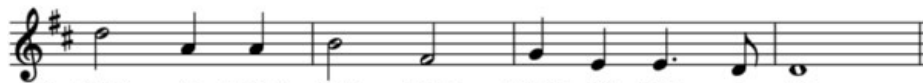

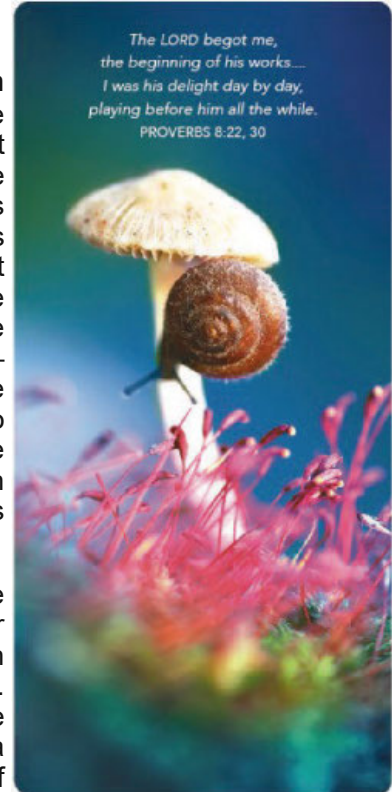
I Believe in God

What do we mean when we say this? We are saying that we don't understand it, but we believe it; we accept it as truth. How do we know it's true? First, we must remember that we are standing before the greatest mystery of all—the mystery of the triune God. The best we can do is open our eyes to the power of God working in our lives. Today's readings help us do that.

In the first reading, the wisdom of God takes our hand and leads us through the marvels of creation. Who has not stood in awe before a sunset, a waterfall, or the smile of an infant? We are surrounded by the wonders of the natural world, wonders that can fashion us into nature mystics and prompt us to praise our Creator.

Once transformed by his encounter with the risen Christ, Paul proclaims again and again that “we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ” (Romans 5:1). He knows from experience that Jesus is his savior and the savior of us all. We may not always realize this, but there are times in the life of each of us when we experience a profound need to be saved.

Finally in the Gospel, it was Jesus himself who promised that the “Spirit of truth” would come and strengthen our faith (John 16:13). Without that Spirit we might simply wander about in confusion. These readings provide a glimpse into the action of God in our lives. Do we believe what they say?



We pray for all those who are facing sickness in mind or body. We ask that you restore their health, soothe their pain and ease their worry. Give them your peace and comfort. In Jesus' name, Amen!

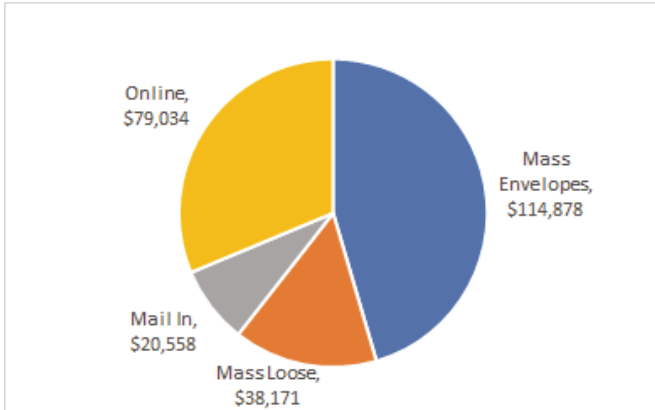
BIBLICAL ROOTS OF THE TRINITY

Today's readings show some biblical roots of what Christians would later call the Trinity. Proverbs showcases the role of Wisdom in the work of creation, portrayed as a reality outside of God but integrated into God's work of forming the heavens and the earth. We join the psalmist in sharing Wisdom's delight in God's handiwork: "O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth" (Psalm 8:2). In his letter to the Romans, Paul writes of peace with God through Jesus, and the love of God received through the Holy Spirit, distinguishing God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit while also displaying their abiding unity. Finally, in the farewell discourse from John's Gospel, Jesus—who had earlier spoken of himself as Son of the Father—promises his friends that they will receive the Spirit of truth that will teach and guide them after his departure.

The entire volunteer staff of St Andrew Kitchen wish to thank our parishioners and other benefactors for your continued support of our mission.

As we move forward into 2022, our goal is to expand into other areas of the Low Country and perhaps double the number of our clients, the hungry, needy and perhaps homeless in our area. Since the beginning of this, our second year of operation, we have provided approximately 1200 complete hot nutritiously balanced and individually packaged meals to our clients and separate items such as fresh fruit, and peanut butter and jelly sandwiches which go along every Wednesday to Mercy Mission in Hardeeville where Sister Mary Francis allows us to meet our clients, 75 to 100 per week. We also plan to contribute heavily to the purchase of new major kitchen appliances by the parish that are needed at St. Andrew Hall, and mostly used by our mission.

RAÍCES BÍBLICAS DE LA TRINIDAD

Por último, en el discurso de despedida del Evangelio de Juan, Jesús -que antes había hablado de sí mismo como el Hijo del Padre- promete a sus amigos que recibirán el Espíritu de la verdad que les enseñará y guiará después de que él se vaya.
