



No se puede echar en saco roto la predicación de Jesús, urge la conversión, el Evangelio evoca diversos motivos para el cambio radical de la persona. La gente le pregunta y él responde con claridad y sencillez. San Gregorio Magno (540-604. Homilía 31, 4), exhorta a las personas con una reflexión profunda sobre la higuera que no da fruto: "Con un grande temor se debe escuchar lo que se dice: Córtala. ¿Para qué ocupa la tierra inútilmente? Cada uno a su manera, si no hace buenas obras. Pero desde el momento que ocupa un espacio en la vida presente, es un árbol que ocupa inútilmente el terreno, porque en ese lugar en donde está, impide que ahí se ponga otro a trabajar".

Continua su homilía. "Pero hay algo más grave, y es que los poderosos de este mundo, si no realizan ningún bien, no lo hacen producir ni siguiera en aquellos que dependen de ellos, porque su ejemplo actúa sobre sus subalternos como una sombra estimulante de perversidad... Sofocados por la sombra no reciben el calor del sol y permanecen fríos, sin el calor de Dios. Pero el pensamiento de este poderoso, cualquiera que sea su nombre, no es más objeto directo de los cuidados de Dios. Dejarnos cuidar por Dios es el mensaje de Cristo. La Iglesia administra cuidadosamente los sacramentos para que sus fieles acudan a recibir el abono por medio de ellos. Los sacramentos de iniciación cristiana son la base. Bautismo, Confirmación y Eucaristía. ¿Los frecuentas? ¿Cómo te ayudan a crecer y dar fruto en tu vida? ©LPi

Laetare Sunday and Sacred Silence

Two weeks ago I mentioned why the music during Lent is more somber than other times of the year. One exception to this rule of solemn music is *Laetare* Sunday (the Fourth Sunday of Lent), the halfway point of our Lenten journey and a break from penitential focus. 'Laetare,' meaning 'Rejoice,' comes from the very first words (the *incipit*, or opening phrase) of the traditional Latin Mass for this Sunday. The music on Laetare Sunday reflects the imagery of the light of Christ amid the darkness, and serves as a reminder of the upcoming joy of the Resurrection at Easter.

Sacred silence will be implemented in the form of unaccompanied music beginning on Holy Thursday after the *Gloria* is sung and ending when we again sing out with joy at the *Gloria* on Holy Saturday.

But for Laetare Sunday, "Rejoice, O Jerusalem: ...rejoice with joy, you that have been in sorrow: that you may exult..."

Lenten Abstinence Regulations

Every Friday during Lent is a day of abstinence.

ABSTINENCE is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the Parish Priest should be consulted.


