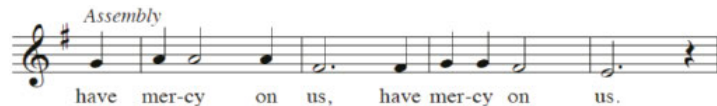

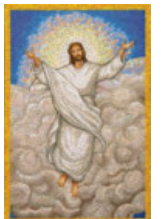

How Far Is Up?

It depends upon your understanding of cosmology, the religious explanation of the nature and structure of the universe. If Jesus ascended into heaven, how far up did he go? This also depends upon your understanding of cosmology. These are not foolish questions. We might not be experts in the field of cosmology, but many of us know a bit about galaxies, spacetime, and black holes, if only from *Star Trek*. So with this minimal cosmological knowledge, how should we understand Acts 1:9 when “a cloud took [Jesus] from their sight”? Did he just keep going up?

In the Letter to the Ephesians, Paul refers to Jesus’ ascension, but he does not describe a mystifying event, as the Gospel reading does. Instead, he speaks of Jesus’ exaltation at God’s right hand. Perhaps it was fitting that Jesus ascended into the sky a little way, emphasizing that what occurred was more than mere physical exaltation. Rather, it is a way of stating that Jesus has now achieved honor and glory far beyond anything that is human, earthly, or created. He now enjoys divine glorification.

Still, even Paul uses metaphorical language when he says that Jesus sits at God’s right hand in heaven. We know that heaven is more than a place but is also a state of total fulfillment. We also know that to be seated at the host’s right hand means to be awarded the place of honor at the banquet. So, Paul is saying that Jesus enjoys total fulfillment in the place of honor next to his Father, where he is now praised as the beginning and end of all that is. This is reason to rejoice.

SENT FORTH

Today we celebrate Jesus’ return to heaven. If we struggle to know how to feel about this event, we take our cue from Jesus’ disciples. These disciples are first-hand witnesses to the Ascension, returning afterward to Jerusalem, where “they were continually in the temple praising God.” Long-time companions of the Lord, they surely feel the pain of physical separation from Jesus. Yet they praise God continually. They accept God’s plan, looking forward to the day when Christ will come again. As our reading from Hebrews affirms, Christ will return to “bring salvation to those who eagerly await him.” This Good News is almost too much to take in; the Acts of the Apostles explains that an angel has to wake the disciples from their stupor, reminding them to start the Lord’s work. Today’s readings are our own angel, sending us forth in joyful hope.

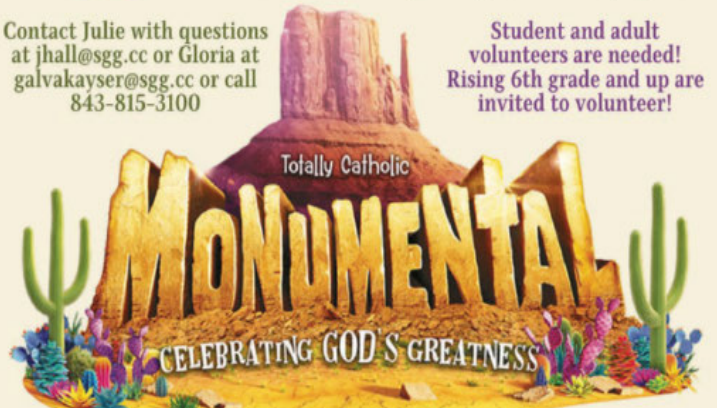

BICENTENNIAL CAMPAIGN PROJECTS UPDATE

In 2020, in celebration of the Diocese of Charleston turning 200 years old, the Bicentennial Campaign was launched to strengthen the parishes and missions of South Carolina, form Catholics to believe in the Gospel, and live the Gospel through social outreach. Through the generous donations and support of our parishioners, St. Gregory the Great surpassed the diocesan goal of \$2 million dollars—reaching a total of \$3.32 million dollars in pledges and one-time donations! Of that amount, SGG is slated to receive \$2.11 million dollars to strengthen and expand our parish. Five major projects were listed as top priorities by our pastor, Msgr. Ronald R. Cellini, along with the SGG Bicentennial Campaign Team, in consultation with our church and school leaders, ministry leaders, Executive Committee, and our Parish Finance Council. Below are updates on each of those projects.

