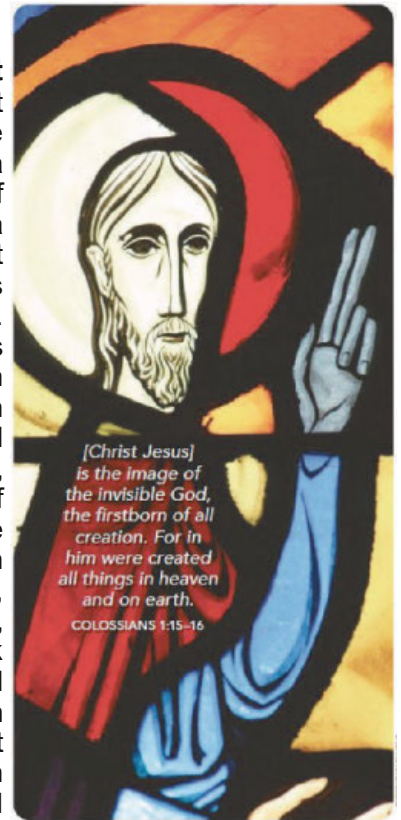

Love of the Law

Years ago, I saw a chart in a catechism that identified the faith of the Old Testament as a religion of law and that of the New Testament as a religion of love. This is not only seriously wrong, it is also dangerously biased. The two commandments to love as recorded in today's Gospel originate in Deuteronomy 6:5 and Leviticus 19:18, respectively. Several of the prophets describe God's love of Israel in tender, even passionate, terms (Isaiah 43:1, Jeremiah 31:3). To think otherwise is to tread alarmingly close to a form of anti-Judaism. We must remember that the religion Jesus loved deeply, and which he sought to bring to fulfillment, was the religion of ancient Israel.



[Christ Jesus] is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. For in him were created all things in heaven and on earth.
COLOSSIANS 1:15-16

Part of the error of that chart might have been a misunderstanding of the meaning of law. We might think of *law* as "proscription" or "restriction" (you must...or you must not...). The Hebrew meaning is more flexible. Some translate the Hebrew word *torah* as "instruction" or "directive." The psalmist delights in the law because it refreshes the soul and rejoices the heart.

Today's first reading tells us that the law is already in our hearts. The law of love was certainly in the heart of the Samaritan who cared for the stranger on the side of the road.

If we can see that laws are meant to help us care for ourselves, others, and the world, we will soon realize that living as the laws direct us might bring us to a deep love for the law.

RIGHT RELATIONSHIPS

Our God is about relationships. In the first reading, Moses reminds the Israelites that the laws, which are already in their hearts, keep them in right relationship with the God who loves them so much that they always find forgiveness. Centuries later, along comes Jesus, whom Paul describes to the Colossians as "the image of the invisible God," the very embodiment of this God of love. In his parable about the good Samaritan, Jesus explains how the law of love overrules the letter of the law. Instead of answering the question "Who is my neighbor?" Jesus demonstrates that it is not about who is worthy of being loved, but rather loving as God loves—about being neighbor, about being the good Samaritan. Jesus wants us to continue his work as images of this God of love by loving all people, even those who seem to be our enemies.

Overnight volunteers needed for SGG's Family Promise ministry, supporting local host congregations that provide shelter to homeless families with children

There are over 700 homeless children in Beaufort County. Family Promise is an interfaith non-profit organization committed to helping homeless families with children achieve lasting independence. They help families accomplish this by providing shelter, meals and support services for them, and by offering programs designed to address the underlying causes of homelessness. Their promise is to link those in need with those who want to help. Those who benefit from the efforts of Family Promise are considered guests.

Saint Gregory the Great participates in the network of Family Promise by being a support congregation, providing additional volunteers to augment existing teams in the facilities of 4 specific host congregations:

- Lord of Life Lutheran (on Buckwalter Pkwy, opposite Exxon and McD's)
- Church of the Palms (on Hwy 170, just south of Argent Blvd intersection)
- Grace Coastal Church (on Hwy 170, about 1.3 miles north of 278)
- The Unitarian Fellowship of The Lowcountry (Malphrus Rd., 1 mile behind Lowe's)

How can you help?

Right now we are looking for volunteers to cover 1 overnight shift every 8 weeks at one of our host churches. The shift runs from 8 PM in the evening to 7 AM the next morning, and involves being present to our guests for conversation, support, and help with children until about 10 PM; then retiring to your own private quarters for reading, prayer, personal time and sleep.

Two hosts are needed for each overnight, so couples would be ideal, but singles are welcome, as are parent with teen child. Orientation will be provided.

We invite you to respond to Jesus' message in Matthew 25:31-46 when Our Lord said: "... Whatever you do for even these least brothers of mine, you do for me. . ."

Come join 65 of your fellow parishioners who now serve as overnight hosts or evening dinner hosts.
