A Message From the Pastor

I join the Florida Bishops in marking January 22nd as the 49th anniversary of the U.S. Supreme Court's decision



in Roe v. Wade. We should mourn the heartbreaking loss of over 62 million victims through abortion. The Catholic Church stands emphatically and unreservedly for the rights of the unborn and looks forward with hope that God will soon bring our nation to a profound awareness of the dignity of human life and a recognition that all lives deserve protection under the law.

It is especially encouraging that the U.S. Supreme Court has heard arguments in the Mississippi abortion case, Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization. This case addresses whether banning abortions after 15 weeks gestation is constitutional. Although difficult to predict, this could very well be the case that overturns Roe. Imagine if all believers across the country committed to daily prayer and fasting for a decision that honors the sanctity of unborn life through the Pray for Dobbs campaign (<u>www.prayfordobbs.com</u>).

One way the Church serves pregnant women and their families is through the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' initiative Walking with Moms in Need, which connects parishioners with volunteer opportunities at community pregnancy resource centers. This ministry offers tangible, life-affirming support for vulnerable families. As Pope Francis has said, "Among the most fragile are children who do not see the light because their mothers suffer economic, social and cultural conditioning that drives them to give up that wonderful gift that is the birth of child." (Address of His Holiness Pope Francis to the Hospital of the Innocents Institute, May 2019)

The Church seeks to be a beacon in a dark world and to serve as a field hospital to all who are contemplating or have been harmed by abortion. May we all recommit to highlighting the great good that is found in embracing life. Let's ask the Lord to guide and strengthen our elected and appointed officials at the state and federal levels to come to respect the sacredness of each human life, including the unborn. Let us continue to fight for a culture of life in all spheres so that our society may appreciate the truth that every person—no matter their size, ability, or location —is worth protecting.

As you found out last week in this column, the Annual Pastoral Appeal is going away and a new appeal, the Catholic Ministries Appeal, is starting soon. Our commitment weekend will be in early February. At that time, we hope you will make a commitment to support the Catholic Ministries of the Diocese of St. Petersburg through a monetary pledge. The more we give, the more services the ministries can provide.

If you recall, there are three sources of funding replacing the Annual Pastoral Appeal.

The first bucket is the Catholic Ministries Appeal. All parishioners are being asked to give directly to the first bucket, directly supporting ministries. 100% of every dollar donated to the Catholic Ministries Appeal will fund Catholic ministries and services that no single parish could accomplish on its own. They include:

- Catholic Charities
- The Office of Catholic Schools
- Vocation Promotion
- Seminarian Support & Formation

- Support of Retired Clergy & Religious
- Campus Ministry
- The Lay Pastoral Ministry Institute

The parish will contribute to the second bucket out of offertory income. The 2% Cathedraticum tax paid by each parish will fund:

- The Bishop's Office which is responsible for the governance and oversight of all diocesan entities and offices as well as all actions and functions the bishop must complete to fulfill his duty as shepherd of the people of God in the Diocese.
- The Chancellor's Office which oversees the archives of the diocese, provides clearance for visiting priests and missionaries, provides statistical reports for the Official Catholic Directory, the USCCB and the Roman Curia, is responsible for the Propagation of the Faith including the Missionary Cooperative Plan and oversees World Mission Sunday amongst many other duties.
- The annual contributions to organizational leadership of the Church:
 - The Florida Catholic Conference of Bishops representing the public policy voice of the Catholic Church in the State of Florida
 - US Conference of Catholic Bishops
 - The Papal Offices and the Holy See

The third bucket, earnings from the Parish Support Trust, includes:

- Human Resources support services
- Accounting and Finance support services
- Legal Services
- Information Technology support services
- Building and Real Estate support services




