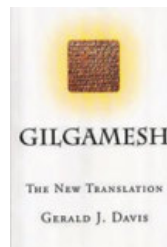
VOLUNTEERS NEEDED TO ASSIST WITH FUNERAL RECEPTION COMMITTEE
