SPIRITUAL LIFE

Lenten Disciplines of Fasting and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fasting & Abstinence.

Every Friday during Lent is a day of abstinence.

FASTING is to be observed by all 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 60th birthday. On a fast day, one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed.

ABSTINENCE is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the Parish Priest should be consulted.

Fasting, almsgiving and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for Baptism or of renewal of Baptism at Easter.

En el Evangelio de hoy

En la actualidad, a pesar del avance de la medicina, existen enfermedades incurables. ¿Cuáles son las enfermedades incurables ahora? ¿De qué padecemos? ¿Quiénes son los leprosos actuales? ¿Qué personas son las expulsadas de la ciudad y de la sociedad? En tiempo de Jesús, era la lepra; los enfermos, al adquirir esta enfermedad, eran expulsados de la ciudad y no podían acercarse a las personas sanas. Hoy, Jesús sigue haciendo milagros de todo tipo, sigue curando, tocando y aliviando a los necesitados. Acercarse al pobre significa luchar y comprometerse con su persona para que salga de su pobreza y enfermedad. ¿Cómo tocamos y ayudamos a los que sufren en la sociedad actual?

La curación del leproso del Evangelio nos dice que Jesús tocó al leproso sin temor a contagiarse. Su compasión se muestra con el diálogo entre ambos: «Se le acercó un leproso, que se arrodilló ante él y le suplicó: “Si quieres, puedes limpiarme”. Sintiendo compasión, Jesús extendió la mano y lo tocó diciendo: “Quiero, quedar limpio”» (Marcos 1, 40-41). Jesús rompe las reglas al tocar el leproso, lo importante en este caso era la empatía, la compasión, el ser uno con el otro. Lo que hizo Jesús le traerá consecuencias fatales, romper la ley no era aceptable. El acercamiento con respeto a los enfermos significa una muestra de amor grande para ellos. Salgamos de nuestra burbuja, busquemos a los que sufren, que, con seguridad, están en la familia y amigos. ¡No seamos indiferentes a su sufrimiento!

Normas de ayuno y abstinencia durante la Cuaresma

El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días de ayuno y abstinencia.

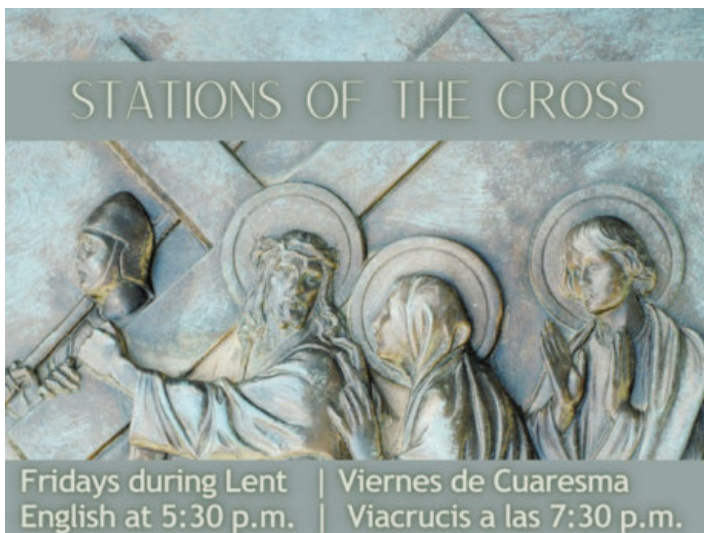
Todos los viernes durante la Cuaresma son días de abstinencia.

EL AYUNO se debe observar por todos los católicos que son mayores de 18 años de edad pero aún no cumplen 60 años. Los obligados por esta regla pueden tomar solo una comida completa. Dos comidas pequeñas que no equivalen a una comida completa están permitidas como sea necesario para mantener la fuerza de acuerdo con las necesidades de cada uno. No se permite comer entre comidas, pero líquidos, incluyendo leche y jugos, se permiten.

LA ABSTINENCIA de carne se observa por todos los católicos mayores de 14 años.

Tome en cuenta que cuando la salud o la capacidad para trabajar se ven seriamente afectadas, la ley no le obliga. En caso de duda sobre el ayuno y la abstinencia, se debe consultar con un sacerdote.

El ayuno, las obras de caridad y la oración son las tres disciplinas tradicionales de la Cuaresma. Los fieles y los catecúmenos deben emprender estas prácticas seriamente con un espíritu de penitencia y de preparación para el Bautismo o para la renovación del Bautismo en la Pascua.



Reception of Holy Communion

Reception of Holy Communion at Mass is available for Catholics who are in union with the Pope, not conscious of grave sin, and normally have fasted for one hour. Let us all pray for union with the Lord Jesus, that the Holy Spirit will dispel the sad divisions which separate Christians, and for the peace and unity of the whole human family.

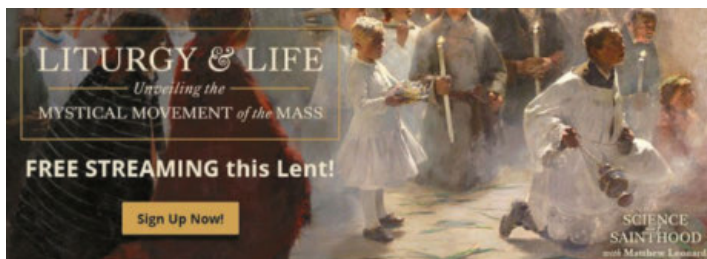

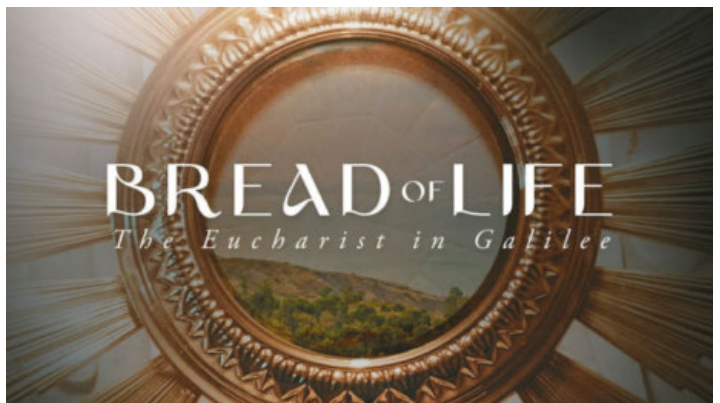


Josh Blakesly

Do you hear the words spoken by Christ in the Gospel of Matthew and wonder what you can do? For many years, men from St. Mary Magdalene Church have been bringing Christ to the men at Perry Correctional Institution with a 4-day retreat. These Kairos Walks are an ecumenical effort of Christian churches in the upstate, retreats that brings the message of salvation to 30 incarcerated men two times a year, once in the spring and once in the fall.

The team is looking for more volunteers. A 40-man team is needed to present this retreat. This spring's Walk will be Thursday, April 18, through Sunday, April 21, and includes six evenings of training over the next three months to ready volunteers for the retreat.

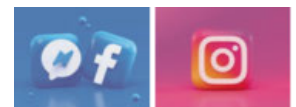
Our parish supports the Outreach Tithing Committee who researches and assists worthy charities.



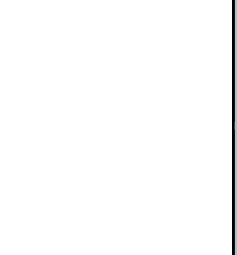
