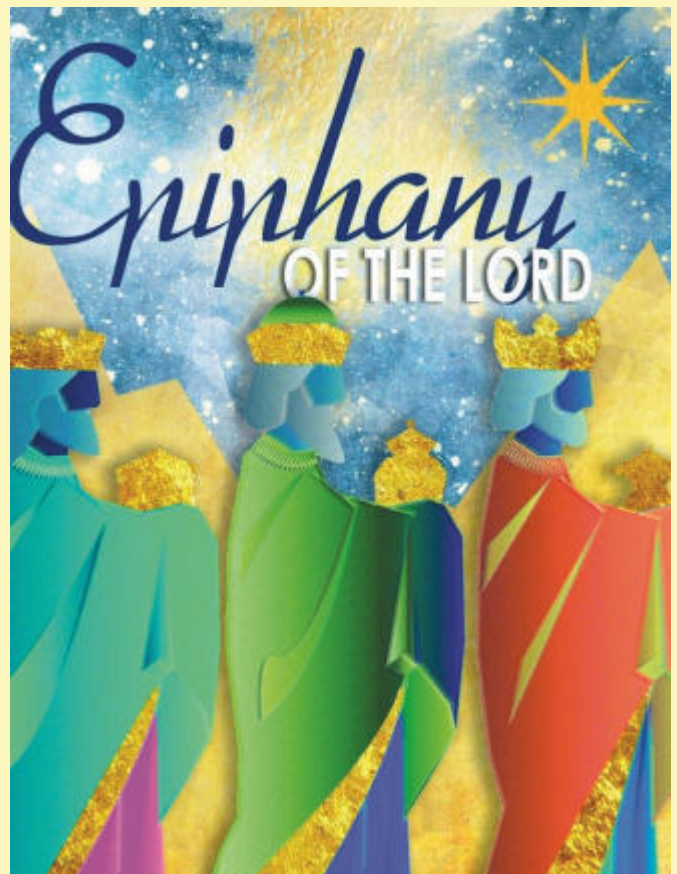

WE WELCOME ALL NEWCOMERS AND VISITORS TO BLESSED SACRAMENT CHURCH. If you would like to register at Blessed Sacrament, registration forms are available at the back of the church, in the parish office, or register online at blsac.org.

It is our custom that statements testifying to the active, participating, contributing status of an individual be provided for those wishing to be sacramental sponsors or for those wishing to receive a sacrament. We cannot issue such statements if you are not a registered and active member of Blessed Sacrament Church. You must use the offertory envelopes provided to registered parishioners to support your active status.

BAPTISM: Parents who wish to have their child/children baptized should contact the Parish Office. A preparatory session (class) is mandatory for the proper formation of parents and godparents. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a baptism.

MARRIAGE: Those wishing to enter into a sacramental marriage should contact the Parish Office at least six months prior to the intended date.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION: Preparations for the reception of these Sacraments are taken care of by the Office of Faith Formation. Please call Sarah Runko at 843-974-3609. **Members of Blessed Sacrament Church, who are asked to be Sponsors of Confirmation Candidates, will need to be Active Parishioners of the Parish.**

VISITING THE SICK: Please inform the Parish Office should a relative/friend who is homebound/hospitalized need a pastoral visit or the Sacrament of Anointing. A priest will attend to the Sacrament and, as needed, will arrange for Holy Communion to be brought to your loved one.

The General Dispensation from the obligation to attend Weekend Masses ended June 5th

With the lifting of the general dispensation,

A "Registered and Active" family/individual is one who:

1. Has been formally registered and participating in the life of the Parish for at least 3 months.
2. Participates in Worship through **weekly attendance** at Weekend Masses.
3. Places **envelopes weekly** in the offertory, even if empty.

- ~ If you give online, please turn in your empty envelopes weekly at Mass and check "I give online."
- ~ If you contribute periodically through the collection, please remember to put in envelopes weekly, even if empty, and mark "I attended Mass."
- ~ Contributions in cash can only be considered when presented in the parish envelope.
- ~ Multiple envelopes put in at a weekend Mass will be considered participation for that one Mass.
- ~ Envelopes Dropped off or Mailed will not be considered participation at Mass.
- ~ Blank Green envelopes are available in the church if needed.

Families need to be Active Members for a child to be eligible to receive a Sacrament.

Families need to be Active Members to receive reduced tuition rates at Blessed Sacrament School and Bishop England High School.

(Active parishioner status must be maintained for families in the Schools and Sacramental Program)

Individual dispensation, for those who are still at risk of grave illness and for their caretakers, will remain in place. *If you are not attending Mass because of an individual dispensation, please use Online Giving or mail envelopes to the Parish Office. If you are not attending Mass & do not mail envelopes to the parish office or use online giving, you will be considered a Non Active Parishioner.*

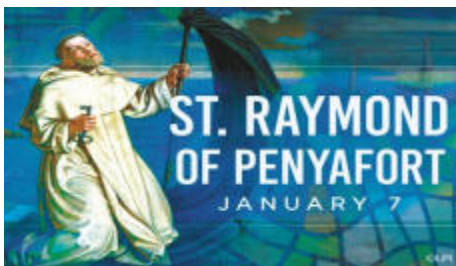

MATTHEW 2:10

THE SOLEMNITY OF THE EPIPHANY

The EPIPHANY is the MANIFESTATION OF JESUS TO THE WORLD signified by the visit of the Magi from the East.

