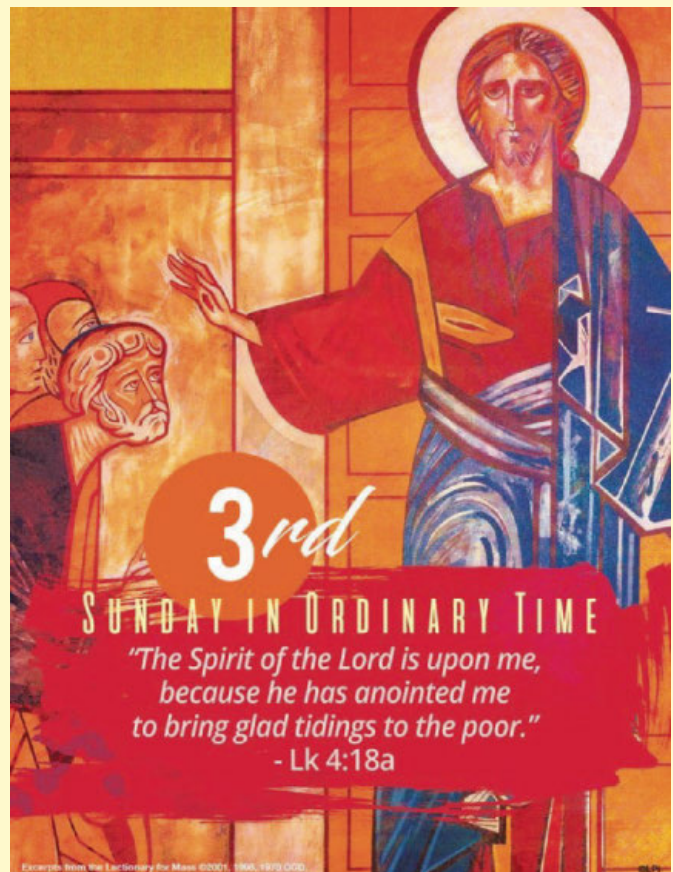

WE WELCOME ALL NEWCOMERS AND VISITORS TO BLESSED SACRAMENT CHURCH. If you would like to register at Blessed Sacrament, registration forms are available at the back of the church, in the parish office, or register online at blsac.org.

It is our custom that statements testifying to the active, participating, contributing status of an individual be provided for those wishing to be sacramental sponsors or for those wishing to receive a sacrament. We cannot issue such statements if you are not a registered and active member of Blessed Sacrament Church. You must use the offertory envelopes provided to registered parishioners to support your active status.

BAPTISM: Parents who wish to have their child/children baptized should contact the Parish Office. A preparatory session (class) is mandatory for the proper formation of parents and godparents. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a baptism.

MARRIAGE: Those wishing to enter into a sacramental marriage should contact the Parish Office at least six months prior to the intended date.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION: Preparations for the reception of these Sacraments are taken care of by the Office of Faith Formation. Please call Sarah Runko at 843-974-3609. **Members of Blessed Sacrament Church, who are asked to be Sponsors of Confirmation Candidates, will need to be Active Parishioners of the Parish.**

VISITING THE SICK: Please inform the Parish Office should a relative/friend who is homebound/hospitalized need a pastoral visit or the Sacrament of Anointing. A priest will attend to the Sacrament and, as needed, will arrange for Holy Communion to be brought to your loved one.

The General Dispensation from the obligation to attend Weekend Masses ended June 5th

With the lifting of the general dispensation,

A "Registered and Active" family/individual is one who:

1. Has been formally registered and participating in the life of the Parish for at least 3 months.
2. Participates in Worship through **weekly attendance** at Weekend Masses.
3. Places **envelopes weekly** in the offertory, even if empty.

- ~ If you give online, please turn in your empty envelopes weekly at Mass and check "I give online."
- ~ If you contribute periodically through the collection, please remember to put in envelopes weekly, even if empty, and mark "I attended Mass."
- ~ Contributions in cash can only be considered when presented in the parish envelope.
- ~ Multiple envelopes put in at a weekend Mass will be considered participation for that one Mass.
- ~ Envelopes Dropped off or Mailed will not be considered participation at Mass.
- ~ Blank Green envelopes are available in the church if needed.

Families need to be Active Members for a child to be eligible to receive a Sacrament.

Families need to be Active Members to receive reduced tuition rates at Blessed Sacrament School and Bishop England High School.

(Active parishioner status must be maintained for families in the Schools and Sacramental Program)

Individual dispensation, for those who are still at risk of grave illness and for their caretakers, will remain in place. *If you are not attending Mass because of an individual dispensation, please use Online Giving or mail envelopes to the Parish Office. If you are not attending Mass & do not mail envelopes to the parish office or use online giving, you will be considered a Non Active Parishioner.*

ONCE A CHILD FROM A PARISH FAMILY FINISHES HIGH SCHOOL, WE ASK THAT HE/SHE REGISTERS INDIVIDUALLY AS AN ADULT MEMBER OF THE PARISH, AND WE ENCOURAGE HIM/HER TO PARTICIPATE AS FULLY ENGAGED STEWARDS OF THE PARISH.



