It is our custom that statements testifying to the active, participating, contributing status of an individual be provided for those wishing to be sacramental sponsors or for those wishing to receive a sacrament. We cannot issue such statements if you are not a registered and active member of Blessed Sacrament Church. You must use the offertory envelopes provided to registered parishioners to support your active status.

**BAPTISM:** Parents who wish to have their child/children baptized should contact the Parish Office. A preparatory session (class) is mandatory for the proper formation of parents and godparents. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a baptism.

**MARRIAGE:** Those wishing to enter into a sacramental marriage should contact the Parish Office at least six months prior to the intended date.

**FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION:** Preparations for the reception of these Sacraments are taken care of by the Office of Faith Formation. Please call Sarah Runko at 843-974-3609. **Members of Blessed Sacrament Church, who are asked to be Sponsors of Confirmation Candidates, will need to be Active Parishioners of the Parish.**

**VISITING THE SICK:** Please inform the Parish Office should a relative/friend who is homebound/hospitalized need a pastoral visit or the Sacrament of Anointing. A priest will attend to the Sacrament and, as needed, will arrange for Holy Communion to be brought to your loved one.

## **The General Dispensation from the obligation to attend Weekend Masses ended June 5<sup>th</sup>**

With the lifting of the general dispensation,

### **A "Registered and Active" family/individual is one who:**

1. Has been formally registered and participating in the life of the Parish for at least 3 months.
2. Participates in Worship through **weekly attendance** at Weekend Masses.
3. Places **envelopes weekly** in the offertory, even if empty.

- ~ If you give online, please turn in your empty envelopes weekly at Mass and check "I give online."
- ~ If you contribute periodically through the collection, please remember to put in envelopes weekly, even if empty, and mark "I attended Mass."
- ~ Contributions in cash can only be considered when presented in the parish envelope.
- ~ Multiple envelopes put in at a weekend Mass will be considered participation for that one Mass.
- ~ Envelopes Dropped off or Mailed will not be considered participation at Mass.
- ~ Blank Green envelopes are available in the church if needed.

### **Families need to be Active Members for a child to be eligible to receive a Sacrament.**

#### **Families need to be Active Members to receive reduced tuition rates at Blessed Sacrament School and Bishop England High School.**

*(Active parishioner status must be maintained for families in the Schools and Sacramental Program)*

Individual dispensation, for those who are still at risk of grave illness and for their caretakers, will remain in place. *If you are not attending Mass because of an individual dispensation, please use Online Giving or mail envelopes to the Parish Office. If you are not attending Mass & do not mail envelopes to the parish office or use online giving, you will be considered a Non Active Parishioner.*

ONCE A CHILD FROM A PARISH FAMILY FINISHES HIGH SCHOOL, WE ASK THAT HE/SHE REGISTERS INDIVIDUALLY AS AN ADULT MEMBER OF THE PARISH, AND WE ENCOURAGE HIM/HER TO PARTICIPATE AS FULLY ENGAGED STEWARDS OF THE PARISH.

## Saint of the Week

You may be familiar with the annual "blessing of throats" that many parishes in the United States use to commemorate the beloved bishop and martyr, St. Blaise lived in the fourth century in Turkey and Armenia. Due to religious persecution, he was forced to flee and hide in a cave in the back country in order to save his life.

History has it that one day a group of hunters stumbled upon where St. Blaise was living. They found the bishop kneeling in prayer, surrounded by wolves, lions and bears that he had tamed. The legend has it that as the hunters dragged Blaise off to prison, a mother came with her young son who had a fish bone lodged in his throat. At Blaise's command, the child was able to cough up the bone and thus lived.

Today we remember the saint on his feast day by taking two candles, crossing them against the throat, and saying the following prayer:

*Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.*

## **THE POWER OF THE EVIL ONE** **(ALIAS ... THE DEVIL, SATAN, LUCIFER)**

It is presumed that from the age of reason (say 7yrs old) we are able to make the foundational judgement of what is right and wrong, good and bad, virtuous and vicious and so on. Exceptions to this general understanding are also possible. My mama used to say, when I was about sixteen or so, "When are you going to learn???" You are old enough to distinguish between right and wrong." Perhaps I had a slight delay in 'growing up'!!!

