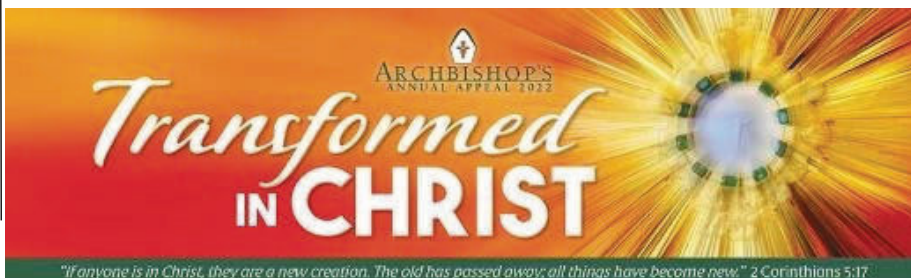


The beautiful altar flowers are in honor of Esgar Miguel and Maria Luisa Alvarado's Wedding.

Eucharist Congress

Once again, Catholics from the Archdiocese of Atlanta will join for praise and worship in celebration of the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist at the 25th Eucharistic Congress. The theme this year is from Matthew 11:28, "Come to Me."

The Eucharistic Congress will take place Friday-Saturday, June 17-18, at the Georgia International Convention Center, 2000 Convention Center Concourse, College Park, GA 30337.

Pope Francis words

"What is man that thou art mindful of him" we prayed during the Psalm (8:4). These words came to mind as I was thinking of you. Before what you have seen and suffered, before the crumbled houses and buildings reduced to ruins, this question comes to mind: What is man? What is he if what he raises can crumble down in an instant? What is he if his hope can crumble to dust? What is man? The answer seems to lie in the continuation of the sentence: what is man that thou art mindful of him? God remembers us just as we are with all our frailties. In the uncertainty that we feel within and on the outside, the Lord gives us one certainty: He remembers us. He is re-mindful of us, that is, he returns to us with his heart because he cares for us. And while here on earth many things are quickly forgotten, God does not leave us in oblivion. No one is despicable in his eyes. Each of us has an infinite value for him: we are small beneath the sky and powerless when the earth trembles but to God we are more precious than any thing else.

Memory is a keyword for life. Let us ask for the grace to remember each day that we are not forgotten by God, that we are his beloved, unique and irreplaceable children. Remembering this gives us the strength not to surrender before life's setbacks. Let us remember our worth when we are faced with the temptation to feel sad and to continue dredging up the worst, which seems to be never-ending. Bad memories also appear when we are not thinking of them. But they dole out pain: they leave behind only melancholy and nostalgia. But how difficult it is to free oneself from bad memories! That adage — according to which it was easier for God to take Israel out of Egypt than Egypt out of Israel's heart — has merit.

In order to free the heart from a past that keeps returning, from negative memories that imprison, from paralyzing regrets, we need someone to help us carry the burden we have within. Indeed, today Jesus says there are "many things that we cannot bear" (cf. Jn 16:12). And what does he do in the face of our weakness? He does not remove our burdens as we would like, we who are always seeking quick and superficial solutions; no, the Lord gives us the Holy Spirit. We need him because he is the Comforter, that is, the one who does not leave us on our own under life's burdens. He is the One who transforms our enslaved memory into free memory, past wounds into memories of salvation. He accomplishes in us what he did through Jesus: his wounds — those terrible lesions hollowed out by evil — by the power of the Holy Spirit have become channels of mercy, luminous wounds in which God's love shines, a love that is uplifting, that enables us to rise again. This is what the Holy Spirit does when we invite him into our wounds. He anoints the bad memories with the balm of hope because the Holy Spirit is the builder of hope.

El Papa Francisco nos habla

«¿Qué es el hombre para que de él te acuerdes?» hemos rezado en el Salmo (8, 5). Me han venido a la mente estas palabras pensando en vosotros. Ante lo que habéis visto y sufrido, ante casas derrumbadas y edificios reducidos a escombros, surge esta pregunta: ¿Qué es el hombre? ¿Qué es, si lo que levanta puede colapsar en un instante? ¿Qué es, si su esperanza puede terminar en escombros? ¿Qué es el hombre? La respuesta parece venir de la continuación de la oración: ¿qué es el hombre para que de él te acuerdes? De nosotros, tal y como somos, con nuestras debilidades, Dios se acuerda. En la incertidumbre que sentimos fuera y dentro, el Señor nos da una certeza: nos recuerda. Él re-cuerda, es decir, regresa con su corazón a nosotros, porque se preocupa por nosotros. Y mientras aquí abajo muchas cosas se olvidan rápidamente, Dios no nos deja en el olvido. Nadie es despreciable en sus ojos, cada uno tiene un valor infinito para Él: somos pequeños bajo el cielo e impotentes cuando la tierra tiembla, pero para Dios somos más valiosos que cualquier otra cosa.

Recuerdo es una palabra clave para la vida. Pidamos la gracia de recordar cada día que no somos olvidados por Dios, que somos sus hijos amados, únicos e irremplazables: recordarlo nos da la fuerza para no rendimos ante los reveses de la vida. Recordemos cuánto valemos, frente a la tentación de entristecernos y continuar moviendo ese peor que parece no acabar nunca. Los malos recuerdos llegan, incluso cuando no pensamos en ellos; pero pagan mal: solo dejan melancolía y nostalgia. ¡Pero qué difícil es liberarse de los malos recuerdos! Es válido aquel dicho por el cual era más fácil para Dios sacar a Israel de Egipto que a Egipto del corazón de Israel. Para liberar el corazón del pasado que regresa, de los recuerdos negativos que nos aprisionan, de las añoranzas que lo paralizan, se necesita a alguien que nos ayude a llevar el peso que tenemos dentro. Hoy Jesús nos dice: «no podéis con ello» (cf. Jn 16,12). ¿Y qué hace frente a nuestra debilidad? No nos quita las cargas, como nos gustaría a nosotros, que siempre estamos buscando soluciones rápidas y superficiales; no, el Señor nos da al Espíritu Santo. Lo necesitamos porque él es el Consolador, el que no nos deja solos bajo las cargas de la vida. Es Él quien transforma nuestra memoria de esclavos en memoria libre, las heridas del pasado en recuerdos de salvación. Él hace en nosotros lo que hizo por Jesús: sus llagas, esas feas heridas talladas por el mal, se han convertido por el poder del Espíritu Santo en canales de misericordia, heridas luminosas en las que brilla el amor de Dios, un amor que eleva, que resucita. Esto es lo que hace el Espíritu Santo cuando lo invitamos a nuestras heridas. Él unge los malos recuerdos con el bálsamo de la esperanza, porque el Espíritu Santo es el reconstructor de la esperanza.

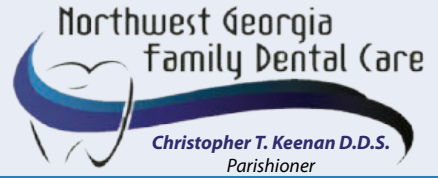

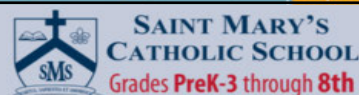

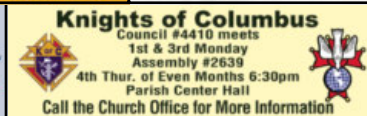
