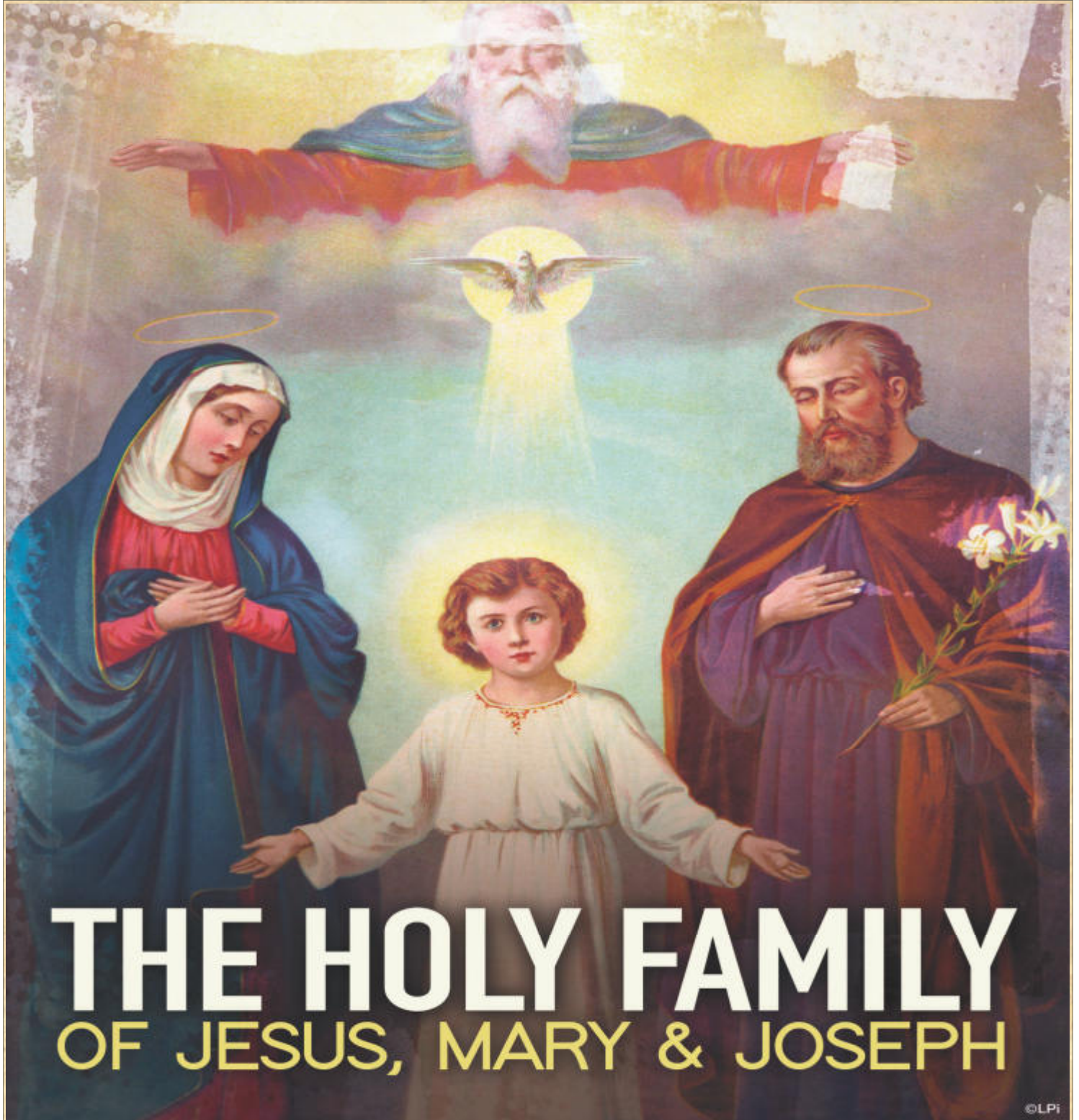

Pope Francis words

Today we are celebrating the Feast of the Holy Family, and the liturgy invites us to reflect on the experience of Mary, Joseph and Jesus, united by an immense love and inspired by great trust in God. Today's Gospel passage (cf. Lk 2:41-52) recounts the journey of the family of Nazareth to Jerusalem, for the celebration of Passover. But, on the return journey, the parents realize that their 12-year-old son is not in the caravan. After three days of searching and fear, they find him in the temple, sitting among the teachers, focused on a discussion with them. At the sight of the Son, Mary and Joseph "were astonished" (v. 48) and the Mother revealed their fear to him, saying: "your father and I have been looking for you anxiously" (ibid.) Astonishment — they "were astonished" — and anxiety — "your father and I, anxious" — are the two elements to which I would like to call your attention: astonishment and anxiety.