Excuses, excuses, excuses – we all seem to find one whenever! The consequences of our thoughts, words and deeds are inescapable. They catch up with us. Put it this way: if the devil could tempt Jesus to go against His heavenly Father's Will, then who are you and I? This is not an excuse to give in, rather, it is a reason to opt for the good life, the right action, the noble thought.

The sources of temptation are (Mathew 4:1-12) THE WORLD, THE FLESH AND THE DEVIL and each, in their own way, try to separate us from God's holy Will. Yes it is basic to our Christian philosophy that there is a power for evil and a power for good. AND GOOD IS ALWAYS STRONGER. GOD IS GOODNESS. RESORT TO THE POWER OF GOD TO HELP DEFEAT THE WAYS OF THE DEVIL.

How???

Some suggestions...

Participate at Mass with some regularity and receive the strengthening grace of Jesus in the Eucharist.

Frequent the Sacrament of Reconciliation and make a good confession when you succumb to the world, the flesh or the devil.

Spend time in Eucharistic adoration when the occasion is available.

Seek the intercession of the Blessed Virgin who, because of her great love for her Son, will intercede for anyone who wishes to stay close to Him.

Read the Sacred Scriptures knowing that God's holy Word therein is not a scientific remedy rather a history of how God acts in the lives of His people.

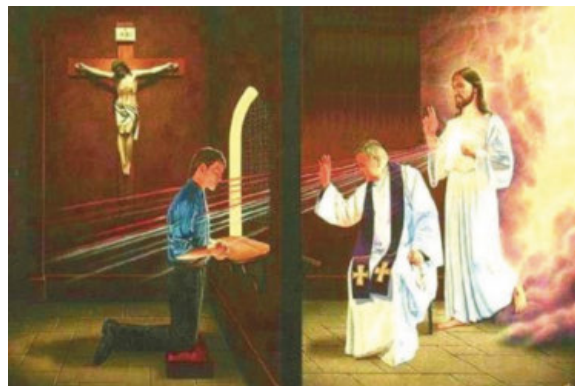
Participate in some devotional life that stems from the great mysteries of the faith.

Use sacramentals (Holy Water, blessed objects, sacred images) for they are signs of holiness.

Avoid isolation. The devil seems always ready to be a close companion!

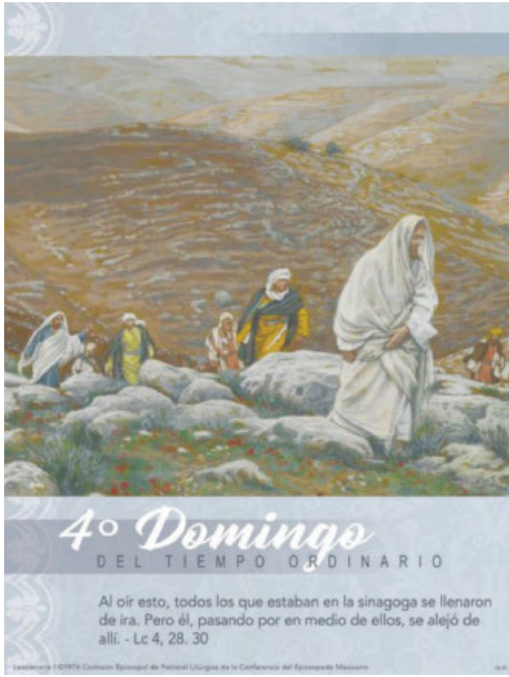

### Historia de la fiesta

A mediados del siglo V esta fiesta se conocía como "La Candelaria" o "Fiesta de las Luces". La Virgen María ha dado luz a la Luz del Mundo, Jesucristo, y en esta fiesta Él se manifiesta a Simeón y Ana.

Hasta el siglo VI se celebraba a los cuarenta días de la Epifanía, el 15 de febrero. Ahora se celebra el 2 de febrero, por ser a los cuarenta días de la Navidad.

