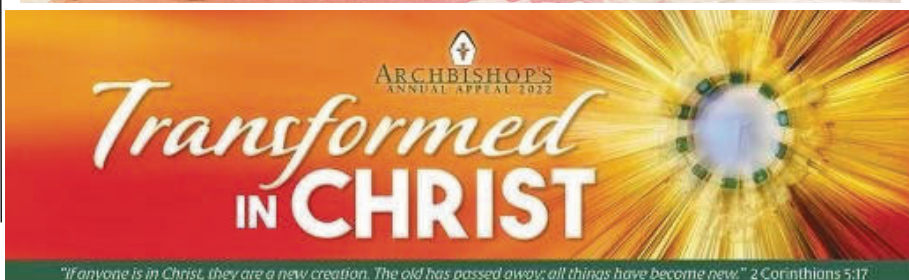

Pope Francis words

Today's Gospel passage (cf. Jn 20:19-31) recounts that on the day of Easter, Jesus appears to his disciples in the Upper Room, in the evening, bearing three gifts: peace, joy, the apostolic mission.

The first words he says are: "Peace be with you" (v. 21). The Risen One brings authentic peace, because through his sacrifice on the Cross he achieved reconciliation between God and humanity, and he conquered sin and death. This is peace. His disciples needed this peace first and foremost, because, after the Master was arrested and condemned to death, they fell into dismay and fear. Jesus appears among them alive and, in showing the wounds — Jesus wanted to preserve his wounds — in his glorious body, gives peace as the fruit of his victory. But that evening the Apostle Thomas was not present. Apprised of this extraordinary event, incredulous at the testimony of the other Apostles, he demands to personally verify the truth of what they assert. Eight days later, just as today, the apparition is repeated: Jesus confronts Thomas' incredulity, inviting him to touch His wounds. They are the sources of peace, because they are the sign of the immense love of Jesus who defeated the forces hostile to man: sin, death. He invites him to touch the wounds. It is a lesson for us, as if Jesus were to tell all of us: "If you are not at peace, touch my wounds".

Touch Jesus' wounds, which are the many problems, difficulties, persecutions, illnesses of so many suffering people. Are you not at peace? Go. Go to visit someone who is the symbol of Jesus' wounds. Touch Jesus' wounds. Mercy flows from those wounds. That is why today is the Sunday of Mercy. A saint used to say that Jesus' crucified body is like a bundle of mercy, which reaches each of us through his wounds. All of us need mercy, as we know. Let us draw near to Jesus and touch his wounds in our suffering brothers and sisters. Jesus' wounds are a treasure: mercy issues from them. Let us be courageous and touch Jesus' wounds. With these wounds he stands before the Father; he reveals them to the Father, as if to say: "Father, this is the price; these wounds are what I paid for my brothers and sisters". With his wounds Jesus intercedes before the Father. He gives us mercy if we draw near, and he intercedes for us. Do not forget Jesus' wounds.

The second gift that the Risen Jesus brings to his disciples is joy. The evangelist recounts that "the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord" (v. 20). And there is also a verse, in Luke's version, that says that they disbelieved for joy. We too, perhaps when something incredible, beautiful has happened, might say: "I cannot believe it; this is not true!". This is how the disciples were. They disbelieved for joy. This is the joy that Jesus brings us. If you are sad, if you are not at peace, look to Jesus Crucified; look to the Risen Jesus; look at his wounds and receive that joy.

And then, in addition to peace and joy, Jesus also brings the gift of mission to the disciples. He says to them: "As the Father has sent me, even so I send you" (v. 21). Jesus' Resurrection is the beginning of a new dynamism of love, capable of transforming the world with the presence of the Holy Spirit.

This second Sunday of Easter, we are invited to approach Christ with faith, opening our heart to peace, joy and the mission. But let us not forget Jesus' wounds because from them come peace, joy and the strength for the mission. Let us entrust this prayer to the maternal intercession of the Virgin Mary, Queen of Heaven and Earth.

