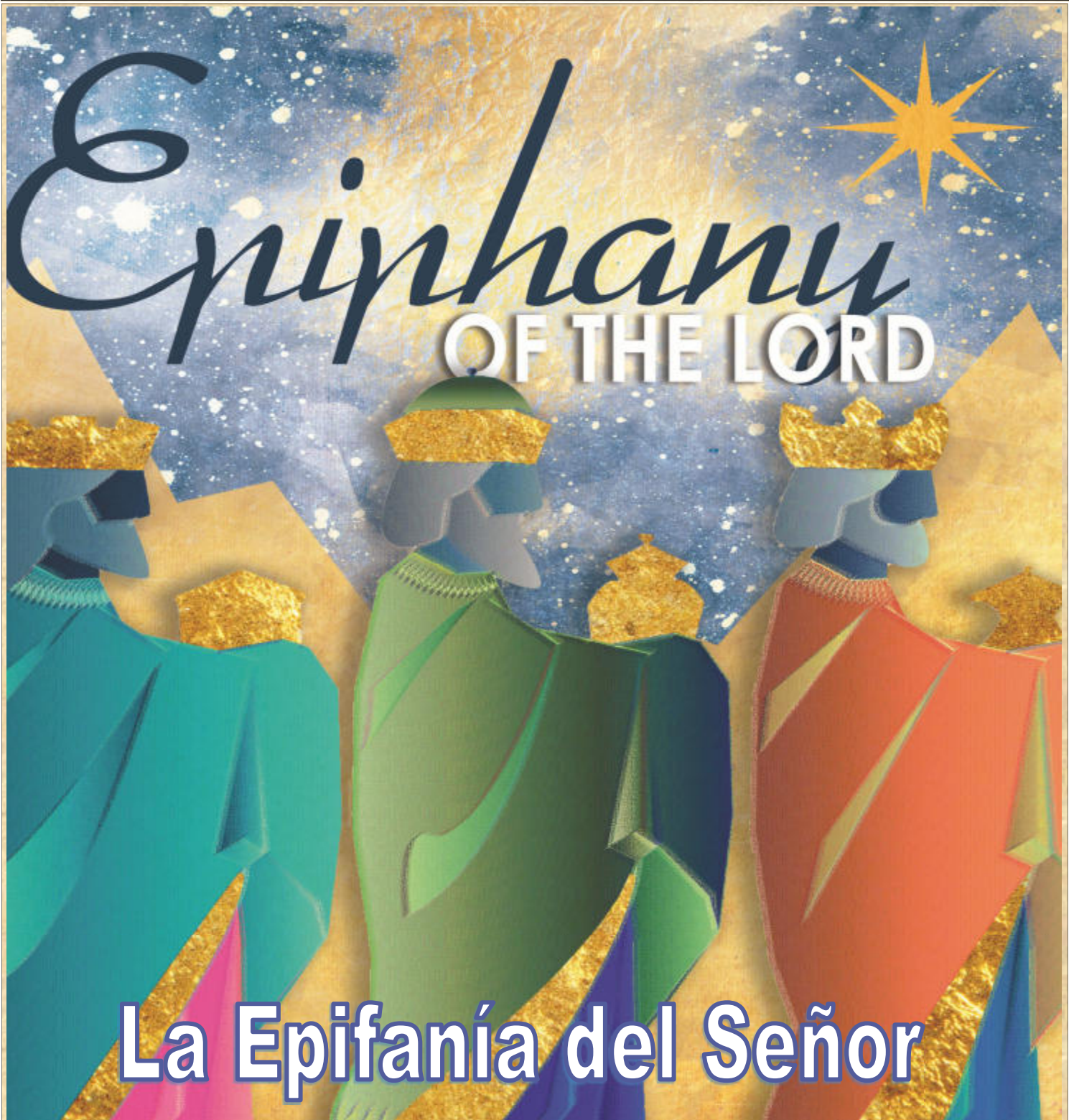

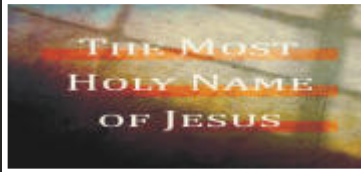

Pastor's Column

Blessings and Peace to all, this New Year 2022; and Happy Epiphany!

Pope Francis words

Today, the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord, is the celebration of the manifestation of Jesus, symbolized by light. In the prophetic texts this light is a promise: light is promised. Isaiah, in fact, addresses Jerusalem with these words: "Arise, shine; for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you" (60:1). The prophet's invitation — to arise because the light has come — seems surprising, because it occurs in the aftermath of the harsh exile and of the numerous oppressions that the people have experienced.

Today this invitation also resonates for us, who have celebrated the Birth of Jesus, and it encourages us to allow ourselves to be reached by the light of Bethlehem. We too are invited not to stop at the outward signs of the event, but to set out from it once again and to undertake anew the experience of our journey as men and women, and as believers.

The light that the Prophet Isaiah had foretold, is present and encountered in the Gospel. And Jesus, born in Bethlehem, the City of David, has come to bring salvation to those near and far: to everyone. Matthew the Evangelist reveals various ways by which one can encounter Christ and react to his presence. For example, Herod and the scribes of Jerusalem have a hard heart, which obstinately refuses the visit of that Child. This is one possibility: to be closed to the light. They represent those who, even in our day, fear Jesus' coming and close their heart to brothers and sisters who need help. Herod is afraid of losing power and does not consider the true good of the people, but rather his own personal advantage. The scribes and the chief priests of the people are afraid because they do not know how to look beyond their own certainties; they are thus unable to understand the newness that is in Jesus.