In the family of Nazareth astonishment never waned, not even in a dramatic moment such as Jesus being lost: it is the ability to be astonished before the gradual manifestation of the Son of God. It is the same astonishment that even strikes the teachers of the temple, "amazed at his understanding and his answers" (v. 47). But what is astonishment; what is it to be astonished? Being astonished and being amazed is the opposite of taking everything for granted; it is the opposite of interpreting the reality that surrounds us and historical events according to our criteria alone. A person who does this does not know what amazement is, what astonishment is. Being astonished is being open to others, understanding others' reasons: this attitude is important for mending compromised interpersonal relationships, and is also indispensable for healing open wounds in the familial environment. When there are problems in families, we take for granted that we are right and we close the door to others. Instead, it is important to think: 'What is good about this person?', and to be astonished by this 'good'. And this helps family unity. If you have problems in the family, think about the good things in the family member with whom you have problems, and be astonished by this. This will help to heal familial wounds.

The second element that I would like to grasp from the Gospel is the anxiety that Mary and Joseph felt when they could not find Jesus. This anxiety reveals Jesus' centrality in the Holy Family. The Virgin and her husband welcomed that Son, protected him and watched him grow in age, wisdom and grace in their midst, but above all he grew in their hearts; and, little by little, their affection for him and their understanding of him grew. This is why the family of Nazareth is holy: because it was centered on Jesus; all of Mary and Joseph's attention and concerns were directed toward him.

That anxiety that they experienced in the three days that Jesus was missing should also be our anxiety when we are distant from him, when we are distant from Jesus. We should feel anxious when we forget Jesus for more than three days, without praying, without reading the Gospel, without feeling the need of his presence and of his comforting friendship. And many times, days pass in which I do not remember Jesus. But this is bad, this is really bad. We should feel anxious when these things happen. Mary and Joseph searched for him and found him in the temple while he was teaching: for us too, it is especially in the house of God that we are able to encounter the divine Teacher and receive his message of salvation. In the Eucharistic celebration we have a living experience of Christ; he speaks to us; he offers us his Word; he illuminates us, lights our path, gives us his Body in the Eucharist from which we draw vigor to face everyday difficulties.

And today let us go home with these two words: astonishment and anxiety. Do I know how to be astonished, when I see the good things in others, and in this way resolve family problems? Do I feel anxious when I am distant from Jesus?

Let us pray for all the families in the world, especially those in which, for various reasons, peace and harmony are lacking. And let us entrust them to the protection of the Holy Family of Nazareth.

El Papa Francisco nos habla

Hoy celebramos la fiesta de la Sagrada Familia y la liturgia nos invita a reflexionar sobre la experiencia de María, José y Jesús, unidos por un inmenso amor y animados por una gran confianza en Dios. El pasaje del Evangelio de hoy (cf. Lucas 2, 41-52) narra el viaje de la familia de Nazaret a Jerusalén, para la fiesta de Pascua. Pero, en el viaje de regreso, los padres se dan cuenta de que el hijo de doce años no está en la caravana. Después de tres días de búsqueda y temor, lo encuentran en el templo, sentado entre los doctores, concentrado discutiendo con ellos. Al ver al Hijo, María y José «quedaron sorprendidos» (v. 48) y la Madre expresó su temor diciendo: «Tu padre y yo, angustiados, te andábamos buscando» (ibid.).

El asombro, ellos «quedaron sorprendidos», y la angustia, «tu padre y yo, angustiados», son los dos elementos sobre los que me gustaría llamar tu atención: asombro y angustia.

