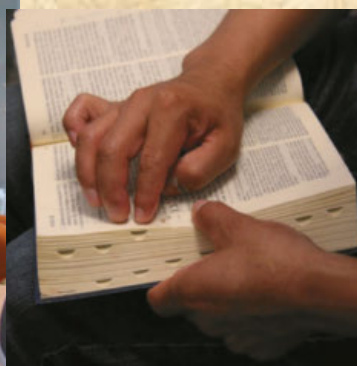

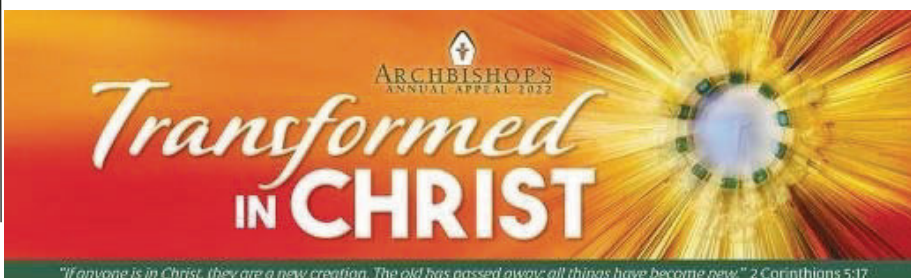

Pope Francis words

In today's Gospel passage (cf. Lk 9:51-62), Saint Luke begins the narrative of Jesus' last journey towards Jerusalem, which ends at Chapter 19. It is a long journey, not only geographically and spatially, but also spiritually and theologically, towards the fulfilment of the Messiah's mission. Jesus' decision is radical and total, and those who follow him are called to measure up to it. Today the Evangelist presents us three characters — three cases of vocation, we could say — that shed light on what is required of those who wish to follow Jesus to the end, completely.

The first character promises him: "I will follow you wherever you go" (v. 57). Generous! But Jesus replies that the Son of man, unlike foxes that have holes, and birds that have nests, "has nowhere to lay his head" (v. 58). The absolute poverty of Jesus. Indeed, Jesus left his paternal home and gave up all security in order to proclaim the Kingdom of God to the lost sheep of his people. In this way Jesus pointed out to us, his disciples, that our mission in the world cannot be static, but is itinerant. The Christian is itinerant. The Church by her very nature is in motion; she does not stay sedentary and calm within her enclosure. She is open to the broadest horizons, sent forth — the Church is sent forth — to bring the Gospel through the streets and to reach the human and existential peripheries. This is the first character.

The second character Jesus meets receives the call directly from him, but replies: "Lord, let me first go and bury my father" (v. 59). It is a legitimate request based on the commandment to honour your father and mother (cf. Ex 20:12). Nevertheless, Jesus responds: "Leave the dead to bury their own dead" (Lk 9:60). With these deliberately provocative words, he intends to emphasize the primacy of following and of proclaiming the Kingdom of God, even over and above the most important realities, such as the family. The urgency of communicating the Gospel, which breaks the chains of death and ushers in eternal life, does not permit delays but requires promptness and complete willingness. Thus, the Church is itinerant, and here the Church is decisive, acts quickly, on the spot, without waiting.

The third character also wants to follow Jesus but on one condition: he will do so after bidding farewell to his relatives. And this is the response he receives from the Teacher: "No one who puts his hand to the plow and looks back is fit for the kingdom of God" (v. 62). Following Jesus excludes regrets and backward glances but requires the virtue of decision.

In order to follow Jesus, the Church is itinerant, acts promptly, quickly and decisively. The value of these conditions set by Jesus — itinerancy, promptness and decision — does not lie in a series of saying 'no' to the good and important things in life. Rather, the emphasis is placed on the main objective: to become a disciple of Christ! A free and conscious choice, made out of love, to reciprocate the invaluable grace of God, and not made as a way to promote oneself. This is sad! Woe to those who think about following Jesus for their own advantage, that is, to further their career, to feel important or to acquire a position of prestige. Jesus wants us to be passionate about him and about the Gospel. A heartfelt passion which translates into concrete gestures of proximity, of closeness to the brothers and sisters most in need of welcome and care. Precisely as he himself lived.