Instead, the experience of the Magi is quite different (cf. Mt 2:1-12). Having come from the East, they represent all the faraway peoples of the traditional Hebrew faith. Yet they allow themselves to be guided by the star and face a long and perilous journey just to arrive at the destination and to know the truth of the Messiah. The Magi were open to 'novelty', and history's greatest and most surprising novelty is revealed to them: God-made-man. The Magi prostrate themselves before Jesus and offer him symbolic gifts: gold, incense and myrrh, because seeking the Lord entails not only perseverance on the journey but also generosity of heart. And lastly, they returned "to their own country" (v. 12); and the Gospel states that they returned "by another road". Brothers and sisters, each time that a man or woman encounters Jesus, he or she changes paths, returns to life in a different way, returns renewed, "by another road". They returned "to their own country", bearing within them the mystery of that humble and poor King; we can imagine that they told everyone about the experience they had had: the salvation offered by God in Christ is for all mankind, near and far. It is not possible to "take possession" of that Child: he is a gift for all.

Let us also have a bit of silence in our heart and allow ourselves to be illuminated by the light of Jesus that comes from Bethlehem. Let us not allow our fears to close our hearts, but let us have the courage to open ourselves to this light that is meek and delicate. Then, like the Magi, we will feel "great joy" (v. 10) that we will be unable to keep to ourselves. May the Virgin Mary — star who guides us to Jesus and Mother who shows Jesus to the Magi and to all those who approach her — support us on this journey.

El Papa Francisco nos habla

Hoy, solemnidad de la Epifanía del Señor es la fiesta de la manifestación de Jesús, simbolizada por la luz. En los textos proféticos se promete esta luz: se promete la luz. Isaías, de hecho, se dirige a Jerusalén con estas palabras: «¡Arriba, resplandece, que ha llegado tu luz y la gloria de Yahveh sobre ti ha amanecido!» (60, 1). La invitación del profeta —a levantarse porque viene la luz— parece sorprendente, porque se encuentra después del duro exilio y de las numerosas vejaciones que el pueblo había experimentado.

Esta invitación, hoy, también resuena para nosotros que hemos celebrado la Navidad de Jesús y nos anima a dejarnos alcanzar por la luz de Belén. Nosotros también estamos invitados a no detenemos en los signos externos del evento, sino a comenzar de nuevo y emprender, en la novedad de la vida, nuestro viaje de hombres y creyentes.

La luz que el profeta Isaías preanunció en el Evangelio está presente y encontrada. Y Jesús, nacido en Belén, la ciudad de David, vino para llevar la salvación a vecinos y lejanos: a todos. El evangelista Mateo muestra diferentes maneras en que uno puede encontrarse con Cristo y reaccionar ante su presencia. Por ejemplo, Herodes y los escribas de Jerusalén tienen un corazón duro, que persiste y rechaza la visita de ese Niño. Es una posibilidad: cerrarse a la luz. Representan a quienes, incluso en nuestros días, tienen miedo de la venida de Jesús y cierran sus corazones a los hermanos y hermanas que necesitan ayuda. Herodes teme perder poder y no piensa en el verdadero bien de las personas, sino en su propio interés personal. Los escribas y los líderes de la gente tienen miedo porque no pueden mirar más allá de sus propias certezas, por lo que no logran captar la novedad que es Jesús.

Por otro lado, la experiencia de los Magos es muy diferente (cf. Mateo 2, 1-12). Venidos de Oriente, representan a todos los pueblos lejanos de la fe judía tradicional. Sin embargo, se dejan guiar por la estrella y se enfrentan a un largo y arriesgado viaje para llegar al destino y conocer la verdad sobre el Mesías. Los magos estaban abiertos a la «novedad», y revelaron la novedad más grande y sorprendente de la historia: Dios hecho hombre. Los magos se postran ante Jesús y le ofrecen regalos simbólicos: oro, incienso y mirra; Porque la búsqueda del Señor implica no solo la perseverancia en el camino, sino también la generosidad del corazón. Y finalmente, se retiraron «a su país» (v. 12); y dice el evangelio que volvieron por «otro camino». Hermanos y hermanas, cada vez que un hombre o una mujer se encuentran con Jesús, él cambia sus caminos, vuelve a la vida de una manera diferente, vuelve renovado, «por otro camino». Regresaron «a su país» llevando consigo el misterio de ese Rey humilde y pobre; podemos imaginar que contaron a todos la experiencia vivida: la salvación ofrecida por Dios en Cristo es para todos los hombres, cercanos y lejanos. No es posible «tomar posesión» de ese Niño: Él es un regalo para todos.

Nosotros también, hagamos un poco de silencio en nuestro corazón y dejémonos iluminar por la luz de Jesús que proviene de Belén. No permitamos que nuestros miedos cierren nuestros corazones y tengamos el coraje de abrimos a esta luz que es suave y discreta. Entonces, como los Magos, experimentaremos «inmensa alegría» (v. 10) que no podremos conservar para nosotros mismos. Que nos sostenga en este viaje la Virgen María, estrella que nos lleva a Jesús, y Madre que muestra a Jesús a los Magos y a todos los que se le acercan.