En la familia de Nazaret, el asombro nunca cesó, ni siquiera en un momento dramático como la pérdida de Jesús: es la capacidad de sorprenderse por la manifestación gradual del Hijo de Dios. Es el mismo asombro que también afecta a los doctores del templo, admirados «por su inteligencia y sus respuestas» (v.47). Pero, ¿qué es el asombro, qué es sorprenderse? Sorprenderse y maravillarse es lo contrario a dar todo por sentado, es lo contrario a interpretar la realidad que nos rodea y los acontecimientos de la historia solo de acuerdo con nuestros criterios. Y una persona que hace esto no sabe lo que es la maravilla, lo que es el asombro. Sorprenderse es abrirse a los demás, comprender las razones de los demás: esta actitud es importante para sanar las relaciones comprometidas entre las personas y también es indispensable para sanar heridas abiertas dentro de la familia. Cuando hay problemas en las familias, asumimos que tenemos razón y cerramos la puerta a los demás. En su lugar, uno debe pensar: «¿Qué tiene de bueno esta persona?» Y maravillarse con eso «bueno». Y esto ayuda a la unidad de la familia. Si tenéis problemas en la familia, pensad en las cosas buenas que tiene el familiar con el que tenéis problemas, y maravillaos con eso. Y esto ayudará a sanar las heridas familiares.

El segundo elemento que me gustaría comprender del Evangelio es la angustia que experimentaron María y José cuando no encontraban a Jesús. Esta angustia manifiesta la centralidad de Jesús en la Sagrada Familia. La Virgen y su esposo habían acogido a ese Hijo, lo custodiaron y lo vieron crecer en edad, sabiduría y gracia en medio de ellos, pero sobre todo creció en sus corazones; Y, poco a poco, su afecto y comprensión por él aumentaron. He aquí por lo que la familia de Nazaret es santa: porque estaba centrada en Jesús, todas las atenciones y cuidados de María y José estaban dirigidas a él.

La angustia que sintieron en los tres días de la pérdida de Jesús también debe ser nuestra angustia cuando estamos lejos de Él, cuando estamos lejos de Jesús. Debemos sentir angustia cuando nos olvidamos de Jesús durante más de tres días, sin rezar, sin leer el Evangelio, sin sentir la necesidad de su presencia y su amistad consoladora. Y muchas veces pasan los días sin que yo recuerde a Jesús. Pero esto es malo, esto es muy malo. Debemos sentir angustia cuando suceden estas cosas. María y José lo buscaron y lo encontraron en el templo mientras enseñaba: nosotros también, es sobre todo en la casa de Dios donde podemos encontrarnos con el divino Maestro y acoger su mensaje de salvación. En la celebración eucarística hacemos una experiencia viva de Cristo; Él nos habla, nos ofrece su Palabra, nos ilumina, ilumina nuestro viaje, nos da su Cuerpo en la Eucaristía, del cual obtenemos fuerzas para enfrentar las dificultades de cada día.

Y hoy volvemos a casa con estas dos palabras: asombro y angustia. ¿Sé experimentar el asombro cuando veo las cosas buenas de los demás, y así resuelvo los problemas familiares? ¿Me siento angustiado cuando me he apartado de Jesús?

Recemos por todas las familias del mundo, especialmente aquellas en las que, por diversas razones, hay una falta de paz y armonía. Y las confiamos a la protección de la Sagrada Familia de Nazaret.

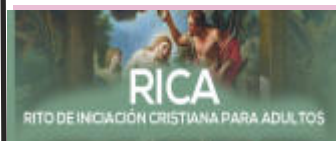

May the God of mercy and light grant healing and hope to all those who are now trying to find a way forward."

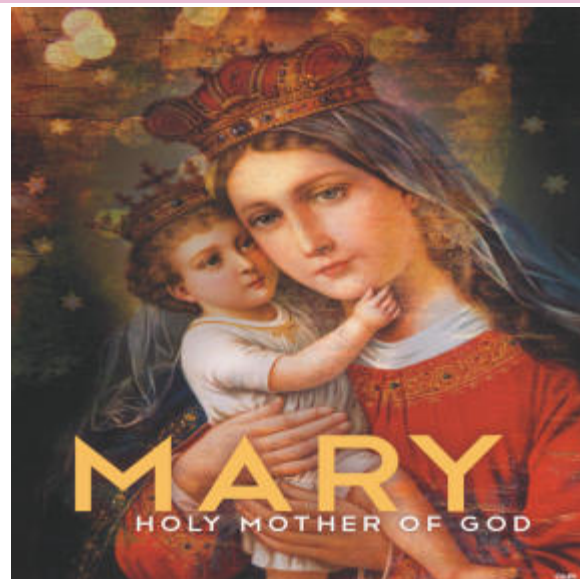
El Arzobispo Hartmayer insta a la oración y el apoyo a las víctimas del tornado
