MESSAGE FROM FR. SEBASTIAN



Dear Parishioners and Guests,

We know that for us, Catholics, the most important book is the Bible. However there is one more very important book. It is the Catechism

of the CatholicChurch.

The catechism is an organized presentation of the essential teachings of the Catholic Church in regards to both faith and morals. When we talk about "the catechism" today we are most likely referring to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, promulgated by Pope John Paul II in 1992 to coincide with the 30th anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council.

For more than a decade bishops, theologians, and other experts worked on a "compendium of all Catholic doctrine regarding both faith and morals." The fruit of their work was the catechism, an organized presentation of the essential teachings of the Catholic Church in regard to both faith and morals, "in the light of the Second Vatican Council and the whole of the church's tradition."

The creation of an official, authoritative, and authentic reference text for teaching and transmitting Catholic doctrine was not new, however. In 1566 the so-called Roman Catechism was published in response to the request issued three years earlier by the Council of Trent. Used until 1978, it inspired, as intended, the creation of many national catechisms.

Often these national catechisms were in a question-and-answer format, bringing to life the very meaning of the word catechism, derived from the Greek verb "to echo." Students would, for centuries to come, repeat or echo the answers to the questions back to their teachers, who maybe hoped that the pupils would not only learn Catholic doctrine but echo the faith in their own lives.

In the United States the most famous of these Q&A catechisms is the Baltimore Catechism. Issued by the Third Plenary Council of Baltimore in 1884 and used until at least 1962, its 421 questions and answers became ingrained in the minds of millions of U.S. Catholic grammar school students who grew up before the council.

The Catechism can also be adapted for specific audiences. There is only one official Catechism of the Catholic Church, but it has been adapted in many different ways. Some adaptations seek to simplify the Catechism to make it easier for different audiences to read and understand it. YOUCAT is an effort to bring the Catechism to a teenage audience and put the sometimes technical language of the Catechism into terms young adults can easily understand. The United States Cátholic Catechism for Adults is a more condensed and reader friendly version of the Catechism for adults. In 2006 the U.S. bishops published the United States Catholic Catechism for Adults (USCCA), directed toward U.S. Catholics. Based on the CCC, it is written in light of the Catholic American experience and developed for the continuous formation and growth of adult Catholics.

But neither catechism is meant to stand alone as the only reference for Catholic teaching. It only contains small sections of the actual documents it references. The church's rich tradition, the Bible, and liturgy all illuminate each other and help us grow in faith, hope, and love.

The Vatican website makes the Catechism of the Catholic Church available to read for free. You can also download the Catechism for your Kindle. It is easy to find hard copies of the Catechism, too, if you prefer to read a traditional book. Just as the Church wants to make the Bible available to every Catholic, it also wants to make the Catechism available to all.




RESPECT LIFE WEEKEND: JANUARY 22 AND 23

Each year on January 22, all Catholic dioceses in the United States are called to observe a "Day of Prayer" for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. January 22 is the anniversary of the 1973 Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision that legalized abortion throughout our nation. Since then, over 60 million lives have been lost. That's more than the size of Italy's population.

We set aside January 22nd and 23rd to pray for the sanctity of life from conception to natural death, and the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life. This includes days of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion. We are each called to observe these days through the penitential practices of prayer, fasting and/ or giving alms. The act of abortion rejects God's gift of life. Abortion destroys the life of a child, lovingly knit together in his or her mother's womb, and for someone who has participated in abortion, the loss of a child can form a hole in their heart so deep that sometimes it seems nothing can fill the emptiness. As a human and Christian family, we grieve the loss of so many lives. And yet, even in our grief, we know there is hope. CHRIST came for the very purpose of redeeming our sins, offering us His forgiveness, and giving us His peace. Therefore, let us take courage and offer prayer and penance, that all human life would be welcomed in love and protected in law.

Thank you to all the parishioners and guests of Our Lady of the Angels Catholic Church. In 2021, you donated thousands of pounds of food and recently a check for \$1,100.00 in a monetary donation. Your contributions, along with assistances received from other community organizations, as well as food from Feeding Tampa Bay, have kept the costs to run the Food Pantry down to approximately \$16,000 per month.

The St. Joseph Food Pantry is the largest Food Pantry in Manatee County. Any eligible Manatee County resident is welcome to sign up and receive food once a month.

With your help, the St. Joseph Food Pantry was able to provide groceries, meat, toiletries, blankets, and calendars, to the families who made almost 17,000 visits to the Food Pantry. Those families included over 56,000 individuals with 18,837 being children.

The Thanksgiving Turkey Event on November 22nd and 23rd provided 860 turkeys and fixings to Food Pantry clients. Those families had almost 3,000 members.

To continue operating, the Food Pantry relies on a totally volunteer staff and the generosity of our donors. One positive outcome of the pandemic has been the outpouring of support for The St. Joseph Food Pantry.
