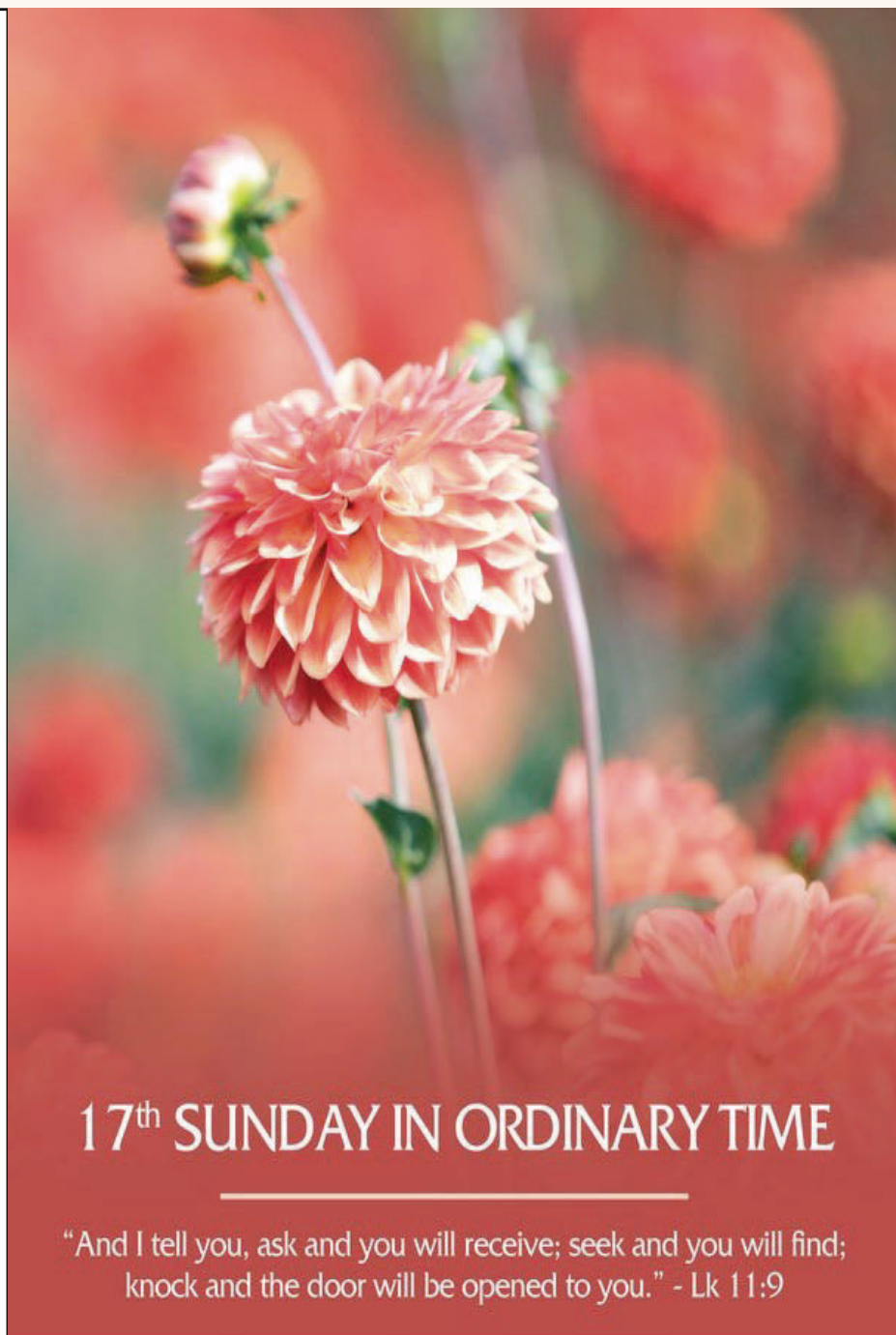

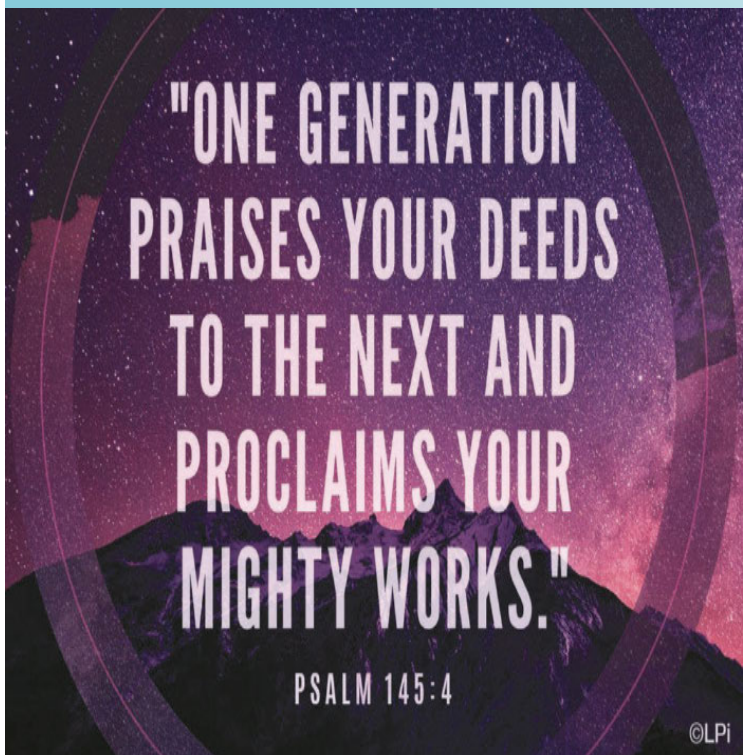

ST. JAMES (JULY 25TH)



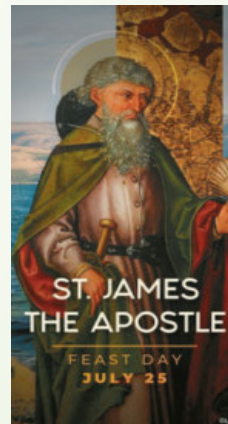
The core of our Christian faith is that the Risen Lord Jesus is alive and active among us, the members of his Body, right now. Yet during his own life he too needed spiritual nourishment; and so, today we see him praying, trying to discern how this journey to Jerusalem will go.

And his disciples ask him to teach them how to pray. Both his answer and the selection from Genesis show us that our persistent prayer can gain mercy and good things. Yet God is still God, and it is in the hallowing of God's Name and in carrying out God's will that we receive the best gift of all, the Holy Spirit within us.

- How does the "Our Father" help you understand what kind of relationship God wants to have with you?
- When have you found saying "Your will be done" to be liberating?
- What goes through your mind as you realize Jesus is teaching that God is not just his Father, but a Father to you as well?

Practice: As you ponder and pray over your day, conclude each petition, worry, or care by repeating several times: "Jesus, I surrender myself to you, take care of everything!"

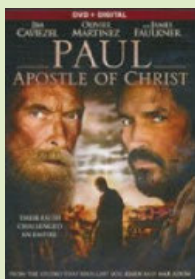
James, the brother of John the Evangelist, was the first Apostle to be martyred. He was beheaded by order of Herod of Agrippa. The Gospels tell us that the two brothers left their father, Zebedee, and followed Jesus as soon as He called out to them. James was one of the three Apostles who were particularly close to the Lord. He was there with the Lord and his brother, John, and Peter at the Transfiguration and in the Garden of Gethsemane.

