





The Diocese of St. Augustine for Parents who Home School Their Children

- .. Families must register with the parish and be in communication with the religious education office.
- Home school families are defined as those families who provide education, including religious faith formation, in their homes following a standardized curriculum. Families who seek to use the parish program for religious education only when it is convenient with the scheduling of secular activities are not covered in this definition of home school family.
- Families are obligated to use the same religious education text as the parish religious education program during the sacramental years.
- The Pastor or his delegate for religious education should require a periodic progress report to be made by home school parents.
- Home School families must submit enrollment document from the Home School Program for previous and current year.


