Parish Census

The parish began a census last year in June to ensure the accuracy of data for each registered household in our database that would provide demographic information for pastoral planning and provide up-to-date parish data to the Diocese.

Over the last year, we have reached out to families with envelope numbers up to 9,000, multiple times over email and by phone. If your envelope number is 9,000 or less and you have not verified your household information within the last year, please contact the parish by June 15.

Unless your household account is verified, you will be identified as an inactive household, regardless of your ministry involvement or giving history.

To verify your parish household data, look in your inbox for an email from census@smmcc.org from late April or May and respond. You can also call the church at 864-537-4223 and leave a voicemail with your household address, and the name, phone number, email and date of birth of everyone who is currently living in your house. Do not include adult children who have moved away.
