


Evelyn Waugh (1903-1966) converted to Catholicism in 1930. Like several of the characters from his masterpiece, Brideshead Revisited (1945), Waugh led a life of dissipation until his final year at Oxford in 1924. The novel follows the life of Charles Ryder from 1920-1943 and his interactions with a wealthy and aristocratic Catholic family. Regarding Brideshead, the author states: "The whole thing is steeped in theology...".

In February, the group will meet on Thursday, February 10 via Zoom and read Gillgamesh. The anonymous epic *Gillgamesh* is the oldest written work of any human civilization – dating 1,500 years before Homer. In 1872 a British scholar claimed that the work contains an account of the flood - and has enjoyed wide readership since then. The poem, which includes themes of loss and pain, traces the tragic story of the part god hero.


