A Message From the Pastor

Today's Gospel contains the third major Epiphany of Jesus Christ. Two weeks ago we heard of the



magi's visit, which reveals God's plan to save everyone, no matter where they're from, through this newborn child. Last week we heard about Jesus' baptism in the Jordan River, where God publicly revealed that Jesus is His Beloved Child (and by extension so are we).

Today we hear about the wedding at Cana. Yes, it's miraculous that Jesus transforms water into wine, which foreshadows how He will later transform wine into His own blood. But what does this scripture passage reveal to us about who Jesus is?

First of all we should notice that it is His mom who sees the problem and brings it up to Him. Mary intercedes for those she cares about, bringing our concerns to her Son. And while it might sound to us like Jesus is brushing her off with an "ugh not now, mom!" that's not what really is going on.

In the Gospel of John, Jesus is presented to us as someone who is in control and who knows His purpose. Later on, in the 12th Chapter, as Jesus is preparing to be crucified, He says *The hour has* come for the Son of Man to be glorified. Unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit. So when He says to His mother my hour has not yet come, we should realize He knows that as soon as He reveals who He is and what He can do, He will be on a path that leads to His glorification: the crucifixion and resurrection. I bet Mary knew this, too.

And yet she immediately turns to the servers at the wedding feast and says do whatever he tells you. We should listen to Mary and trust that her Son is in control. He is God's beloved Son who came to save the entire world.

CATHOLIC MINISTRY APPEAL

Our old friend, the Annual Pastoral Appeal, is changing. Actually, it is going away and something new is



taking its place. For several years the Diocese has been studying the overall funding plan and asking for feedback from parishioners and pastors. As a result, APA was retired as of December 31, 2021.

The new plan is based on true discipleship. Instead of one large appeal that covers all the expenses of the Diocese, there will now be three new sources of funding:

- 1. The Catholic Ministries of the Diocese will be funded directly by you and me. The more we give, the more services these ministries can provide each year.
- 2. The administration of the Diocese will now be funded by a 2% Cathedraticum (a fancy word for tax) that every parish in the diocese has to pay.
- 3. Funding for services provided by the diocese to all parishes and schools will come from the earnings of a new Parish Support Trust the Diocese is establishing.

Your donations to the Catholic Ministry Appeal will go in the first "bucket", the one for Catholic Ministries. This means your donation goes directly and only to ministries and will not be used for any of the administrative costs that come with running the Diocese. Like in the past, each parish has a goal based on a "fair share" formula. Our goal for this year is \$143,848.

We hope we can count on you to help meet this goal. In fact, knowing how generous our parishioners have been in the past, we suspect we will exceed our goal and the ministries of the Diocese of St. Petersburg will be able to expand their services. Next week there will be more details about each of the three categories and how this change will affect the parish.
