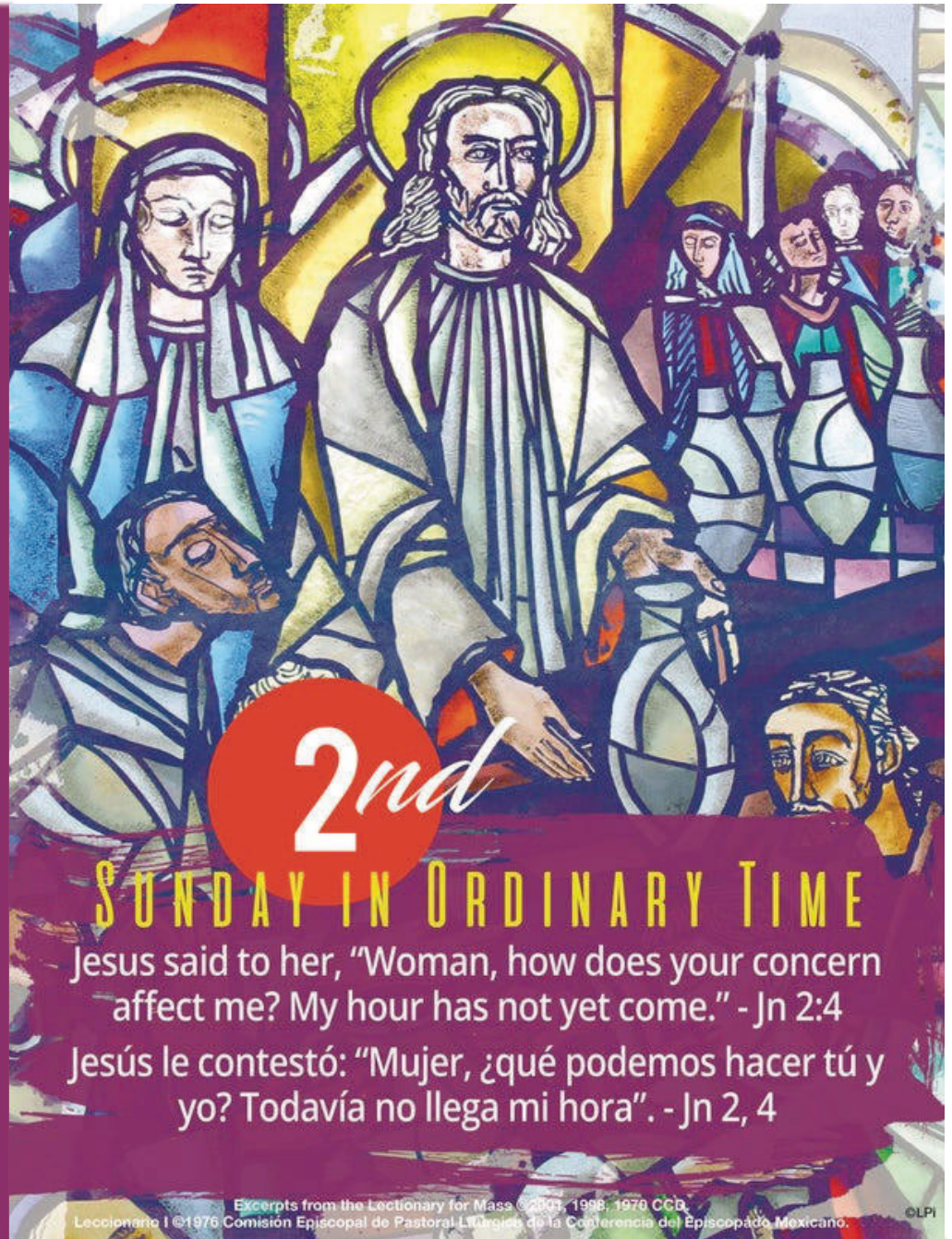

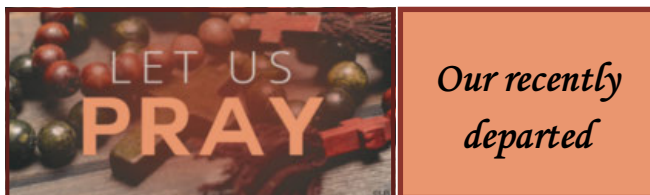
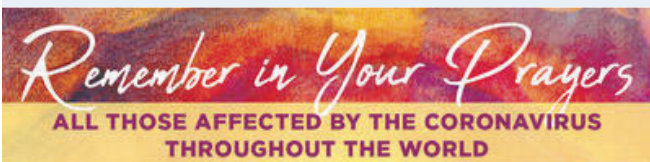

World Day of the Sick

Pope John Paul II designated February 11, as World Day of the Sick, "A special time of prayer and sharing, of offering one's suffering for the good of the Church, and of reminding us to see in our sick brother and sister the face of Christ who, by suffering, dying, and rising, achieved the salvation of humankind."



HEALING

In keeping with this special day Saint Patrick Catholic Church will celebrate the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick on Saturday, February 5, 2022, during Mass at 9:00 AM.