The history of this visit was a familiar story of traders who would traverse the desert as a way of life ... bring goods for sale, barter, whatever. Seemingly these particular traders were catering to the needs of the wealthy. Their trade-goods included gold, frankincense and myrrh, expensive items! Gold = we know! Frankincense = let's just say a highly perfumed substance that had many applications. Myrrh = a substance that had medicinal applications. These were their most treasured items of trade.

Directed by the heavenly bodies (moon and constellations), as they were accustomed to in desert travel, there was this unusual sign that their familiarity had perhaps never experienced. Their decision to follow the particular star led them to the manger. Now it is custom in the East, then and even now, that new life, babies, are a gift from the Divine. Needless to say, this particular visit to the manger where the star seemed to have 'come to a halt', satisfied their curiosity that it was a recent birth scene. Presumably, in typical eastern custom, they must have raised their hands heavenwards as a response to the gift of the Divine. Then, as the biblical account continues, they opened their coffer (container for valuables) and gave their gifts of GOLD, FRANKINCENSE and MYRRH (the most expensive trade-items they had). We remember this account. It is part of the Christmas story. Pass it on!

Each year, by custom and faith, we too remember all that is associated with the Birth of Jesus Christ: the visit of the Angel Gabriel, the YES of Mary, the manger where animals are 'protected' at nightfall, the shepherds in the field, and the visit of the Magi (Three Kings, Travelers from the East, traders). And, as we remember, we join ourselves to this 'ancient' but ever new story of the Birth of Jesus Christ. As it brings joy to our hearts, we can continue the tradition of sharing the recorded happenings in our witness to these faith-accounts. Yes, it is Jesus, King of Kings, Lord of all, Savior of the world.

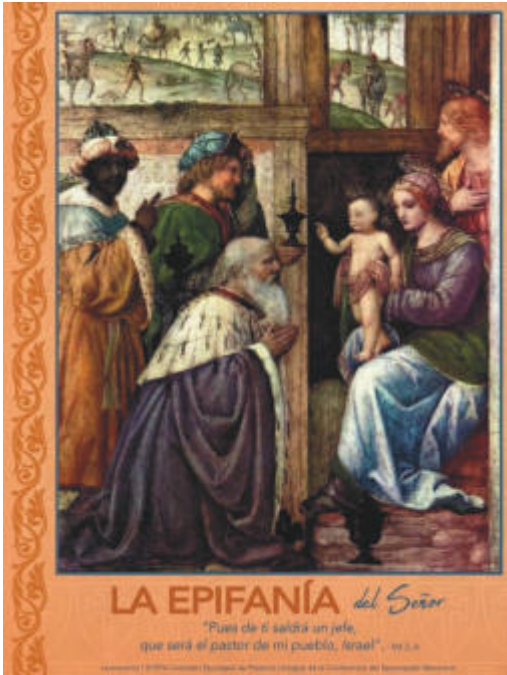

La Epifanía del Señor

El Papa Francisco nos explica acerca de la belleza de esta celebración. “La manifestación de Jesús, simbolizada por la luz: Levántate y resplandece, Jerusalén, porque llega tu luz; la Gloria del Señor amanece sobre ti”. Él nos exhorta al movimiento, a no quedarnos ahí fijos como estatuas sin hacer nada.

También, nos explica sobre la participación de los magos del Oriente y lo que ellos representan. “Los Magos, venidos de Oriente, representan a todos los pueblos lejanos de la fe judía tradicional: se dejan guiar por la estrella y se enfrentan a un largo y arriesgado viaje; se postran ante Jesús y le ofrecen regalos simbólicos: oro, incienso y mirra; la búsqueda del Señor implica también la generosidad del corazón” (1/6/2019). ¿Qué le estoy ofreciendo a Jesús en esta etapa de mi vida? ¿Qué tipo de manifestaciones he tenido de Dios a lo largo de mi vida? Pidamos, en esta Eucaristía, que la luz de Cristo se manifieste en estos tiempos turbulentos y oscuros que experimentamos en el mundo entero. Sigamos vigilantes, caminemos por sendas nuevas, sigamos el ejemplo de los Magos. Ellos, regresaron a su país por otro camino.

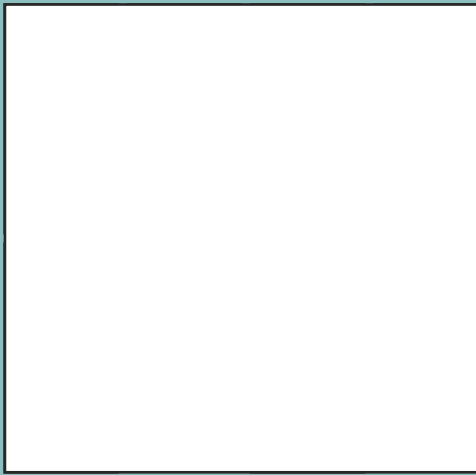
