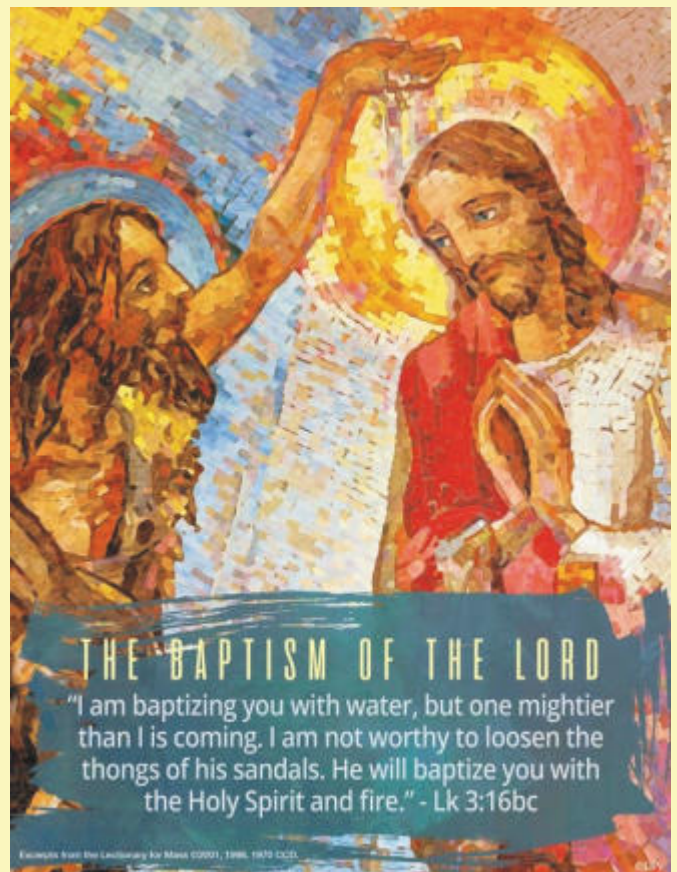

**BAPTISM:** Parents who wish to have their child/children baptized should contact the Parish Office. A preparatory session (class) is mandatory for the proper formation of parents and godparents. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a baptism.

**MARRIAGE:** Those wishing to enter into a sacramental marriage should contact the Parish Office at least six months prior to the intended date.

**FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION:** Preparations for the reception of these Sacraments are taken care of by the Office of Faith Formation. Please call Sarah Runko at 843-974-3609. **Members of Blessed Sacrament Church, who are asked to be Sponsors of Confirmation Candidates, will need to be Active Parishioners of the Parish.**

**VISITING THE SICK:** Please inform the Parish Office should a relative/friend who is homebound/hospitalized need a pastoral visit or the Sacrament of Anointing. A priest will attend to the Sacrament and, as needed, will arrange for Holy Communion to be brought to your loved one.

## **The General Dispensation from the obligation to attend Weekend Masses ended June 5<sup>th</sup>**

With the lifting of the general dispensation,

### **A "Registered and Active" family/individual is one who:**

1. Has been formally registered and participating in the life of the Parish for at least 3 months.
2. Participates in Worship through **weekly attendance** at Weekend Masses.
3. Places **envelopes weekly** in the offertory, even if empty.

- ~ If you give online, please turn in your empty envelopes weekly at Mass and check "I give online."
- ~ If you contribute periodically through the collection, please remember to put in envelopes weekly, even if empty, and mark "I attended Mass."
- ~ Contributions in cash can only be considered when presented in the parish envelope.
- ~ Multiple envelopes put in at a weekend Mass will be considered participation for that one Mass.
- ~ Envelopes Dropped off or Mailed will not be considered participation at Mass.
- ~ Blank Green envelopes are available in the church if needed.

### **Families need to be Active Members for a child to be eligible to receive a Sacrament.**

#### **Families need to be Active Members to receive reduced tuition rates at Blessed Sacrament School and Bishop England High School.**

*(Active parishioner status must be maintained for families in the Schools and Sacramental Program)*

Individual dispensation, for those who are still at risk of grave illness and for their caretakers, will remain in place. *If you are not attending Mass because of an individual dispensation, please use Online Giving or mail envelopes to the Parish Office. If you are not attending Mass & do not mail envelopes to the parish office or use online giving, you will be considered a Non Active Parishioner.*

ONCE A CHILD FROM A PARISH FAMILY FINISHES HIGH SCHOOL, WE ASK THAT HE/SHE REGISTERS INDIVIDUALLY AS AN ADULT MEMBER OF THE PARISH, AND WE ENCOURAGE HIM/HER TO PARTICIPATE AS FULLY ENGAGED STEWARDS OF THE PARISH.

## THE FEAST OF THE HOLY FAMILY

## THE SOLEMNITY OF MARY, MOTHER OF GOD



In her tradition, Holy Mother the Church, from early times, celebrated this Feast. The Sacred Scriptures bear witness to this faith. Remember the greeting of the Angel Gabriel: “Hail, Full of Grace”. Fittingly, in her Liturgy, the observance of the first day of the New Year is dedicated to the care and protection of the Mother of God. She wishes the best for her adopted children – that each one of us should live in the light and life of HER Son, Jesus. What a blessing!

