





Pope Francis words

Dear Brothers and Sisters, Good morning!

Today's Gospel recounts the third apparition of the Risen Jesus to the disciples, with the account of the miraculous catch on the shore of the lake of Galilee (cf. Jn 21:1-19). The narrative is situated in the context of the everyday life of the disciples, who returned to their land and to their work as fishermen, after the shocking days of the passion, death and resurrection of the Lord. It was difficult for them to understand what had taken place. Even though everything seemed finished, Jesus "seeks" his disciples once more. It is He who goes to seek them. This time he meets them at the lake, where they have spent the night in their boats catching nothing. The nets appear empty, in a certain sense, like the tally of their experience with Jesus: they met him, they left everything to follow him, full of hope... and now? Yes, they saw he was risen, but then they were thought: "He went away and left us.... It was like a dream..." .

So it is that at sunrise Jesus presents himself on the lakeshore; however they do not recognize him (cf. v. 4). The Lord says to those tired and disappointed fishermen: "Cast the net on the right side of the boat, and you will find some" (v. 6). The disciples trust in Jesus and the result is an incredibly abundant catch. At this point John turns to Peter and says: "It is the Lord!" (v. 7). Right away Peter throws himself into the water and swims to the shore, toward Jesus. In that exclamation: "It is the Lord!", there is all the enthusiasm of the Paschal faith, full of joy and wonder, which sharply contrasts with the disappearance, the dejection, the sense of powerlessness that had accumulated in the disciples' hearts. The presence of the Risen Jesus transforms everything: darkness has become light, futile work has again become fruitful and promising, the sense of weariness and abandonment give way to a new impetus and to the certainty that He is with us.

From that time, these same sentiments enliven the Church, the Community of the Risen One. All of us are the community of the Risen One! At first glance it might sometimes seem that the darkness of evil and the toil of daily living have got the upper hand, the Church knows with certainty that the now everlasting light of Easter shines upon those who follow the Lord Jesus. The great message of the Resurrection instills in the hearts of believers profound joy and invincible hope. Christ is truly risen! Today too, the Church continues to make this joyous message resound: joy and hope continue to flow in hearts, in faces, in gestures, in words. We Christians are all called to communicate this message of resurrection to those we meet, especially to those who suffer, to those who are alone, to those who find themselves in precarious conditions, to the sick, to refugees, to the marginalized. Let us make a ray of the light of the Risen Christ, a sign of his powerful mercy, reach everyone.

May he, the Lord, also renew in us the Paschal faith. May he render us ever more aware of our mission at the service of the Gospel and of our brothers and sisters; may he fill us with his Holy Spirit so that, sustained by the intercession of Mary, with all the Church we may proclaim the greatness of his love and the abundance of his mercy.

El Papa Francisco nos habla

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, ¡buenos días!

El Evangelio de hoy narra la tercera aparición de Jesús resucitado a los discípulos a orillas del lago de Galilea, con la descripción de la pesca milagrosa (cf. Jn 21, 1-19). El relato se sitúa en el marco de la vida cotidiana de los discípulos, que habían regresado a su tierra y a su trabajo de pescadores, después de los días tremendos de la pasión, muerte y resurrección del Señor. Era difícil para ellos comprender lo que había sucedido. Pero, mientras que todo parecía haber acabado, Jesús va nuevamente a «buscar» a sus discípulos. Es Él quien va a buscálos. Esta vez los encuentra junto al lago, donde ellos habían pasado la noche en las barcas sin pescar nada. Las redes vacías se presentan, en cierto sentido, como el balance de su experiencia con Jesús: lo habían conocido, habían dejado todo por seguirlo, llenos de esperanza... ¿y ahora? Sí, lo habían visto resucitado, pero luego pensaban: «Se marchó y nos ha dejado... Ha sido como un sueño...».

He aquí que al amanecer Jesús se presenta en la orilla del lago; pero ellos no lo reconocen (cf. v. 4). A estos pescadores, cansados y decepcionados, el Señor les dice: «Echad la red a la derecha de la barca y encontraréis» (v. 6). Los discípulos confiaron en Jesús y el resultado fue una pesca increíblemente abundante. Es así que Juan se dirige a Pedro y dice: «Es el Señor» (v. 7). E inmediatamente Pedro se lanzó al agua y nadó hacia la orilla, hacia Jesús. En aquella exclamación: «¡Es el Señor!», está todo el entusiasmo de la fe pascual, llena de alegría y de asombro, que se opone con fuerza a la confusión, al desaliento, al sentido de impotencia que se había acumulado en el ánimo de los discípulos. La presencia de Jesús resucitado transforma todas las cosas: la oscuridad es vencida por la luz, el trabajo inútil es nuevamente fructuoso y prometedor, el sentido de cansancio y de abandono deja espacio a un nuevo impulso y a la certeza de que Él está con nosotros.

Desde entonces, estos mismos sentimientos animan a la Iglesia, la Comunidad del Resucitado. ¡Todos nosotros somos la comunidad del Resucitado! Si a una mirada superficial puede parecer, en algunas ocasiones, que el poder lo tienen las tinieblas del mal y el cansancio de la vida cotidiana, la Iglesia sabe con certeza que en quienes siguen al Señor Jesús resplandece ya imperecedera la luz de la Pascua. El gran anuncio de la Resurrección infunde en el corazón de los creyentes una íntima alegría y una esperanza invencibles. ¡Cristo ha verdaderamente resucitado! También hoy la Iglesia sigue haciendo resonar este anuncio gozoso: la alegría y la esperanza siguen reflejándose en los corazones, en los rostros, en los gestos, en las palabras. Todos nosotros cristianos estamos llamados a comunicar este mensaje de resurrección a quienes encontramos, especialmente a quien sufre, a quien está solo, a quien se encuentra en condiciones precarias, a los enfermos, los refugiados, los marginados. A todos hagamos llegar un rayo de la luz de Cristo resucitado, un signo de su poder misericordioso.

Que Él, el Señor, renueve también en nosotros la fe pascual. Que nos haga cada vez más conscientes de nuestra misión al servicio del Evangelio y de los hermanos; nos colme de su Santo Espíritu para que, sostenidos por la intercesión de María, con toda la Iglesia podamos proclamar la grandeza de su amor y la riqueza de su misericordia.



Please note that we won't have Confessions on Thursday May 5.




Religious Education
