It is our custom that statements testifying to the active, participating, contributing status of an individual be provided for those wishing to be sacramental sponsors or for those wishing to receive a sacrament. We cannot issue such statements if you are not a registered and active member of Blessed Sacrament Church. You must use the offertory envelopes provided to registered parishioners to support your active status.

**BAPTISM:** Parents who wish to have their child/children baptized should contact the Parish Office. A preparatory session (class) is mandatory for the proper formation of parents and godparents. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a baptism.

**MARRIAGE:** Those wishing to enter into a sacramental marriage should contact the Parish Office at least six months prior to the intended date.

**FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION:** Preparations for the reception of these Sacraments are taken care of by the Office of Faith Formation. Please call Sarah Runko at 843-974-3609. **Members of Blessed Sacrament Church, who are asked to be Sponsors of Confirmation Candidates, will need to be Active Parishioners of the Parish.**

**VISITING THE SICK:** Please inform the Parish Office should a relative/friend who is homebound/hospitalized need a pastoral visit or the Sacrament of Anointing. A priest will attend to the Sacrament and, as needed, will arrange for Holy Communion to be brought to your loved one.

## The General Dispensation from the obligation to attend Weekend Masses ended June 5<sup>th</sup>

With the lifting of the general dispensation,

### A "Registered and Active" family/individual is one who:

1. Has been formally registered and participating in the life of the Parish for at least 3 months.
2. Participates in Worship through **weekly attendance** at Weekend Masses.
3. Places **envelopes weekly** in the offertory, even if empty.

- ~ If you give online, please turn in your empty envelopes weekly at Mass and check "I give online."
- ~ If you contribute periodically through the collection, please remember to put in envelopes weekly, even if empty, and mark "I attended Mass."
- ~ Contributions in cash can only be considered when presented in the parish envelope.
- ~ Multiple envelopes put in at a weekend Mass will be considered participation for that one Mass.
- ~ Envelopes Dropped off or Mailed will not be considered participation at Mass.
- ~ Blank Green envelopes are available in the church if needed.

### **Families need to be Active Members for a child to be eligible to receive a Sacrament.**

### **Families need to be Active Members to receive reduced tuition rates at Blessed Sacrament School and Bishop England High School.**

*(Active parishioner status must be maintained for families in the Schools and Sacramental Program)*

Individual dispensation, for those who are still at risk of grave illness and for their caretakers, will remain in place. *If you are not attending Mass because of an individual dispensation, please use Online Giving or mail envelopes to the Parish Office. If you are not attending Mass & do not mail envelopes to the parish office or use online giving, you will be considered a Non Active Parishioner.*

ONCE A CHILD FROM A PARISH FAMILY FINISHES HIGH SCHOOL, WE ASK THAT HE/SHE REGISTERS INDIVIDUALLY AS AN ADULT MEMBER OF THE PARISH, AND WE ENCOURAGE HIM/HER TO PARTICIPATE AS FULLY ENGAGED STEWARDS OF THE PARISH.

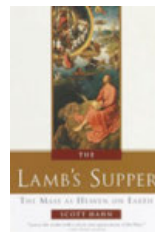

## **ORDINARY TIME (THE FIRST PART)**

In the worship year of the Church, the major Seasons are: ADVENT, CHRISTMAS, LENT, EASTER. Outside these times, the year is called ORDINARY TIME. This TIME is divided into two parts: the first of approximately 9 weeks following Christmas – Monday, January 10 thru Tuesday, March 1 - and the second of about 25 weeks following Easter – till the day after the Solemnity of Pentecost (June 6). During ORDINARY TIME, Holy Mother the Church, in her liturgy, celebrates various feasts and observances dedicated in the name of persons (Jesus, Mary, Joseph, the saints and martyrs), events and other significant occasions. The liturgical color of ORDINARY TIME is GREEN ... signifying GROWTH – how the Church has grown in holiness over time. (The other colors are Red, White, Violet and Black).

Just for the heck of it.... Calendars have been many over the years (and for centuries past)! Suffice it to say that the common understanding of the word CALENDAR is simply ‘the sequential order of days and dates which gives us the ability to keep a record of happenings etc. or to project the same for the future’. It is in the above sense of things that we can speak of a LITURGICAL CALENDAR: the sequence of days and dates which enables the Church to organize religious Seasons, Feasts and Solemnities. Think about it ... your date of birth doesn’t change annually, and there’s nothing that you or I can do about our individual dates of death!!!

I hope 2022 has started well for you and that it continues in the same vein!