He is known as James "the Greater" to distinguish him from the other Apostle by the same name. The title has little to do with his function or the people's regard for him. Rather, it was a term indicating that he was the elder of the two.

He is the patron saint of Spain and of pilgrims. In northwestern Spain, he is venerated at Santiago de Compostela, a mediaeval pilgrimage site that is still very popular today.

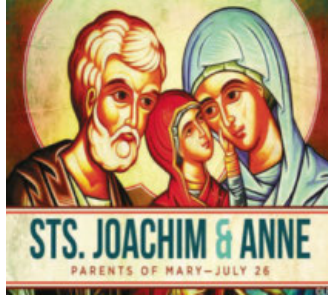

STS. ANNE AND JOACHIM (JULY 26TH)



On July 26 the Roman Catholic Church commemorates the parents of the Virgin Mary, Saints Joachim and Anne. The couple's faith and perseverance brought them through the sorrow of childlessness, to the joy of conceiving and raising the immaculate and sinless woman who would give birth to Christ.

The New Testament contains no specific information about the lives

of the Virgin Mary's parents, but other documents outside of the Biblical canon do provide some details. Although these writings are not considered authoritative in the same manner as the Bible, they outline some of the Church's traditional beliefs about Joachim, Anne and their daughter.

The "Protoevangelium of James," which was probably put into its final written form in the early second century, describes Mary's father Joachim as a wealthy member of one of the Twelve Tribes of Israel. Joachim was deeply grieved, along with his wife Anne, by their childlessness. "He called to mind Abraham," the early Christian writing says, "that in the last day God gave him a son Isaac."

Joachim and Anne began to devote themselves to rigorous prayer and fasting, in isolation from one another and from society. They regarded their inability to conceive a child as a surpassing misfortune, and a sign of shame among the tribes of Israel.

