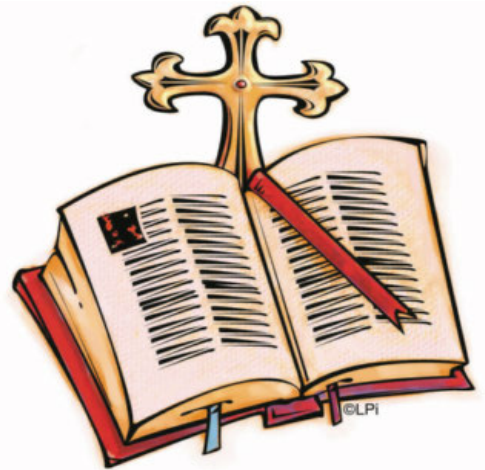

### Inspiration for the week

## The Most Holy Trinity



In creative celebration of the Most Holy Trinity, pray a rosary with creation. Find a quiet place outside or sit near a window. Contemplate the amazing Divine Gift that is before you. Admire it. Study it. Become one with it. Ask for the guidance of Brother St. Francis as you pray: *“You, Holy Father, are King of heaven and earth. You are three in one, God above all gods. You are good, all good, and supreme good, Lord God, living and true. You are love. You are beauty. You are gentleness. You are joy. You are hope and happiness.”* Admire the wonder and majesty of God in all that is around you. Ask for wisdom and understanding.

Begin each decade with the Our Father and conclude with the Glory Be.

**Decade one:** Contemplate God the Father. As you pray each bead with a Hail Mary, get lost in the grandeur of all that you see. Imagine the thousands and thousands of years of history that is before you. Envision a time when nothing existed. What is nothing? Lift your eyes, heart, and soul to the power and magnificence of the universe, its expanse and its endlessness. You are one with it all. God’s creative power.

**Decade two:** Contemplate God the Son. Behold the squirrels, birds, and critters all conducting life’s business. They have heartbeats just like yours. Praying each bead, become one with the incarnate divine life that flows through you and flows with the smallest of creatures. It is holy innocence and blessed life. Tenderness. Compassion, Mercy. Reverence. All want to be held, have a home, and be loved. God in all things. Emmanuel.

**Decade three:** Contemplate God the Holy Spirit. The changing of times and seasons happens often without notice. It is all within God’s care and guided. We all belong. Behold the living, dying, and rising to new life. You are one with all time from beginning into eternity.

**Decade Four:** Contemplate God as One.

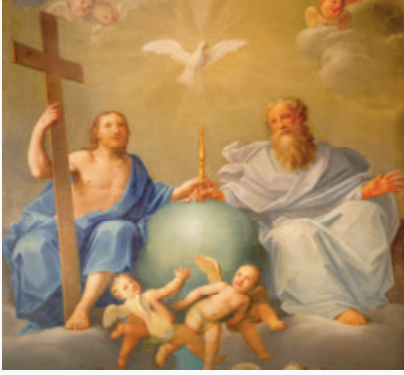
**Decade Five:** Contemplate God as three. All different while remaining one. The divine dance is being danced before you. Rest in what you see. Become what you see. We are all connected: God of the Holy Trinity, creation, our brothers and sisters, the animals, and the plants.

The rosary you have prayed celebrates the circle of connectedness and the intimate relationship we share with all things: a glimpse of the Trinity.





## Misterio de la Santa Trinidad un solo Dios.



En esta fiesta en la que celebramos a Dios: el misterio de un único Dios y este Dios es el Padre y el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo. ¡Tres personas, pero Dios es uno! El Padre es Dios, el Hijo es Dios, el Espíritu es Dios. Pero no son tres dioses: es un solo Dios en tres personas. Es un misterio que nos ha revelado Jesucristo: la Santa Trinidad. Hoy nos detenemos a celebrar este misterio, porque las Personas no son adjetivaciones de Dios: no. Son personas reales, distintas, diferentes; no son -como decía aquel filósofo- “emanaciones de Dios”: ¡no, no! Son personas. Está el Padre, al que rezo con el Padre Nuestro; está el Hijo que me ha dado la redención, la justificación; está el Espíritu Santo que habita en nosotros y habita en la Iglesia. Y esto nos habla al

corazón, porque lo encontramos encerrado en esa frase de San Juan que resume toda la revelación: “Dios es amor”. El Padre es amor, el Hijo es amor, el Espíritu Santo es amor. Y en cuanto es amor, Dios, aunque es uno y único, no es soledad sino comunión, entre el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo. Porque el amor es esencialmente don de sí mismo, y en su realidad originaria e infinita es Padre que se da generando al Hijo, que a su vez se da al Padre, y su amor mutuo es el Espíritu Santo, vínculo de su unidad. No es fácil entenderlo, pero se puede vivir este misterio; todos nosotros; se puede vivir tanto.

Este misterio de la Trinidad nos fue desvelado por el mismo Jesús. Él nos hizo conocer el rostro de Dios como Padre misericordioso; se presentó a Sí mismo, verdadero hombre, como Hijo de Dios y Verbo del Padre, Salvador que da su vida por nosotros y habló del Espíritu Santo que procede del Padre y del Hijo, Espíritu de la Verdad, Espíritu Paráclito- el domingo pasado hablamos de esta palabra “paráclito”- es decir, Consolador y Abogado. Y cuando Jesús se apareció a los apóstoles después de la Resurrección, Jesús los mandó a evangelizar “a todas las gentes, bautizándolas en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo” (Mt 28,19).

La fiesta de hoy, pues, nos hace contemplar este maravilloso misterio de amor y luz del que procedemos y hacia el cual se orienta nuestro camino terrenal.

En el anuncio del Evangelio y en toda forma de la misión cristiana, no se puede prescindir de esta unidad a la que llama Jesús, entre nosotros, siguiendo la unidad del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo: no se puede prescindir de esta unidad; la belleza del Evangelio requiere ser vivida -la unidad-y testimoniada en la concordia entre nosotros, que somos tan diferentes. Y esta unidad me atrevo a decir que es esencial para el cristiano: no es una actitud, una forma de decir: no, es esencial, porque es la unidad que nace del amor, de la misericordia de Dios, de la justificación de Jesucristo y de la presencia del Espíritu Santo en nuestros corazones.

María Santísima, en su sencillez y humildad, refleja la Belleza de Dios Uno y Trino, porque recibió plenamente a Jesús en su vida. Que ella sostenga nuestra fe; que nos haga adoradores de Dios y servidores de nuestros hermanos.

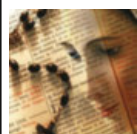

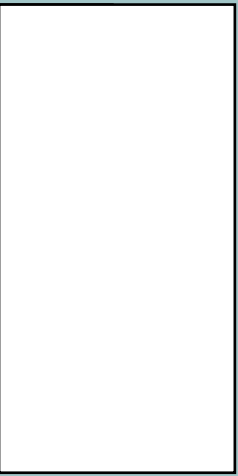