## THE BAPTISM OF JESUS BY JOHN IN THE JORDAN



From ancient times, baptism was meant to signify a change of lifestyle in the spiritual sense – it signified a conversion of heart. John’s entire mission was to prepare the people for the coming of the Savior which necessitated a ritual immersion in water (thus signifying a cleansing of the exterior) that indicated a change of heart, a conversion of the interior.

Those who were looking forward to the Savior were anxiously waiting for the fulfillment of all the Old Testament prophecies. The expectations were somewhat different in terms of what this Savior would do for them. Was he going to be a political leader who would rid the nation of foreign domination? Was he to be a spiritual Savior restoring a right relationship with Yahweh? Would he exercise worldly power? Depending on their notion of ‘Savior’ was their reception of the Infant born in Bethlehem of Judea. Those who accepted Jesus in line with the prophecies of old were looking forward to a ‘new heaven and a new earth’; those who were focused on status and power were disappointed at the lowly birth, the lack of worldly power, etc. etc.

Now enters John the Baptist into the picture of everyday life. His manner of life, his preaching was strange to say the least. As is so often the case in life, people juxtapose ‘manner of life’ with their individual aspirations of the accomplishments of ‘such a person’. John was no exception. For some he was out of his mind. For others his words were powerful. The gradual acceptance of the Baptist created the right kind of ‘mind and heart’ for spiritual rejuvenation that he preached. So the Jordan scene and the external manifestation of conversion brought many people to the saving ritual of washing... the poor, the rich and the in-between, the simple and the educated.

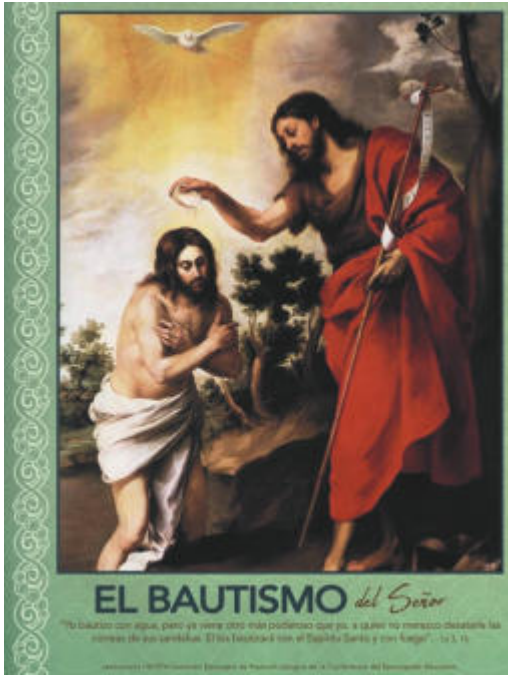

**Meditación del Evangelio**  
**29 de enero de 2022**

*El Bautismo del Señor*

Con la celebración del Bautismo del Señor se da por terminado el tiempo de Navidad. El Bautismo de Jesús es como una nueva epifanía, es decir, una nueva manifestación de Dios por medio de Jesús ahora en el Jordán. “El Espíritu Santo bajó sobre él y se manifestó exteriormente en forma de paloma, y del cielo vino una voz: Tú eres mi Hijo, hoy te he dado la vida” (Lucas 3,22). La revelación del Padre se manifiesta proclamando a Jesús como su Hijo.

El Papa Francisco en una de sus catequesis lo muestra en tres puntos muy importantes para todos los que hemos sido bautizados en Cristo Jesús: “Jesús quiso recibir el bautismo predicado y administrado por Juan el Bautista en el Jordán. ¡Cuánta humildad tiene Jesús! 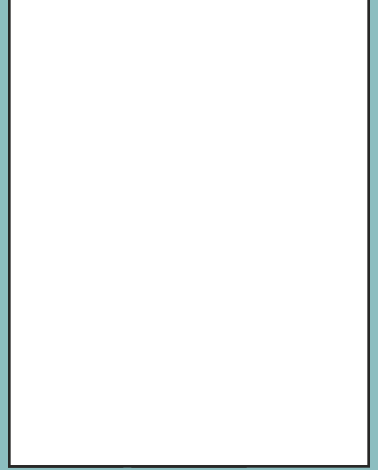

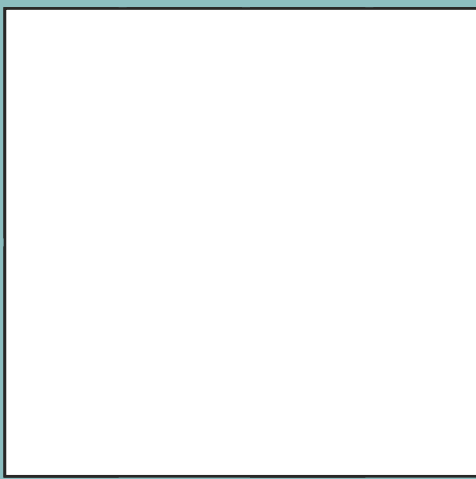
