



Las lecturas nos llevan a meditar el libro del Éxodo. Tiempo donde se invita a ir al desierto para reflexionar en las propias tentaciones que nos alejan de Dios. Lenten Abstinence Regulations

Every Friday during Lent is a day of abstinence.

ABSTINENCE is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the Parish Priest should be consulted.







My Dear Parishioners,

In our bulletin of February 6th, 2022, I announced that we would be clearing the structures on the property that we bought last summer that is adjacent to our entrance. At that time, I mentioned that we would be considering how to best use this area of our campus.

The property is now safely cleared and after much deliberation and discussion with my team, I have decided to move forward with the planning of a columbarium as well as possibly Stations of the Cross, a walking trail and a garden area on that site. The Diocese of Charleston has given us their approval to proceed with the planning including updating our Master Plan. During this planning phase, which will continue over the next months, we will further assess this opportunity and the feasibility of these initiatives.

We have a lot to consider in this process. If the columbarium and other elements come to fruition, I want it to be a serene, peaceful and beautiful place.

I look forward to sharing with you our plans as they develop.
