

What Are You Curious About?

A little earlier today I looked online at the Drivers Handbook put out by the state of Florida. It was very complete from license requirements through driving rules and regulations of the road. But the most compelling parts of the handbook were the why’s. For example, it didn’t just state “Don’t drive when you are sleepy,” it went on to explain some of the consequences that can occur when doing so and what to do if you become sleepy. In other words, it not only explained the “what” and “how” but also, the “why”

If you come to RCIA to learn the practices of the Catholic faith, you will surely learn them. But it is the whys of our faith that are compelling, and that is the difference between a traditional class where you learn the what and how and an RCIA gathering where you also learn the why.

The goals for RCIA are two-fold:

- ◊ Learning the practices (the what’s and the how’s) and exploring the depths of the Catholic Faith (the whys).
- ◊ Coming to understand God’s love for you in a very profound way, and how to return that love.

RCIA is a journey of personal conversion that helps you to enter into a very intimate relationship with God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It is a process of discovery, not only about things external to you, but also things about you as God’s beloved child.

A couple questions for you, reader.

- Do you understand how the readings apply to you in your life and circumstances and what you are called to do?
- Do you know the meaning of the final words of sending and how you are to respond?
- Do you know what it is to serve as priest, prophet, and king, as your Baptism calls you to be, to do?
- How do you live out the premises of Catholic Social Teaching?

Now it is your turn. **What are you curious about?**

What would make you a more devoted Catholic Christian? A Disciple?

Why Do I Need to Pray in front of Planned Parenthood... ...can't I pray at home or in church?

You need to pray outside the abortion facility because *your presence has an immediate impact on an urgent situation.*

Arriving at Planned Parenthood for an abortion, a woman sees the public vigil, knows and understands that at a time she needs it most, people are praying just for her. Pray in front of Planned Parenthood any First Thursday of the month from 10:00 am–6:00 pm,

Women have turned away from abortion because of this *ministry of presence*. You are the *presence* of Jesus, there, with them.

July and August so far have seen four babies saved from abortion, praise God!!!! This brings the 2021 total to 16. Two saves are especially noteworthy.

The first, a woman had an abortion appointment, drove back and saw us praying outside of Planned Parenthood and kept going. The next day she went to Sarasota Medical Pregnancy Center and they told us that she is going to keep her baby. There was no contact by a sidewalk counselor or a prayer volunteer at Planned Parenthood. She just saw us there and changed her mind about the abortion. We know 40 Days for Life tells us this happens, that our presence on the sidewalk is critical and that we don't know the lives we are touching. Well, it has happened to us and now we know firsthand!! God has blessed us with knowledge and strength that encourage us to continue our prayerful, peaceful, lawful vigil despite what is going on in our society. Our presence saves lives and saves souls. As our Lord told us, “Be not afraid”.

The second happened just this week. As James Kurt reported, “Today I received this blessed follow-up on two of our referrals from Tuesday - one save has been **confirmed**.” And from Patty “I just did a follow up call with the late afternoon client and praise God she is going to have the baby! She has an MD appointment scheduled and has told her family, who are supportive of her decision.” Quote from the follow-up, “The Ultrasound really made the difference. I saw my baby and not a clump of cells - that did it for me.”

Wow, “I saw my baby and not a clump of cells”. Praise God she saw through the lies of the pro-aborts and saw the humanity of her baby. Thanks to all who work at the Pregnancy Resource Centers, those who donate to the centers to help make them possible and to the Knights of Columbus, and those who support the Knights, who provide funding for the ultrasound machines.

Above are accounts from some of the parishioners who pray in front of Planned Parenthood as told by Rich Owens (40 Days for Life Coordinator). Remember, every first Thursday, our parish has committed to support the prayer effort from 10:00 am until 6:00 pm.
