# Easter: The Summit of the Catholic Faith

*For the Easter Season Spread the Good News!*

The Easter Season, April 21, 2019 - June 9, 2109, the fifty days from the Sunday of Resurrection to Pentecost Sunday are celebrated in joy and exultation as one feast day, indeed as one “great Sunday.”

Throughout the Universal Church the faithful gathered for a joyous celebration on Easter; that is the Resurrection of Our Lord, the Summit of the Catholic Faith. Easter is not

“Feast of feasts,” the “Solemnity of solemnities.”

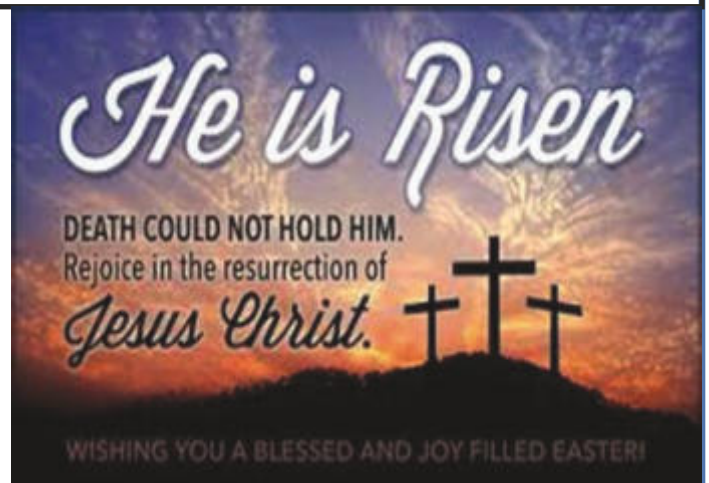
This celebration comes after the holiest of weeks which began with the entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday and included the institution of the Eucharist (Communion) during the Last Supper, Institution of the Sacrament of Holy Orders as well as the betrayal by Judas on Holy Thursday and the suffering and death of Our Lord on Good Friday. The Resurrection on Easter completes the journey for Jesus but it is just the beginning of a new journey of belief and hope for the Faithful, Bishop Frank J. Dewane explained during an Easter Vigil Mass on April 15 at Epiphany Cathedral in Venice.

“Tonight, represents a great night. When the power of death is conquered by Jesus Christ. When we have been given that promise of eternal life,” Bishop Dewane said.

The Bishop noted the Gospel reading from the Vigil provides guidance to carry the message of Easter forward. The Gospel of Mark (16:1-7) tells the story of the women who were going to treat the body of Jesus in the Jewish custom and wondered along the way about how to remove the stone over the tomb. Determined to go on despite their own doubts, they found the stone rolled to the side and the Gospel then reads: “On entering the tomb they saw a young man sitting on the right side, clothed in a white robe, and they were utterly amazed. He said to them, ‘Do not be amazed! You seek Jesus of Nazareth, the crucified. He has been raised; he is not here. Behold the place where they laid him. But go and tell his disciples and Peter, ‘He is going before you to Galilee; there you will see him, as he told you.’”

Bishop Dewane said we all need to look back to Scripture and recall those words, at that moment. “It is not just a story from the past. These words, from Jesus Christ, are for you, and for me. We have to read them anew and understand it is what Christ has told us.”

By listening to the what the Lord teaches, we let the love of Christ into your hearts. Therefore, we can approach the tomb ourselves, “with the same determination as the women who came to the tomb did,” the Bishop continued. “Don’t be afraid. Go forward. If we move forward with that same determination, the Lord will provide an angel to help you remove that stone. Remember to do what he told you. It’s in Scripture. Let it be in our hearts and let us live those words we have been told.”



# Pascua: La Cumbre de la Fe Católica

**¡Feliz Pascua Difunda la Buena Nueva!**

**El tiempo de Pascua, 9 de abril, 2019 al 9 de junio, 2019, los cincuenta días desde el domingo de Resurrección hasta domingo de Pentecostés son celebrados con júbilo y exultación como un día festivo, efectivamente como “un gran Domingo.”**

Por toda la Iglesia Universal los fieles se reúnen para una celebración jubilosa durante la Pascua; la Resurrección de Nuestro Señor, La cumbre de la Fe Católica. La Pascua no es simplemente una fiesta entre otras, sino la “Fiesta de Fiestas,” la “Solemnidad de solemnidades.”

Esta celebración llega después de la semana más santa que comenzó con la entrada de Jesús a Jerusalén en el Domingo de Ramos e incluyó la institución de la Eucaristía durante la Última Cena, la Institución del Sacramento de Ordenes Sacerdotales y también la traición de Judas en el Jueves Santo, y el sufrimiento y muerte de Nuestro Señor el Viernes Santo. La Resurrección de la Pascua completa el recorrido de Jesús, pero es solo el inicio del recorrido de fe y esperanza para los fieles, explicó el Obispo Frank J. Dewane durante una Misa de Vigilia Pascual en la Catedral de Venecia.

“Esta noche representa una gran noche. Cuando el poder de la muerte es vencido por Jesucristo. Cuando se nos da la promesa de vida eterna,” dijo el Obispo Dewane.

El Obispo señaló la lectura del Evangelio de la Vigilia y aconsejó promover el mensaje de la Pascua. El Evangelio de San Marcos (16:1-7) narra la historia de las mujeres que iban a preparar el cuerpo de Jesús según las costumbres judías y se preguntaban por el camino como iban a remover la piedra que cubría la tumba. Determinadas a proseguir a pesar de sus dudas, encontraron la piedra al lado y el Evangelio nos dice: “Entrando en el sepulcro, vieron un joven sentado a la derecha, vestido con una túnica blanca, y se quedaron muy asustadas. Él les dice: No os asustéis; buscáis a Jesús Nazareno, el crucificado. Ha resucitado, no está aquí; mirad el lugar donde lo colocaron. Pero marchaos y decid a sus discípulos y a Pedro que él va delante de vosotros a Galilea: allí le veris, como os dijo.”

El Obispo Dewane dijo, todos debemos repasar las Lecturas y recordar esas palabras, en ese momento. “No es solo una historia del pasado. Estas palabras, de Jesucristo, son para ti, y para mí. Debemos leerlas de nuevo y entender que eso mismo es lo que Jesucristo nos ha dicho a nosotros.”

Al escuchar lo que el Señor nos enseña, dejamos entrar el amor de Cristo en nuestros corazones. Por lo tanto, nosotros podemos acercarnos a la tumba “con la misma determinación que las mujeres” continuaba el Obispo. “No tengan miedo. Sigán Adelante. Si seguimos Adelante con esa misma determinación, el Señor mandará un ángel para ayudar a remover la piedra. Recuerden hacer lo que nos dijo. Esta en la Escritura. Dejemos que llegue a nuestros corazones y vivamos esas palabras que se nos han dicho. “

La Vigilia Pascual empezó en obscuridad antes de encender el fuego de Pascua y el Cirio Pascual llevado a una iglesia oscura con la proclamación que Cristo es nuestra Luz.