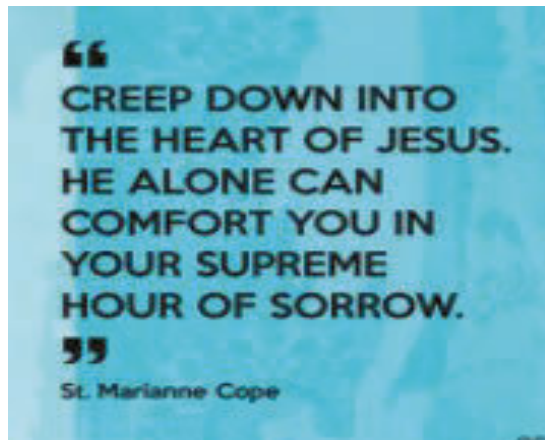

WHAT MAKES CATHOLIC LITURGICAL MUSIC SO SPECIAL???

Two important considerations ...

One: All music reflects the creative skills of musicians and singers. They are gifted persons, and a good musician (as well as a good singer) uses the gifts of dexterity, timing and delivery for their personal fulfillment as well as the enjoyment provided to their listeners.

Two: Liturgical Music is a class by itself. St. Thomas Aquinas, the great Doctor of the Church and an erudite scholar of the Middle Ages, in his discussion of art in general (music included), mentions three points of good liturgical music:

1) INTEGRITY, 2) RIGHT PROPORTION & CONSONANCE, 3) SPLENDOR OF FORM.

LITURGICAL MUSIC MUST REFLECT THE THEOLOGY OF THE TRADITION.

Liturgy is the manner in which the human relates to the divine in worship. Integrity must reflect in lyrics and song the theology of the Catholic tradition. Catholic music must first of all reflect Catholic Theology (the Catholic understanding of the expressions of faith and tradition). It must create the background of good worship. It must cater to the 'faith and tradition' of the Catholic faithful. It must be solidly based on Scripture and Tradition. Hence there is no place for emotional and somewhat light-hearted lyrics nor an adaptation of stage-show popular music "for worship of the Divine". Broadway is not Church. **CATHOLIC LITURGICAL MUSIC MUST HAVE INTEGRITY.**

LITURGICAL MUSIC must be geared to accompanying the prayer sentiments of the worshipping community. Hence the 'folks in the pews' must PRAY the music. Good liturgical music fosters community participation. The liturgical musician must compose (direct, teach) songs that are attractive by their melody and therefore easy for the community to voice in song. **CATHOLIC LITURGICAL MUSIC MUST HAVE PROPORTIONALITY AND CONSONANCE.**

LITURGICAL MUSIC MUST HAVE SPLENDOR AND FORM. The mind and heart of the community at worship should feel unified by the musical format of their prayer. Popular music, in lyrics and song, is geared to popular sentiments irrespective of the faith-tradition of participants. Catholic liturgical music must therefore lead to the honor and worship given the Almighty. Surely there is a world of difference between HAVE A HOLLY JOLLY CHRISTMAS and O COME ALL YE FAITHFUL!!

In my experience of years (!) I have known many coaches who have never actually played the sport they coach (or coached) ... they know the rules of the game and how, when and where to apply them!

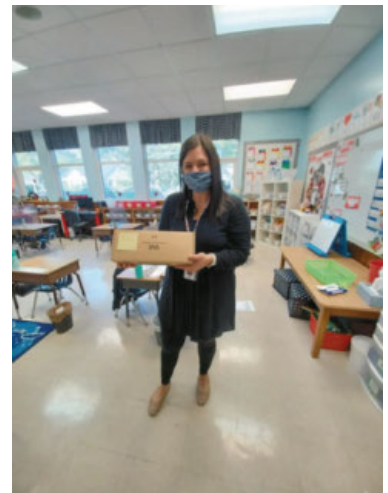
Thank you again for supporting our #iGiveCatholic campaign to invest in technology at BSCS. Pictures here are some of the teachers who received new document cameras.

Meditación del Evangelio

23 de enero de 2022

3.º Domingo Tiempo Ordinario

“Canten al Señor un cántico nuevo, hombres de toda la tierra, canten al Señor. Hay brillo y esplendor en su presencia, y en su templo, belleza y majestad” (Salmo 95, 1,67). La esperanza de Jesús para su pueblo y para toda la humanidad empieza aquí con este pasaje de la Sagrada Escritura. Un mundo nuevo y diverso, sin divisiones ni estatus sociales que dividen y matan. Por el contrario, una tierra redimida y armoniosa, sin tinieblas ni miedos. Esta sigue siendo la esperanza de Jesús por medio de su Iglesia, que siempre, domingo a domingo, nos invita a acoger el Evangelio de Cristo. Abrazar su mensaje y dejarlo penetrar en el corazón hasta que dé fruto. Esto significa también todas sus exigencias de amor que conlleva en el cumplimiento de sus mandamientos.

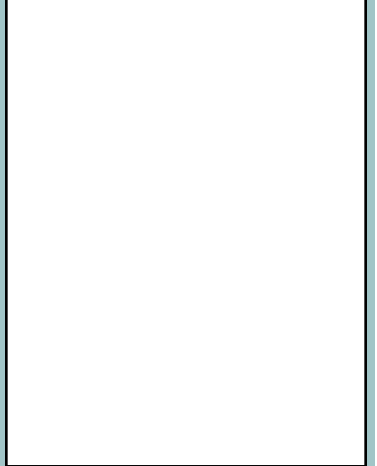

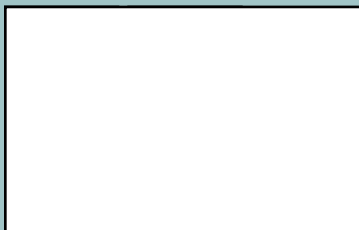
