

## GO DEEPER into Today's Gospel



Any builder worth his or her salt knows the value and importance of a cornerstone. Properly laying and securing this primary unit determines how the rest of the project unfolds and its success. Cornerstones are necessary elements not only of buildings but of

lives as well. Many human beings conduct the business of their lives paying little attention to a grounding reference or starting point. Hence, what unfolds is a tapestry of relativism, with few anchors or guideposts and many impulsive choices. Some consider love to be their cornerstone. While this may sound attractive and useful, the pursuit of love without a simultaneous pursuit of its source can be shallow and self-focused. Just because a person chooses to do no harm and love others does not mean that they are living in truth and properly anchored to the real cornerstone.

Jesus is the true and authentic cornerstone and shepherd. It is only in following the Risen One as the way, the truth, and the life that we can move from being well grounded ethical people to properly focused moral ones. Proper conduct, a true sense of justice, wisdom, virtue, moral principles, faith, hope, and love will be difficult to find unless we listen to the right Voice. It is when we learn to listen to the voice of God that we begin our journey on the road to salvation. It is only the Good Shepherd, the authentic and solid cornerstone, who can guide us through life's questions and challenges and bring us to the safe and proper pasture.

A person's life only has meaning when the cornerstone is properly selected and set. Understanding themselves only as random acts of creation, existing without intent or purpose, will color their choices and influence their decisions. The foundation of their lives will be simply a matter of preference and choice, leaving benchmarks of growth and higher ideals optional to pursue. Whereas people who believe that they are fashioned and loved into existence by a God who purposely made them, have this incredible unconditional relationship at their source which has tremendous significance. Their allegiance is not to themselves but to their Creator. Life, then, is an adventure in search of this Creator God and a journey of self-discovery that seeks to unite their will to His. There is a cost. We have to give up our life in order to gain our life. As ironic as that sounds, it is true. It is only when we finally figure this out that the true cornerstone of our lives will be properly laid and we can, with God's help, get about the business of properly constructing a temple that endures.

### Next Sunday's Readings

5th Sunday of Easter

Acts	9:26-31
1 John	3:18-24

TODAY IS KNOWN AS GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY because, in each year of the liturgical cycle on this 4th Sunday of Easter, the Gospel is always taken from the 10th chapter of John where Jesus speaks of himself as the "good shepherd".

This is intimately linked with the second theme of this Sunday. Not only is it **Good Shepherd Sunday**, it is also **Vocations Sunday**. On this day we are especially asked to pray that the Church may be provided with the Spirit-filled leaders needed to do its work of spreading the Gospel.

We have for too long given a much too narrow meaning to the word 'vocation'. We tend to limit it to a calling to be a priest or a member of a religious institute. But, in fact, every single one of us has a vocation!

**We should ask ourselves today:**

- *Is what I am spending my energies on every day my real vocation?*
- *Is this what God wants me to be doing with my life?*
- *How is what I am doing giving witness to my Christian faith?*
- *What contribution am I offering to making this world a better place for people to live in?*
- *To what extent am I a spreader of truth, of love, of justice, of freedom, of tolerance and acceptance...?*



## Blessed Chiara Luce Badano

October 29, 1971 - October 7, 1990

In 1971, after praying and hoping for a baby for more than 10 years, Ruggero and Teresa Badano of Sassello, Italy, welcomed a little girl whom they named Chiara.

Even at the age of four, Chiara seemed aware of the needs of others. She would sort through her toys to give some to poor children, and she would never give away just the old or broken ones. She invited less-fortunate people into the family's home for holidays and visited the elderly at a retirement center. When other children were sick and confined to bed, Chiara visited them. She loved the stories of the Gospel and loved to attend Mass.

When she was 9, Chiara became involved with the Focolare movement and its branch for young people. Focolare emphasizes brotherhood and unity among all people.

Chiara was very popular. She had a lot of friends, she played sports, and she loved to sing and dance. But when asked, she said she did not try to bring Jesus to her friends with words. She tried to bring Jesus to them with her example and how she lived her life.

When she was 17, Chiara learned she had a very serious form of bone cancer. Treatments were painful and unsuccessful. She became paralyzed. One day someone asked her if she hoped to walk again, and her answer was no. When she suffered, she felt closer to Jesus. She even refused to take pain medication that would make her too sleepy to continue to live her life.

Despite her illness and being confined to bed, Chiara wrote letters and sent messages to others. She attended Focolare youth meetings. She inspired everyone who she encountered with her faith and love for others. She gave all her savings to a friend who was becoming a missionary in Africa. When her life was nearly at an end, she said, "I have nothing left, but I still have my heart, and with that I can always love."

