Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

I am happy to publish this letter with the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of Saint Josaphat in Parma's 2024 financial statements.

Each year we post our financial statements online and distribute them to all the Eparchy's priests and parishes. The Eparchy's Financial Officer, Father Steven Paliwoda, includes a detailed letter to orient the reader to the statements and explain any significant differences from the prior year. His letter helps one focus on the "big picture", along with the year-to-year changes, so I encourage you to refer to it as you review the statements. These annual disclosures make the Eparchy one of the most transparent Catholic dioceses in the world with regard to financial affairs.

I have asked our priests for the past decade to practice the same kind of transparency in our parishes. **Every parish should be audited by an outside accountant and publish its financial statements for its parishioners to see.** Smaller parishes that lack the funds necessary for a full audit should still prepare financial statements which are at least reviewed by an outside accountant. You should be able to view your parish financial statements each year. It is important for the Church to be accountable to the faithful – you – for whom the Church exists to serve!

I offer the following general observations about the Eparchy's 2024 financial statements:

- ✓ The Eparchy's financial situation remains stable. Fourteen years ago, the Eparchy was in a desperate financial situation in which it was more than \$1 million in debt, was significantly behind in paying its bills (including property insurance premiums), and had a large annual operating deficit. Today, the Eparchy has no external debt, is current on all its bills and is running a small surplus. This is thanks to the support of the faithful and outside foundations who place their trust in us. **Thank you.**
- ✓ The Eparchy's revenue (income) in 2024 was in line with 2023, and the Eparchy had a net positive income from its own operations in 2024, albeit slightly less than in 2023. (This is after excluding the effect of donations for Ukraine and distributions to Ukraine.) Between the time of the full-scale Russian invasion of Ukraine in February 2022 and the end of 2024, hundreds of generous individuals and foundations made donations totaling more than \$1,000,000 to the Eparchy to help Ukraine. The inclusion of these donations and distributions in the Eparchy's 2022, 2023 and 2024 financial statements made the revenue and net income far greater than it would have otherwise been in 2022; and made the net income in 2023 and 2024 less than it otherwise would have been (because distributions to Ukraine were greater than income for Ukraine in those years). If donations for Ukraine and distributions to Ukraine are excluded from the 2023 and 2024 financial statements, the Eparchy operated at about a \$150,000 surplus in 2023 and a \$57,000 surplus in 2024.

- ✓ Support from foundations and individuals remained strong. The Eparchy's Stewardship Office continues to produce excellent results, and the faithful continued to generously support the Eparchy in 2024. The Stewardship Office secured over \$280,000 in grants from foundations like Catholic Home Missions, Catholic Extension Society, the Heritage Foundation of First Security Federal Savings Bank, the Koch Foundation, and others in 2024. We did not have our biennial in-person fundraising events for the Eparchy in 2024, so income from events was down in 2024 from 2023; but we will resume the biennial events in the Cleveland and Pittsburgh metropolitan areas in 2025.
- ✓ Costs continue to rise. Elevated costs resulting from high inflation in America in 2021-22 are unfortunately a fact of life; most prices have not declined to their pre-COVID levels. In addition, some costs have increased substantially (in the case of property insurance, the increase was over 20% in 2024 alone, and 79% since 2021). We continue to try to cut costs and be efficient, but operating expenses continue to rise.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank Father Steven Paliwoda, the Eparchy's Financial Officer; Father Vsevolod Shevchuk, Assistant Financial Officer; John F. Kurey, Esq., MBA, Stewardship Director; Yevhen Gulenko, administrative assistant; as well as Michael Simic and his colleagues at Simic CPA Company.

I would also like to thank you for your support for your parish, the Eparchy, and the Ukrainian Catholic Church. Our future depends upon your financial support; you provide the resources the Eparchy needs to continue to serve you. Moreover, by supporting the Eparchy, you ensure we can continue to assist our brothers and sisters who are suffering in Ukraine.

Please be as generous as possible to the Church through your weekly giving, remembering the Eparchy in your will or estate plan, or naming the Eparchy as the beneficiary of an insurance policy or Individual Retirement Account. 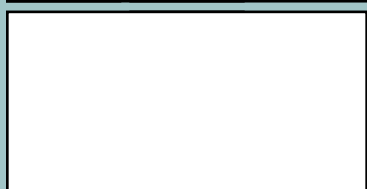

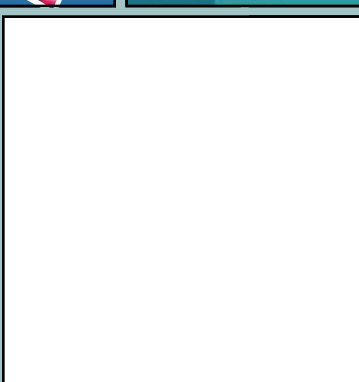
