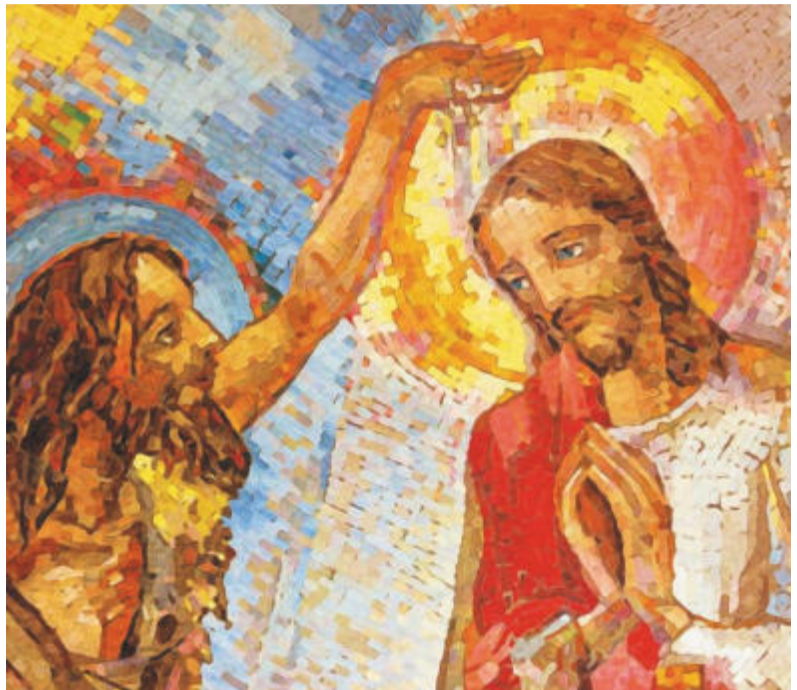

## A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Today we celebrate the feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which seems like a good excuse to offer a refresher on a few things about this great sacramental mystery.



**What is baptism?** It is the foundational sacrament, the gateway to the Church, and the beginning of communion with God. Through baptism we become part of the Body of Christ and our sins are washed away.

**How are we baptized?** Usually a deacon or priest pours blessed water three times over the head of a candidate while saying the person's name along with the words, "I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." The person can also be fully immersed in water three times.

**Who can be baptized?** Anyone who isn't yet baptized (we believe in only one baptism). The only thing necessary is faith, which is publicly professed during the ceremony by the candidate (or the parents in the case of a small child).

**Speaking of kids, why do we baptize children instead of waiting for them to be old enough to speak for themselves?** The Church has been baptizing kids right from the start (check out Acts 16...twice it mentions entire families being baptized). The fact of the matter is, as I often say during baptisms, God chooses us way before we choose Him. And if we truly believe that baptism frees us from the influence of sin (it does and we do), why on earth would we delay that grace of freedom for someone we love and care about?

**Is baptism the only way to get to heaven?** For all those who have received the Gospel and have heard that Jesus Christ is *the way, and the truth, and the life* (Jn 14:6), it is the only way to God and salvation. However, for those who haven't heard the Good News through no fault of their own, it is entirely possible that God can find some other way to save them. I for one don't plan on telling God what He can and cannot do. So, while there *might* be other paths to heaven, we know that baptism is the way God laid out for us.

**Finally, what should I do if I know someone who is interested in baptism?** Send them our way!

## EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP—RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

### I Hope I Am Like Him

“Who is this Christ? Is he like you?”

Perhaps you've heard this story, often attributed to the life of St. Teresa of Calcutta. A sick man asked her this question, as he marveled at her tireless service to himself and others in the name of someone named Jesus Christ.

“He is nothing like me,” the saint is said to have answered. “But I hope I am like him.”

Though the authenticity of this exchange cannot be verified, its message rings perfectly true: all the value of our stewardship lies in its relativity to the one in whose name we perform it.

Consider the figure of John the Baptist—a magnificent, towering character even purely from a literary or historical perspective. A martyr who fed on wild locusts and boldly spoke truth to power—a man so great some mistook him for the Messiah.

But why is he great? Because he prepared the way. All his accomplishments and escapades mean nothing if they are taken out of the context of salvation history. He only makes sense relative to Christ—and this is exactly as he wanted it. “One worthier than I is coming,” he insists. And because of that humility and that total embrace of God's will, he is given one of the greatest honors in the New Testament—he baptizes the Son of God.

Let's examine our lives in the light of their relativity to Christ. How do we prepare the way? When Christ comes to us, what do we do? How do we leave ourselves open to be actors in God's plan?