As it turned out, however, the couple were to be blessed even more abundantly than Abraham and Sarah. An angel revealed this to Anne when he appeared to her and prophesied that all generations would honor their future child: "The Lord has heard your prayer, and you shall conceive, and shall bring forth; and your seed shall be spoken of in all the world."

After Mary's birth, according to the Protoevangelium of James, Anne "made a sanctuary" in the infant girl's room, and "allowed nothing common or unclean" on account of the special holiness of the child. The same writing records that when she was one year old, her father "made a great feast, and invited the priests, and the scribes, and the elders, and all the people of Israel."

"And Joachim brought the child to the priests," the account continues, "and they blessed her, saying: 'O God of our fathers, bless this child, and give her an everlasting name to be named in all generations' ... And he brought her to the chief priests; and they blessed her, saying: 'O God most high, look upon this child, and bless her with the utmost blessing, which shall be forever.'"

The protoevangelium goes on to describe how Mary's parents, along with the temple priests, subsequently decided that she would be offered to God as a consecrated Virgin for the rest of her life, and enter a chaste marriage with the carpenter Joseph.

St. Joachim and St. Anne have been a part of the Church's liturgical calendar for many centuries. Devotion to their memory is particularly strong in the Eastern Catholic churches, where their intercession is invoked by the priest at the end of each Divine Liturgy. The Eastern churches, however, celebrate Sts. Joachim and Anne on a different date, Sept. 9.

Prayer is necessary it is not an option! Just as we need food to survive physically, we need food to survive spiritually as St. Augustine tells us: "Prayer is also called the food of the soul, because the body cannot be supported without food; nor can the soul, be kept alive without prayer: 'As the flesh is nourished by food, so is man supported by prayers.' Prayer is how we come to know God and to nurture our relationship with Him. All friendships and relationships need time and effort. Our relationship with God is no different. We cannot live spiritually without God- talking with Him; listening to Him; praising Him; and just being in His presence. He longs for us more than we long for Him. He takes great delight in us as His children. It is important to set aside specific time each day to pray as well as lifting our hearts and minds to the Lord throughout our day. The Church invites the faithful to regular prayer: daily prayers, the Liturgy of the Hours, Sunday Eucharist, the feasts

Expressions of Prayer

Vocal Prayer is an essential element of the Christian life as Jesus Himself taught us. As human beings we are body and spirit so need to express our feelings externally. Yet it is most important that the heart should be present to him to whom we are speaking in prayer: "Whether or not our prayer is heard depends not on the number of words, but on the fervor of our souls."

Meditation is above all a quest. The mind seeks to understand the why and how of the Christian life, in order to adhere and respond to what the Lord is asking. We are usually helped by books: the Sacred Scriptures, particularly the Gospels, holy icons, liturgical texts of the day or season, writings of the spiritual fathers, works of spirituality, the great book of creation, and that of history the page on which the "today" of God is written.

Contemplative Prayer Contemplative prayer is the simple expression of the mystery of prayer. It is a gaze of faith fixed on Jesus, an attentiveness to the Word of God, a silent love. It achieves real union with the prayer of Christ to the extent that it makes us share in his mystery.

WHAT IS A SMALL CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY (SCC)?

- A group of 8 to 10 people meet weekly (or once a month) in someone's home to study Sunday's scripture readings. Each person discovers, at their own pace, how God has been actively loving them and helping them. In this environment, mutual trust grows, and members share their individual faith stories. The group becomes a small church in the large parish, so that everyone experiences the concern, prayer, and emotional support of the Body of Christ.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE PART OF A GROUP CALLED "COMMUNITY?"

- This is more than a bunch of people gathering for a meeting every week. SCCs are people of similar beliefs meeting WITH ("com") UNITY. Oneness does not mean alikeness; rather it means agreeing to join in the journey of uniting ourselves to God and His love. Members feel connected to each other due to sharing their faith week after week, but it is more than that. Groups will occasionally gather outside the meetings for social events such as barbecues and pool parties, with all family members invited. During parish missions or retreats, they often attend together and go out for coffee afterward. Why? Because the love flowing between the members cannot be contained within a mere hour and a half meeting per week.



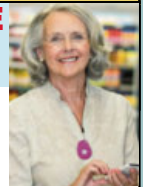

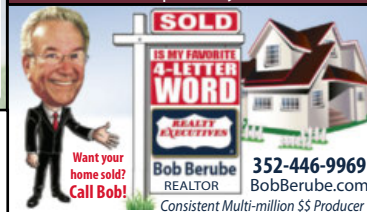
