#### El Evangelio de hoy

Por lo regular, cuando una persona está en problemas serios, tiende a sentirse sin rumbo y perdida. Estar en medio de la tormenta de la vida conlleva a tomar el timón y guiar hacia la calma. Pero, ¿Cómo hacerlo? ¿A quién dirigirnos? En el Evangelio de hoy, los discípulos estuvieron en medio de una fuerte tormenta y se asustaron, y llenos de miedo despiertan a Jesús. Enseguida vienen las preguntas: "Maestro ; no te importa que nos hundamos? Él entonces se despertó. Se encaró con el viento y dijo al mar: Cállate, cálmate". El viento se apaciguó y siguió una gran calma. Después les dijo: ¿Por qué son tan miedosos? ¿Todavía no tienen fe? (Marcos 4:38-40).

El susto de los discípulos, primero, de morir ahogados, y seguido, de ver quien era Jesús que hasta el viento y el mar le obedecían. Y Jesús, sorprendido de su falta de fe, a pesar de estar junto a él, les reprende su falta de confianza en Dios. Nosotros, también, hemos estado en situaciones difíciles en nuestra vida. 



#### MONTH 2 - Developing Baby - "I'm dancing!"

Your baby is making progress developing all of her external features and internal organs. Her brain is functioning at 40 days. Her mother can hear her heartbeat now on an ultrasonic stethoscope. Baby teeth buds are present at  $6\frac{1}{2}$  weeks. The central nervous system is functioning and



40 muscle sets begin their first exercises. From this moment, your spiritually adopted baby grows and refines her body. But everything she needs to survive after birth is already present by the end of the eighth week. She is now called a "fetus" a Latin word meaning "little one." Ultrasound reveals that this little one can now spring, flip and jump - her first dance steps!




It is amazing what our parish can do when we combine our blessings.