Who may receive the Sacrament of Anointing?

Any baptized Catholic who is seriously ill due to sickness, injury, or old age may receive the Anointing of the Sick, even though there is no apparent danger of death. The sacrament should be received when the sick person is best able to profit from it, and not be delayed until the person is at the point of death. The elderly who are in a weakened condition are also encouraged by the Church to receive the Sacrament of Anointing, even though no dangerous illness is present. One should also receive it before a serious operation.

DIA MUNDIAL DEL ENFERMO

El Papa Juan Pablo II designó el 11 de febrero, como Jornada Mundial del Enfermo, "un momento especial de oración y de compartir, de ofrecer el propio sufrimiento por el bien de la Iglesia y de recordarnos que veamos en nuestros hermanos el rostro de Cristo que, sufriendo, muriendo y resucitando, logró la salvación de la humanidad".

De acuerdo con este día especial, la Iglesia Católica de San Patricio celebrará el Sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos el sábado 5 de febrero de 2022, durante la Misa a las 9:00 AM.

¿Quiénes pueden recibir el Sacramento de la Unción?

Cualquier católico bautizado que esté gravemente enfermo debido a una enfermedad, lesión o vejez puede recibir la Unción de los Enfermos, aunque no haya peligro aparente de muerte. El sacramento debe recibirse cuando la persona enferma esté en mejores condiciones de sacar provecho de él, y no debe demorarse hasta que la persona esté al borde de la muerte. La Iglesia también anima a los ancianos que se encuentran en una condición debilitada a recibir el Sacramento de la Unción, aunque no exista una enfermedad peligrosa. También se debe recibir antes de una operación seria.

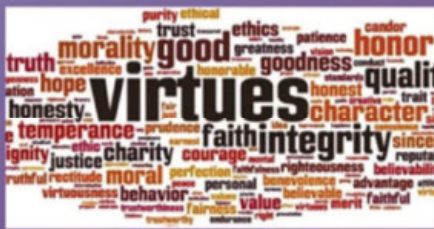

Today's Gospel is the familiar story of the wedding feast at Cana when Jesus performed His first miracle at the request of his mother.

The Blessed Mother noticed that the wine had run out and pointed out the problem to Jesus. Then she gave the servants instructions that are equally applicable to us modern day Stewards. "Do whatever He tells you." Jesus tells the servants to fill some stone jars with water. Jesus used their obedience in that simple task to perform His first miracle, turning the water into the choicest wine.

"Do Whatever He Tells You"

Jesus did not have to include those to perform the miracle. He chose to include them. And today He still chooses to include us in His miracles by using the gifts and talents He has given us.

What a privilege! What a difference you made in 2021!

Many times, it is easy to focus on the troubles and hardships we are dealing with and forget about the great blessings we are receiving amid the challenges. During this bicentennial year Saint Patrick Parish has helped many that have faced some very difficult challenges this past year, thus being the hands and feet of Christ. We wanted to share some of the great blessings here that Saint Patrick, you, by your generosity, kindness, and your yes to Jesus have blessed the Parish and parishioners, the Fayetteville Community, and beyond.

- **Bicentennial Celebration.** We celebrated the beginning of our bicentennial year with Bishop Luis Zarama, Bishop Robert Guglielmone, and Bishop Ned Shlesinger III.
- **Together We Can** pantry items to Catholic Charities we delivered 28,410 items, this is more than we have ever donated in the past 5 years of this project. The closest year to this amount was in 2018 with 20,063 items.
- **Mortgage.** We paid off the 15-year mortgage in just 7 1/2 years.
- **Christmas in July tree.** \$2,345 to Room at the Inn, Meals on Wheels \$2,470, 145 items for Connections of Cumberland County, 248 items for Urban Ministry, 170 items for Operation Inasmuch, and 336 items for Catholic Charities.
- **Advent Angel Tree.** With our Advent Angel Tree, we sent over 800 gifts to Holy Savior Church in Lockport, LA and \$8, 675.00. There were 73 gifts for our parishioners in need, and 506 gifts for Catholic Charities.
- **Outreach Ministry.** This past summer the youth of the parish that participated in HomeWorks repaired 3 homes. We continue to serve the homeless breakfast through Operation Inasmuch, provide weekly meals for the Care Clinic health care providers and clean up the streets in downtown Fayetteville with Adopt-a-Street.
- **Sacraments.** We helped 31 couples entered into a sacramental marriage, 32 people were confirmed, 37 people made their First Communion and we celebrated 52 baptisms. We also celebrated Virgin of the Americas.
- **Hispanic Ministry.** We have celebrated this year our regular annual events like the Three Wise Men at the Epiphany of the Lord, Virgin of the Americas in October, and Our Lady of Guadalupe in December. Also, our Adult Faith Formation programs have been available on Zoom and in presence this past year, ending the las in-person class with a pilgrimage to the Basilica of Mari in Wilmington. The Charismatic Prayer Group was able to come back in-person every Monday evening, and participated in a healing convention in Raleigh back in November.

It is because of YOU, and how you are a living example of the Gospel, the Good News, that we can be part of the living Church and bring the light of Christ to others.
