


We pray the Rosary in person after the daily noon Mass and after the 8:30 a.m. Saturday Mass.

Music During Lent

How does the music change during Lent? Music at Mass during the Lenten season is more somber than any other time of the year, as there is a major shift in tone liturgically. While we still sing out confidently in praise of the Lord, we no longer sing "Alleluia" or the Gloria, as both have a celebratory nature, and therefore, are reserved for the non-penitential seasons.

We will be using <u>Parce Domine</u> -- sung in both Latin and English -- as our Lenten Processional music, and you will also notice the priests processing out of Mass in silence during Lent to emphasize the starkness of the season.

Just as is true for every liturgical season, the Lenten Eucharistic Acclamations sheet music can be found inside the front cover of the hymnal in the pews.

During Lent, our focus is on Christ's sufferings. John 3:30 is an excellent summation of this, "He must increase; I must decrease." Thus, sacred silence is more prominent at Mass and the music reflects that melancholy sentiment. Other than the bare minimum to support singing, instrumental music is omitted (GIRM 313). On Good Friday, the voice will be unaccompanied.

Why do we sometimes sing in Latin? The short answer is that it elevates our prayer, unifies us, and strengthens our community worship. We do so most prominently during Lent and Advent.

Our worship language has gone from Hebrew to Greek to Latin. As a result of Vatican II reforms we now celebrate Mass in vernacular languages. However, the council never intended for Latin to be eliminated from the liturgy. In fact, the council states that Latin should be preserved in the Rites, even with growing use of the vernacular at Mass (Sacrosanctum Concilium 36.1, 54). Just as "Amen" and "Alleluia" connect us to the Hebrew language and "Kyrie eleison" and "Eucharist" connect us to the Greek language, singing in Latin also connects us with our Church history and elevates our worship.

Embrace the beauty in the simplicity and intentional starkness of the music during Lent. Turn your focus toward His sufferings and sacrifice as we longingly await the joy of the Easter season.



Nuestra conducta cristiana

Después de resumir las cuatro bienaventuranzas del domingo pasado, san Lucas nos ayuda a profundizar en la doctrina de Jesús y en sus palabras. Alerta con frases sabias a todos los cristianos, que de alguna manera se acercan al Evangelio: "Yo les digo a ustedes que me escuchan" (Lucas 6,27). Se trata de una colección de principios que versan así: "Amen a sus enemigos, hagan el bien a los que los odian, bendigan a los que los maldicen, y rueguen por los que los maltratan" (Lucas 6, 27-28). Cada uno de estos principios o reglas invitan a una seria reflexión. Deben penetrar en el corazón y en la mente para que produzcan mucho fruto.

Además, se nos dan pautas para caminar el camino de Jesús. Realidades increíbles que dice el Maestro, muchas veces imposibles de llevar a cabo. Poner la otra mejilla al ser golpeados, al que arrebata el manto darle también el vestido, dar al que pide, y al que te quita no reclamarle. ¿Cómo se hace esto? Son ejemplos concretos de conducta cristiana que no fallan al ponerlos en práctica. Jesús nos enseña que lo que importa es la persona y que debemos dejar a un lado los prejuicios y diferencias sociales. Si mi prójimo me necesita, ahí debo estar sin fijarme en la raza o el color. Por esa razón existe la regla de oro: "Traten a los demás como quieren que ellos les traten a ustedes" (Lucas 6,31).

Reception of Holy Communion

Let us all pray for union with the Lord Jesus, that the Holy Spirit will dispel the sad divisions which separate Christians, and for the peace and unity of the whole human family.




