

ABSTINENCE is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the Parish Priest should be consulted.

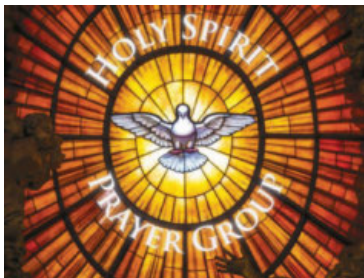

Es lo que estamos llamados a hacer con mayor empeño durante la Cuaresma: acoger la luz en nuestra conciencia, para abrir nuestros corazones al amor infinito de Dios, a su misericordia llena de ternura y bondad, a su perdón...”. Él afirmó que Dios siempre nos perdona, solo pide abrir el corazón y toda la persona a ese perdón infinito de Dios Padre.

Why Do We Do That?

Easter

Question:

Why does the date of Easter change every year, while most other celebrations are celebrated on the same day?


Answer:

Every feast is celebrated at a certain time for a reason. Saints feast days are commonly the day of their death. While we don't know Jesus' exact birthday, we celebrate the "light of the world" around the time of winter solstice, as dark, wintery days begin to lengthen again. We have a historical clue, however, to when the Easter events occurred. We know that Jesus was crucified the day before Passover. The Jews calculated the date for Passover based on both the solar and lunar calendars. It corresponds to the first full moon after the spring equinox. The early Christians maintained this connection in their celebrations of Easter on the first Sunday after the paschal full moon.

We don't re-calculate the full moon every year. As astronomy developed, so too did the forecasts of when Easter would occur in future years. The Church has created a table of calculated dates, projecting the date of Easter decades in advance. The date of Easter also determines the date of Ash Wednesday and the season of Lent, as well as the feast days following in the Easter season, including Pentecost. So these feasts move, too! This tradition may seem complicated, but it connects our Christian faith now to what has come before – our Jewish roots and the real, historical reality of Christ's suffering, death, and resurrection.

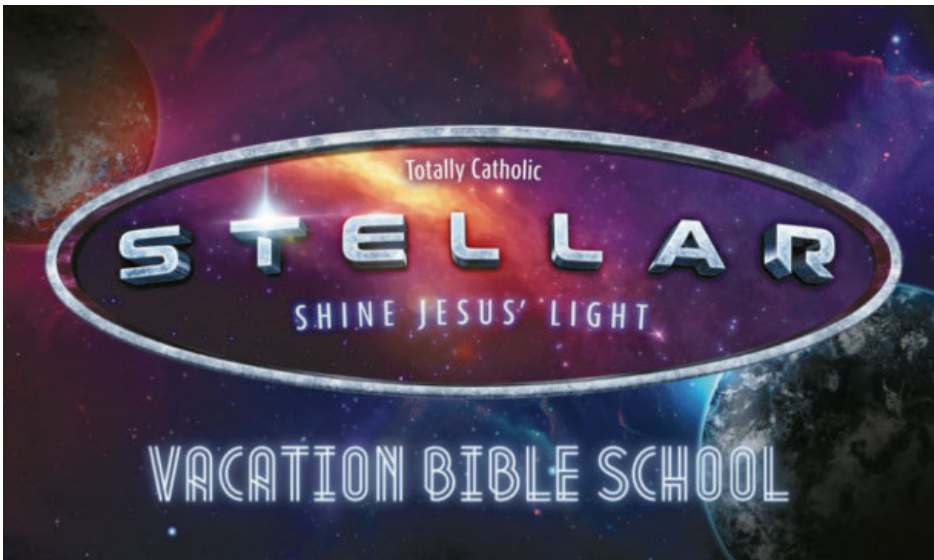

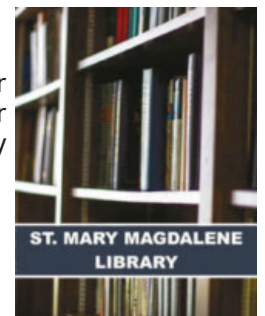

Parking Barricades

Because of the increased volume of “cut-through traffic” passing through the parking lot from Woodruff Road or Brown Road, we have placed barricades to discourage drivers from using our parking lot as a “cut-through” and speeding through as they do.



We are particularly concerned for parishioner and visitor safety at key times during the work week such as daily Mass times, preschool drop off/pick up and during Christian Formation classes.

We are studying whether the barricades will cause the cut-through traffic to move to the outer bounds of the parking lot and whether it will slow drivers down. So far, we’ve seen positive results. We will be moving the barricades to different locations to study their impact on the speed and volume of cut-through traffic. The barricades will be in place only on weekdays, and they will be taken down on Fridays.
