The priest will not process into church or recess, we are asking you NOT to offer a sign of peace, to receive Jesus in your hand while STANDING. Thank you for understanding and know that its your health and well-being that motivate such changes and requests.

DISPENSATION UPDATE / ACTUALIZACIÓN SOBRE LA DISPENSA

Re: Update on dispensation, in-parish worship and access to parish facilities

Peace and all good to you!

COVID-19 continues to be a concern for our world. As the virus mutates and researchers learn more about best practices, we will continue to revise these guidelines. I hope you will check back often for updates. I deeply appreciate your patience and flexibility.

On May 22, prior to the celebration of the Vigil of Pentecost, the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass expired in the Archdiocese of Atlanta. While the general dispensation has lifted, I put into place some exceptions for certain circumstances. They are outlined below. Our general guidelines and procedures are outlined after the exceptions.

While the general dispensation is removed, there are specific instances where the dispensation is applicable, as well as some circumstances in which there is no obligation in the first place. One does not have an obligation to attend Mass on Sunday in the following circumstances:

1. You are ill or you have a health condition that would be significantly compromised if you were to contract a communicable illness (i.e., you have underlying conditions or are in a high-risk category). Please use the dispensation and do not attend Mass.
2. You are experiencing flu-like symptoms.
3. You have been exposed to someone who has tested positive or you have reason to think you might be asymptomatic of a contagious illness.
4. You care for the sick, homebound, or infirm.
5. You are pregnant.
6. You are 65 years of age or older (per the CDC's recommendation of high-risk individuals).
7. You cannot attend Mass through no fault of your own (e.g., no Mass is offered, you are infirm, your ride did not show up, the church was at capacity).
8. You have significant fear or anxiety of becoming ill by being at Mass.

Asunto: Actualización sobre la dispensa, el culto en las parroquias y el acceso a las instalaciones parroquiales

¡Paz y bien para ustedes!

COVID-19 continúa siendo una preocupación para nuestro mundo. A medida que el virus cambia y los investigadores aprendan más sobre las mejores prácticas para combatirlo, seguiremos revisando estas directrices. Espero que recirran a ellas con frecuencia para ver las actualizaciones. Agradezco profundamente su paciencia y flexibilidad.

El 22 de mayo, antes de la celebración de la Vigilia de Pentecostés, la dispensa general de la obligación de asistir a la misa dominical terminó en la Arquidiócesis de Atlanta. Si bien la dispensa general ya no existe, he establecido algunas excepciones para determinadas circunstancias, las cuales se describen a continuación. Nuestras directrices y procedimientos generales se describen después de las excepciones.

Aunque la dispensa general ha sido removida, hay casos específicos en los que seguirá siendo aplicable, así como algunas circunstancias en las que no hay obligación en primer lugar. Una persona no tiene la obligación de asistir a la misa dominical bajo las siguientes circunstancias:

1. Si está enferma o tiene una condición de salud que se vería significativamente comprometida si contrajera una enfermedad transmisible (es decir, tiene condiciones subyacentes o se encuentra en una categoría de alto riesgo). Por favor utilice la dispensa y no asista a misa.
2. Si tiene síntomas similares a los de la gripe.
3. Si ha estado expuesta a alguien que dio positivo en la prueba o tiene motivos para pensar que podría ser asintomática de una enfermedad contagiosa.
4. Si cuida a personas enfermas, confinadas en su hogar o débiles.
5. Si está embarazada.
6. Si tiene 65 años de edad o más (según la recomendación de los CDC para personas de alto riesgo).
7. Si no puede asistir a misa por causas ajenas a su voluntad (por ejemplo, no hay una misa disponible, está enferma, no tiene transporte, la iglesia está llena).
8. Si tiene mucho miedo o ansiedad de enfermarse si asiste a misa.

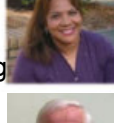

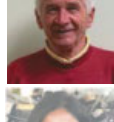

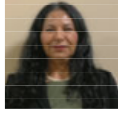
