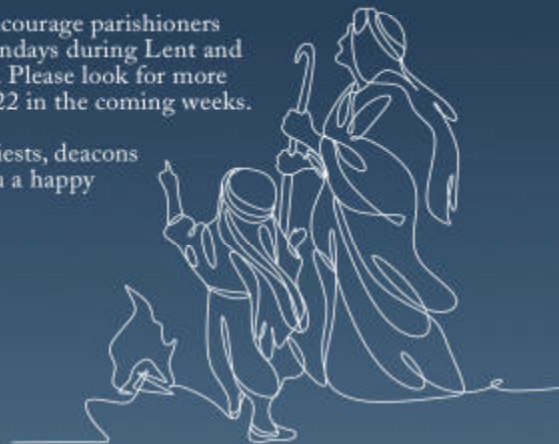
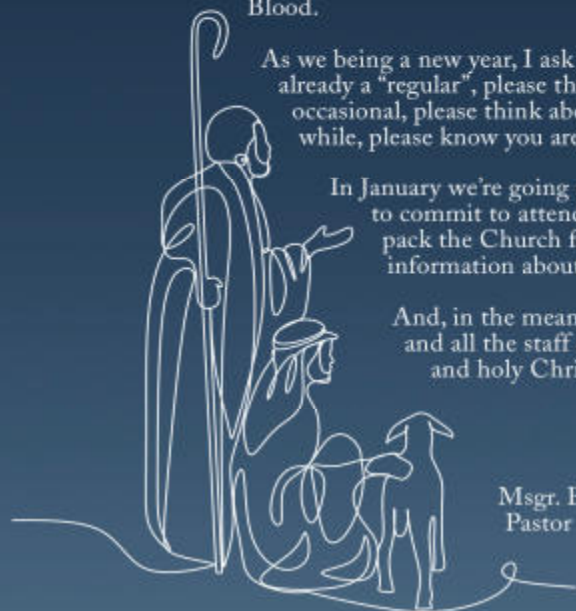

Jn 2,9), pues se había formado en ella por obra del Espíritu Santo, y sabía que ese mismo «poder» creador resucitaría a Jesús, como él mismo había prometido.*

*Así, la fe de María sostuvo la de los discípulos hasta el encuentro con el Señor resucitado, y siguió acompañándolos incluso después de su Ascensión al cielo, a la espera del «bautismo en el Espíritu Santo» (cf. Hch 1,5)...Precisamente por eso María es para todas las generaciones imagen y modelo de la Iglesia, que juntamente con el Espíritu camina en el tiempo invocando la vuelta gloriosa de Cristo: «¡Ven, Señor Jesús!» Benedicto XVI, Papa.*
