Don't you just love to sing Christmas songs? If you are like me, there's nothing quite like Christmas Eve and Silent Night. It just gets into your soul, doesn't it?

We invite you to commit to giving a present to Jesus this year for Christmas - that's the gift of your voice. We in the Music Ministry want to reach out to each one of you and invite you to join us in singing every song and every Mass part on Christmas and for the rest of the church year! You can do it from your pew - with your family - without committing to any practices - and at whatever mass you choose to attend - without joining any of our ministries!

You might say — "I can't read music!" Frankly, neither can a whole lot of us. Some of us don't know a B flat from a flat tire! Or you might say I don't have any musical talent. Where in the Bible does it say to make a loud noise with horn and cymbal but only if you have musical talent? (It doesn't) Or worse of all you might say "I can't sing!" or even worse "I have a terrible voice." Well, that's just not true. God made your voice. He doesn't make junk — he gave you your voice — he has known what it would sound like since.... well actually he has always known because he has always known that you would be here at this time and with your voice.

So why have you decided he doesn't want to hear your voice? He wants to hear it out loud. See there's a beautiful thing that happens when many people sing – the music just sounds better – we add to each other's voices and make a truly wonderful noise unto the Lord! In almost every mass I attend, inevitably I hear a small child cry out in the middle of mass. Some people say, "take that child to the cry room!" I say, "Lets all be like that child!" That kid has it right!! Call out to God at the top of your voice! Sing out to God with all your heart! Let the music kindle your faith. It's a gift that all of you can give to our savior. It's the gift of you!

So, this Christmas SING OUT. Pull out that missalette and join in the songs. We don't call curselves a choir – choirs perform for an audience. We are of you – we are from you – we are you. Join us all in singing and praising God.

And if you are inspired, talk to me about the Contemporary Music Ministry – we are a come as you are band – we don't have auditions and we practice before mass. Or if you like a contemporary approach – and who does not love to hear some of the traditional mighty songs of praise sometimes - then speak to Rocky about joining the Sunday Music Ministry. Or if you love Christian Contemporary Praise band music – like Matt Maher (a Catholic) other current singers – join the new Praise Music Ministry. Most of all – please just SING!





### The Diocese of St. Augustine for Parents who Home School Their Children

- .. Families must register with the parish and be in communication with the religious education office.
- Home school families are defined as those families who provide education, including religious faith formation, in their homes following a standardized curriculum. Families who seek to use the parish program for religious education only when it is convenient with the scheduling of secular activities are not covered in this definition of home school family.
- Families are obligated to use the same religious education text as the parish religious education program during the sacramental years.
- The Pastor or his delegate for religious education should require a periodic progress report to be made by home school parents.
- Home School families must submit enrollment document from the Home School Program for previous and current year.