Funding for the Parish Life Center's Second Floor

During the construction of the Parish Life Center in 2018, it became clear that continuing with the second floor would produce significant savings to the parish. Funds raised through the campaign allowed SGG to pay off the balance of this addition.

Project Cost: \$500,000

Project Timeline: *Completed* November of 2021!

Rectory Expansion

The current rectory houses three full time priests comfortably, but with the growing population of Bluffton, and the number of Masses celebrated at SGG, JP11, and St. Anthony's Mission throughout the week, the need for a fourth priest was necessary. An additional room and living space is being added to the current structure on Pinckney Colony Road.

Project Cost: \$300,000

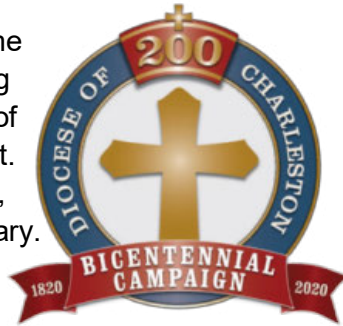
Project Timeline: To be completed September 2022

St. Gregory the Great Catholic School Expansion

The future of SGGCS includes expanding to 2 tracts of each grade and beginning a Pre-Kindergarten program that firsts welcomes 3 year olds and then younger! Plans are currently in the works to evaluate spaces for renovations and how to best incorporate a 3 year old program at SGG!

Project Cost: \$230,000

Project Timeline: Ongoing though \$10,000 has been used for conceptual plans and designs



Upgrades to SGG Church

SGG is twenty two years old and components will soon need to be replaced. Funds will cover replacement of the roof and HVAC units, pew refinishing, and other upgrades, but our first project is the enlargement of the Adoration Chapel.

The Adoration Chapel will now seat 30+ comfortably in the expanded area and a new Sacristy and Vestry will be relocated to the St. Augustine Room.

Project Cost: \$870,000

Adoration Project Cost: \$150,000

ACTUALIZACIÓN DE LOS PROYECTOS DE LA CAMPAÑA DEL BICENTENARIO

En el 2020, en celebración de los 200 años de la Diócesis de Charleston, se lanzó la Campaña del Bicentenario para fortalecer las parroquias y misiones de Carolina del Sur, formar católicos para creer en el Evangelio y vivir el Evangelio a través del alcance social. A través de las generosas donaciones y el apoyo de nuestros feligreses, St. Gregory the Great superó la meta diocesana de \$2 millones de dólares, alcanzando un total de \$3.32 millones de dólares en promesas y donaciones únicas. De esa cantidad, SGG está programado para recibir \$2.11 millones de dólares para fortalecer y expandir nuestra parroquia. Cinco proyectos principales fueron enumerados como prioridades principales por nuestro párroco, Mons. Ronald R. Cellini, junto con el Equipo de Campaña del Bicentenario de SGG, en consulta con los líderes de nuestra iglesia y escuela, los líderes ministeriales, el Comité Ejecutivo y nuestro Consejo Financiero Parroquial. A continuación se presentan actualizaciones sobre cada uno de esos proyectos.

Financiamiento para el Segundo Piso del Centro Parroquial

Durante la construcción del Centro Parroquial en el 2018, quedó claro que continuar con el segundo piso produciría ahorros significativos para la parroquia. Los fondos recaudados a través de la campaña permitieron a SGG pagar el saldo de esta adición.

Expansion de la Rectoria

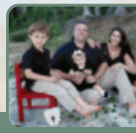
