### MESSAGE FROM FR. SEBASTIAN



DearParishioners and Guests,

Today we celebrate the Baptism of Jesus. At the beginning of Jesus Christ's ministry, He traveled from Galilee to the

Jordan River. John the Baptist preaching was there and baptizing the people. Jesus went to John and asked to be baptized. Jesus Christ set the example for us to be baptized. He commanded His followers to preach the Gospel and to baptize those who believe. So what is baptism? It is the first of seven sacraments and the way in which a person becomes a member of the Catholic Church.

The catechism teaches us that anyone can receive a Catholic baptism who has not already been baptized. There are no age restrictions for baptism; you cannot be too old or too young to be baptized. In extreme cases in which someone's life is in danger it can be performed by anyone, however this is normally done only by ordinary ministers – bishops and priests. They can delegate the responsibility to a deacon.

The most important thing is to use the Trinitarian Baptismal formula. It is: I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Baptizing someone twice is not necessary so long as the person was baptized in water using the Trinitarian formula described above. The only way someone could be "baptized again" is if the original baptism was not valid. However, this would not actually be a second baptism because the first "baptism" was not a real baptism. One way a baptism could be invalid is if the person baptizing uses a formula like "I baptize you in the name of Jesus, Mary, and all the Saints."

We need to remember that

baptism is a gift from God to humanity. It initiates us into the family of God and cleanses us of sin. We do not need to earn this gift. God gives it freely to all who are open to it. For someone who is baptized as an

infant, the personal response of faith comes as the child grows to respond to the graces given in baptism. When a child is baptized, the parents' faith speaks for the child who is too young to have explicit faith on his or her own. This is why the Church requires a reasonable hope that the parents will raise the child in the Catholic faith before a child is baptized.

What does the Grace of Baptism accomplish? 1. It forgives all sins that may have been committed prior to a person's baptism including original sin, mortal sins, and venial sins, and it relieves the punishment for those sins. 2. It makes the newly baptized person "a new creation. 3. It turns the person into a newly adopted son or daughter of Christ. 4. Baptism incorporates a person into the Church, which is the body of Christ. 5. It leaves a spiritual mark (character) of belonging to Christ on the soul. Nothing you can do will take away this mark even if you sin a million times. Those sins may prevent you from being open to the salvation God offers through baptism, but you will always carry the mark of a Christian on your soul.

Jesus was without sin but still completed this act. Through his baptism, he is showing that He is connected with sinners – sinners like you and me. When a person is baptized, they are choosing new life in Christ. When we are baptized we are able to walk in new life. Jesus joins us in baptism showing us that He's right there with us. We can't walk this journey of faith alone.






#### SAINT OF THE WEEK

Born a pagan, St. Hilary (c. 315 – c. 367) studied philosophy and the meaning of life, eventually making his way through the bible. He became a convert and was appointed bishop of Poitiers in 353. Sometimes referred to as the Hammer of the Arians, St. Hilary defended the Nicene Creed against a popular heresy, Arianism. He was exiled to Phrygia for opposing Roman emperor Constantius II, who preferred the heresy which denies Christ's divinity. From Phyrgia St. Hilary fought with his pen, zealously writing against the heresy.

Eventually he was allowed to return to Poitiers, but did so by a circuitous route, preaching against Arianism all the way. St. Hilary was likely the first writer of hymns in the West, his writings on the Trinity, Psalms and Gospel of Matthew survive today. St. Hilary was created Doctor of the Church, a title given to those who provided important contributions to theology and doctrine, in 1851 by Pope Pius IX.