El Papa Francisco nos habla

El evangelio de hoy (Juan 20, 19-31) narra que el día de Pascua Jesús se aparece por la tarde a sus discípulos en el Cenáculo, llevando tres dones: la paz, la alegría y la misión apostólica.

Sus primeras palabras son: «La paz con vosotros» (v. 21). El Señor Resucitado trae auténtica paz, porque a través de su sacrificio en la cruz ha cumplido la reconciliación entre Dios y la humanidad y ha vencido al pecado y a la muerte. Esta es la paz. Sus discípulos eran los primeros que necesitaban esta paz, porque después de la captura y la condena a muerte del Maestro, habían caído en el desamparo y el miedo. Jesús se presenta vivo en medio de ellos y mostrando sus llagas —Jesús quiso conservar sus llagas— en el cuerpo glorioso, da la paz como fruto de su victoria. Pero esa tarde no estaba presente el apóstol Tomás. Informado de este hecho extraordinario, él, incrédulo ante el testimonio del resto de apóstoles, pretende verificar personalmente la verdad de lo que afirman. Ocho días después, tal como hoy, se repite la aparición: Jesús sale al encuentro de la incredulidad de Tomás invitándole a tocar sus llagas. Constituyen la fuente de la paz, porque son el signo del amor inmenso de Jesús, que derrotó a las fuerzas hostiles contra el hombre, es decir, el pecado, el mal y la muerte. Lo invita a tocar las llagas, es una enseñanza para nosotros, como si Jesús dijera a cada uno de nosotros: «Si no estás en paz, toca mis llagas».

Tocar las llagas de Jesús, que son los tantos problemas, las dificultades, las persecuciones, las enfermedades de tanta gente que sufre. ¿Tú no estás en paz?, Ve, ve a visitar a alguien que es símbolo de la llaga de Jesús, toca la llaga de Jesús. De esas llagas brota la misericordia. Por eso hoy es el domingo de la misericordia. Un santo decía que el cuerpo de Jesús crucificado es como un saco de misericordia, que a través de las llagas viene hacia todos nosotros. Todos nosotros necesitamos de la misericordia, lo sabemos. Acercuémonos a Jesús y toquemos sus llagas, en nuestros hermanos que sufren. Las heridas de Jesús son un tesoro: de ellas brota la misericordia. Seamos valerosos y toquemos las llagas de Jesús. Con estas llagas está delante del Padre y se las enseña, como si dijera «Padre, este es el precio, estas llagas son lo que yo he pagado por mis hermanos». Con sus llagas Jesús intercede ante el Padre. Nos da la misericordia si nos acercamos e intercede por nosotros. No olvidéis las llagas de Jesús.

El segundo don que Jesús resucitado lleva a los discípulos es la alegría. El evangelista relata que «los discípulos se alegraron de ver al Señor» (v.20). Y también hay un versículo, en la versión de Lucas, que dice que «no podían creer de la alegría». También a nosotros cuando nos pasa algo increíble demasiado bonito, nos sale de dentro decir: «¡No me lo puedo creer, esto no es verdad!» y así decían los discípulos, no podían creer de tanta alegría. Y esa es la alegría que nos da Jesús. Si estás triste, si no estás en paz, mira a Jesús crucificado a Jesús resucitado, mira sus llagas y toma esa alegría.

Y luego, además de la paz y de la alegría, Jesús da a sus discípulos una nueva misión: Les dice «como el Padre me envió, también yo os envío» (v. 21). La resurrección de Jesús es el inicio de un nuevo dinamismo de amor capaz de transformar el mundo con la presencia del Espíritu Santo. En este segundo domingo de Pascua, estamos invitados a acercarnos a Cristo con fe, abriendo nuestros corazones a la paz, a la alegría y a la misión, pero no olvidemos las llagas de Jesús, porque de ellas brotan la paz, la alegría y la fuerza para la misión. Encomendamos esta plegaria a la intercesión materna de la Virgen María, Reina del Cielo y de la Tierra.

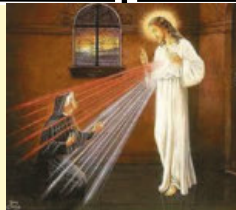
