy Spirit at baptism and are thereby made adopted sons and daughters of God (*Catechism 1265*). Confirmation completes the grace we receive at baptism, and we receive a "special strengthening of the Holy Spirit" (*CCC 1285*). There is no radical change in us that makes us seem suddenly different.

Over time, we come to see that there is a bit of the Spirit in us. We catch ourselves using the gifts, and end up wondering where a bit of wisdom came from, or why we were so patient, or we feel an intensity in our prayer. Perhaps we feel drawn to deepen our spiritual life or find the courage to witness our faith to others. That's when we know we have received the Holy Spirit. We take on His image. Yes, we grow in grace, and wisdom, but we also grow in our awareness and understanding of the working of God in our life. We become more godlike. Our thoughts, words, and actions carry a special quality and others see it in us. Sometimes we even amaze ourselves.

The Holy Spirit is the earthly agent of the Holy Trinity. How effectively the Spirit is able to work through us is in proportion to how open we are to His prompting.