## **HOW CONVERSATIONS PROVOKE WEIGHTY INSIGHTS!!**

I have learned in these many years of ministry that little chit-chat here and there can provoke some serious thinking for all of us. Like for instance ...

WHAT SEEMS TO HAVE HAPPENED TO THE RESPECT THAT WE SHOULD GIVE TO SACRED SPACE – THE CHURCH ITSELF?

WHAT HAPPENED TO THE TRADITIONAL PRACTICE OF GENUFLECTION (FLEXING ONE KNEE TO GIVE HONOR TO THE PRESENCE OF JESUS IN THE TABERNACLE)?

IS THE ACT OF CONSECRATION A MOMENT OF MYSTERY AND AWE?

**Regarding #1:** True ... it has been noticed that folks enter into Church carrying on the same conversation that they did not conclude outside the Church. Also, I have noticed that some folks look out for their ‘conversation partner’ to catch-up on the latest news that is circulating. I deliberately arrive at the back of Church in the hope that people will curtail ‘small talk’. Some even wish to include me in the chit-chat! No, no, no. This is not proper. Once you enter the Church, please respect the House of God by collecting your thoughts about the great mystery of the Eucharist you have come to celebrate. CUT OUT THE SMALL TALK. TALK WITH JESUS PRESENT IN THE TABERNACLE.

**Regarding #2:** There are many ways to pay respect to the presence of Jesus in the tabernacle ... a genuflection, a bow of the head, a bow from the waist. I have observed our young people walk right in and SIT without any sign of respect to the Real Presence of the Lord. Then some take out their cell phones and ‘get to work’. No, no, no. This is not proper. TURN OFF THE CELL PHONE. TALK WITH JESUS PRESENT IN THE TABERNACLE.

**Regarding #3:** And then, as the Consecration is being prayed, parents take their children to the restroom; sometimes even adults march off to the restroom. No, no, no. This is not proper. JESUS IS PRESENT IN HIS BODY AND IN HIS BLOOD. Urgency/Emergency is a different matter. So much for that.

Folks, let’s pause and think about the implications of our actions. Our children learn from us. Surely, no adult wishes to teach such behavior to their children.

Doing my job as a priest!

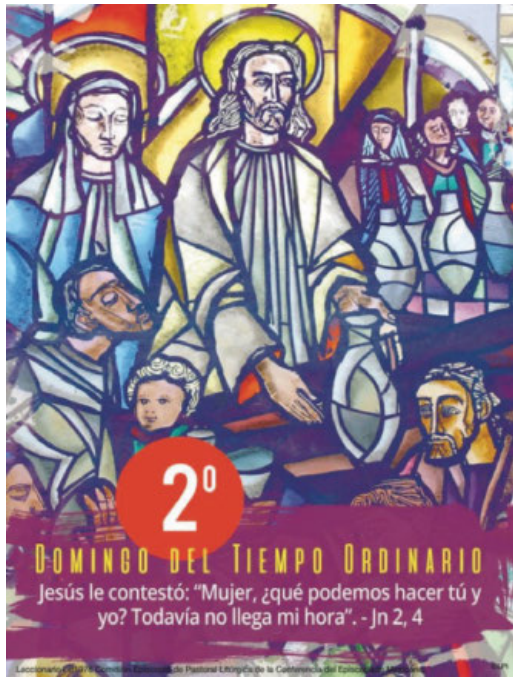

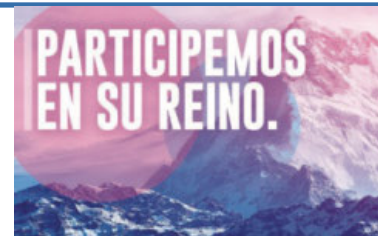

*2.º Domingo Tiempo Ordinario*

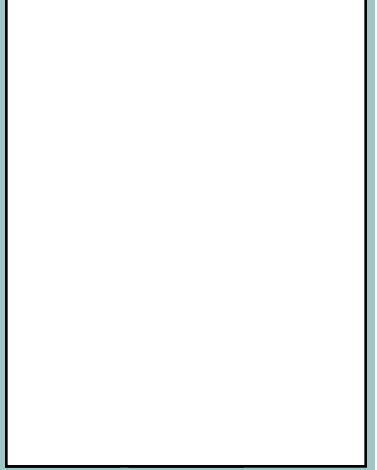

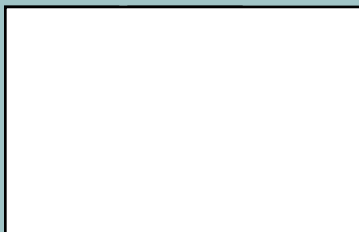