El Papa Francisco nos habla

En el Evangelio de hoy (cf. Lc 9, 51-62), san Lucas comienza el relato del último viaje de Jesús a Jerusalén, que terminará en el capítulo 19. Es una larga marcha no sólo geográfica sino espiritual y teológica hacia el cumplimiento de la misión del Mesías. La decisión de Jesús es radical y total, y los que le siguen están llamados a medirse con ella. El evangelista nos presenta hoy a tres personajes —tres casos de vocación, podríamos decir— que ponen de relieve lo que se pide a quien quiere seguir a Jesús hasta el final, totalmente.

El primer personaje le promete: «Te seguiré adondequiera que vayas» (v. 57). ¡Generoso! Pero Jesús responde que el Hijo del Hombre, a diferencia de los zorros que tienen guaridas y los pájaros que tienen nidos, «no tiene donde reclinar la cabeza» (v. 58). La pobreza absoluta de Jesús. Jesús, en efecto, ha dejado la casa de su padre y renunciado a toda seguridad para anunciar el Reino de Dios a las ovejas perdidas de su pueblo. Así, Jesús nos indica a nosotros, sus discípulos, que nuestra misión en el mundo no puede ser estática, sino que es itinerante. El cristiano es un itinerante. La Iglesia por su naturaleza está en movimiento, no es sedentaria y no se queda tranquila en su propio recinto. Está abierta a los horizontes más amplios, enviada —¡la Iglesia es enviada!— a llevar el Evangelio a los caminos y llegar a las periferias humanas y existenciales. Este es el primer personaje.

El segundo personaje con el que Jesús se encuentra recibe la llamada directamente de Él, pero responde: «Señor, déjame que vaya primero a enterrar a mi padre» (v. 59). Es una petición legítima, basada en el mandamiento de honrar al padre y a la madre (cf. Ex 20,12). Sin embargo, Jesús contesta: «Deja que los muertos entierren a sus muertos» (v. 60). Con estas palabras, deliberadamente provocadoras, tiene la intención de reafirmar la primacía del seguimiento y la proclamación del Reino de Dios, incluso por encima de las realidades más importantes, como la familia. La urgencia de comunicar el Evangelio, que rompe la cadena de la muerte e inaugura la vida eterna, no admite retrasos, sino que requiere inmediatez y disponibilidad. Por lo tanto, la Iglesia es itinerante, y aquí la Iglesia es decidida, actúa con prontitud, en el momento, sin esperar.

El tercer personaje también quiere seguir a Jesús pero con una condición, lo hará después de haber ido a despedirse de sus parientes. Y esto es lo que se escucha decir del Maestro: «Nadie que pone la mano en el arado y mira hacia atrás, es apto para el Reino de Dios» (v. 62). Seguir a Jesús excluye las nostalgias y las miradas hacia atrás, pero requiere la virtud de la decisión.

La Iglesia para seguir a Jesús es itinerante, actúa con prontitud, deprisa y decidida. El valor de estas tres condiciones puestas por Jesús —itinerancia, prontitud y decisión— no radica en una serie de "noes" a las cosas buenas e importantes de la vida. El acento, más bien, hay que ponerlo en el objetivo principal: ¡convertirse en discípulo de Cristo! Una elección libre y consciente, hecha por amor, para corresponder a la gracia inestimable de Dios, y no un modo de promoverse a sí mismo. ¡Esto es triste! Ay de los que piensan seguir a Jesús para promoverse, es decir, para hacer carrera, para sentirse importantes o adquirir un puesto de prestigio. Jesús nos quiere apasionados de él y del Evangelio. Una pasión del corazón que se traduce en gestos concretos de proximidad, de cercanía a los hermanos más necesitados de acogida y cuidados. Precisamente como vivió Él.

The goal, toward which all of history is directed, is represented by the final Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.

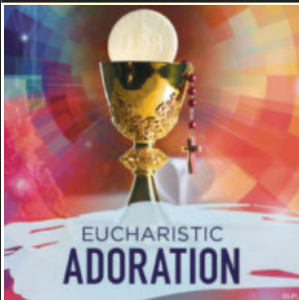
LA COLUMNA DEL PÁRROCO