De origen oriental, esta fiesta no se introdujo en la liturgia del Occidente hasta el siglo VII. Al final de este siglo ya estaba extendida en toda Roma y en casi todo Occidente. En un principio, al igual que en Oriente, se celebraba la Presentación de Jesús más que la Purificación de María.

El Concilio Vaticano II restaura esta fiesta a su origen primariamente Cristológico, celebrándose como la Presentación de Jesús en el Templo.

3. Colocan los sobres semanalmente en la cesta de la colecta en la Misa, aunque estén vacíos.

- Si usted da su ofrenda en línea, por favor, en la Misa, entregue su sobre vacío marcando la casilla «I give online».
- Si usted contribuye ocasionalmente por medio de la colecta de la Misa, por favor, recuerde entregar su sobre semanalmente, aunque sea vacío, y marque la casilla «I attended Mass» que indica que asistió a Misa.
- Las contribuciones en efectivo solo se pueden tomar en cuenta cuando se colocan en la colecta dentro del sobre personalizado de la parroquia.
- Sobres múltiples colocados en una Misa se consideran como participación en esa sola Misa, independientemente de las fechas que indiquen los sobres.

**Meditación del Evangelio**

**30 de enero de 2022**

*4.º Domingo Tiempo Ordinario*

Ser cristiano es ser un profeta comprometido en el amor y en la esperanza. La Liturgia de hoy, por medio del profeta Jeremías, nos pone en alerta sobre este asunto del llamado de Dios al discipulado ya desde el vientre materno: “Antes de formarte en el seno de tu madre, ya te conocía; antes de que tú nacieras, yo te consagré, y te destiné a ser profeta de las naciones” (Jeremías 1,5). Para comprender con mayor claridad y poner manos a la obra en este llamado, debemos recordar que, el domingo pasado, Jesús se encontraba en la sinagoga de Nazaret y sus últimas palabras del pasaje de la Escritura decían: “Hoy se cumplen estas palabras proféticas y a ustedes les llegan noticias de ello” (Lucas 4,21).

Los que escuchaban a Jesús se admiraban de su elocuencia. ¡No lo podían creer! Ellos lo conocían, habían vivido a su alrededor, tenían familiaridad con él. Por lo menos sabían su oficio, “carpintero, hijo de José y María”. Jesús conocía sus pensamientos y responde: “Seguramente ustedes me van a recordar el dicho: Médico, cúrate a ti mismo. Realiza también aquí, en tu patria, lo que nos cuentan que hiciste en Cafarnaúm” (Lucas 4,23). ¿Por qué nadie es profeta en su tierra? Le pasó a Jesús y nos pasa muchas veces a nosotros, hacemos el bien por ahí y cuando se dan cuenta los vecinos y la familia, viene el cuestionamiento y los comentarios sin saber realmente lo que la persona es, vive, o siente. O, mejor dicho, se ignora su compromiso con el amor, como lo expresa San Pablo a los Corintios: “Ahora, pues, son válidas la fe, la esperanza y el amor: pero la mayor de estas tres es el amor” (1 Corintios 13,13).

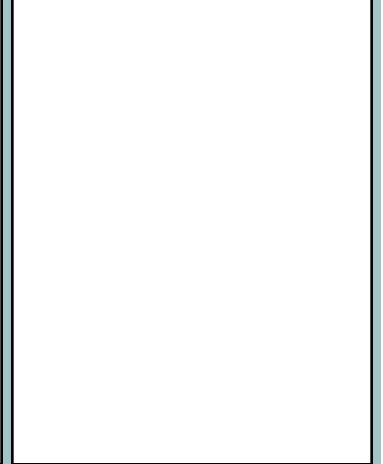

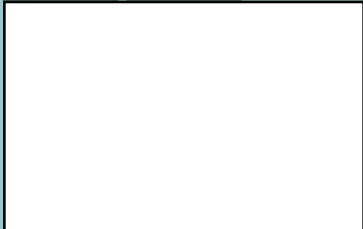