Chiara died in 1990. Within nine years, the bishop of her diocese began the work on her cause for canonization. Pope Benedict XVI declared her "Blessed" in 2010. "Only Love with a capital L gives true happiness," and that's what Chiara showed her family, her friends and her fellow members of the Focolare movement, the pope said.

She was a normal, everyday girl, and possibly a normal, everyday saint. Chiara's brief life showed us how much one person can accomplish in God's name.







DIOCESE OF VENICE IN FLORIDA  
OFFICE OF THE BISHOP

**Per Bishop Frank Dewane, beginning MAY 1, 2021, the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days will be lifted.**

ONGOING GUIDELINES AS OF APRIL 9, 2021

FOR THE CELEBRATION OF MASS:

- The following persons are *not* obligated to attend Mass:
  - Those who are ill, confined to their home, hospital, or nursing facility as well as their caregivers;
  - Those who have reason to believe they were recently exposed to Covid- 19;
  - Those who have underlying health conditions or are in a high-risk category;
  - Those who have a reasonable fear or anxiety of becoming ill if they attend Mass.
- **It remains essential that all in attendance at Mass continue to wear a mask** — this measure is vital to allowing these updated guidelines to be adopted.
- Parishes should continue to Live-Stream Masses.
- **Distancing should be adapted to three feet between persons who are not from the same household. With this change, it will no longer be necessary to block every other row of pews.** Parishioners may be seated in a staggered fashion, while respecting three feet of distance.
- No division should be made according to one's vaccination status.
- Deacons, Readers, Servers, and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion should resume their duties in the celebration of Mass. In the case of Servers, this may not necessarily include all of their prior responsibilities, but Parishes are strongly encouraged to bring Servers back.
- A cantor is permitted, and limited choirs may resume. It is envisioned that this will be smaller groups and not a full choir. Masks should be worn by choir members.
- Weekday Masses should continue in the main church, not a chapel. ***Our chapel will remain closed.***
- Hospitality Ministers and Ushers should not make physical contact when greeting Parishioners.
- Priests, Deacons, Readers, Servers, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Ushers, and Sacristans are to continue following prescribed handwashing and sanitizing practices.
- **The Offertory Procession may return**, provided that all involved sanitize their hands.
- Parishes should continue to carry out the collection in the manner they have presently adopted.

GUIDELINES AS OF APRIL 9, 2021 - CONTINUED

- It continues to be necessary that there be no physical contact during the Sign of Peace. Recall that the Sign of Peace is an optional part of the Mass.
- **Parishioners will come forward to receive Communion — bringing Eucharist to parishioners in the pews will cease — with parishioners responsible for maintaining reasonable distance during the procession.**
- At this time, the Precious Blood should not be distributed to the Faithful.

GUIDELINES RELATED TO THE CHURCH BUILDING:


- **Sanitizing the church after Mass will stop.** It has been demonstrated that Covid-19 is an airborne disease.
- Hand sanitizer should be available at all church entrances and in the Sanctuary where it can be easily used by Celebrants, Extraordinary Ministers and others serving at the Mass.
- **Paper bulletins may be distributed only as people exit the Church.**

SACRAMENTAL AND PARISH LIFE:

- Visits to the homebound for Communion should resume with appropriate caution. Further, parishes should seek to visit sick parishioners in hospitals and nursing homes.
- Parishes are encouraged to offer Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. *Starting May 7 our parish will resume First Friday Adoration from 11:30AM-3PM.*
- Churches should also be open for visitation (remembering that contagion from surfaces does not pose the significant threat as was originally thought). ***Starting May 3 our church will stay open until 3PM daily for private prayer (unless a funeral is taking place). The chapel will remain closed.***
- Parish group activities may resume. This includes, but is not limited to: Bible Studies, Bereavement Ministry, Youth Group, Knights of Columbus, and Rosary Groups. Masks must be worn, and distancing observed at group activities.

*During this year dedicated to St. Joseph, the Faithful are encouraged to turn to his intercession for protection and courage. Let us be mindful in prayer of those who are no longer with us and those who continue in their recovery. May God bless you and your family.*

Are you looking to the world for an answer? Are you looking in the mirror, expecting to find a solution to your problems? Are you expecting happiness, peace, contentment or justice to come from any place other than God?

“It is better to take refuge in the Lord than to put confidence in princes,” the Psalms tell us. Well, I’ve never put much confidence in princes. But when it comes to problems, I often find myself telling God to take a step back – “I’ve got this.”

It’s tough to pray about any problem as much as you talk about it. We want so badly to tackle the issue ourselves. But I’ll let you in on a secret: it doesn’t matter what the question is, we don’t have the answer. Take it to the One who does.

## May Monthly Days of Prayer & Ignatian Preached Retreat


at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Retreat and Spirituality Center (3989 S. Moon Dr., Venice, FL)

Conference topics center on Ignatian spirituality, prayer, and discernment.


